# 1. Introduction

This manual provides detailed instructions for the operation and maintenance of your Trexonic TRX-68B-AMZ 3-Speed Turntable System. Please read this manual thoroughly before using the product to ensure proper function and to prevent damage.

#### 2. SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

- Do not expose the unit to rain or moisture.
- Do not block any ventilation openings.
- Ensure the power cord is not pinched or walked on.
- Unplug the unit during lightning storms or when unused for long periods.
- · Refer all servicing to qualified service personnel.

#### 3. PACKAGE CONTENTS

Verify that all items are present in the packaging:

- Trexonic TRX-68B-AMZ Main Unit
- Wired Shelf Speakers (2)
- Remote Control
- User Manual (this document)
- Power Adapter

# 4. PRODUCT OVERVIEW: CONTROLS AND FEATURES

- 1. Record Player: For playing vinyl records.
- 2. **USB Input:** Connect USB drives for playback or recording.

- 3. **SD Input:** Insert SD cards for playback or recording.
- 4. Power & Volume Knob: Controls power on/off and audio volume.
- 5. Tweeter: High-frequency speaker component.
- 6. Base (Woofer): Low-frequency speaker component.
- 7. CD Player: For playing audio CDs and CD recording.
- 8. Cassette Player: For playing and recording cassette tapes.

# 5. SETUP

#### 5.1 Unpacking

Carefully remove all components from the packaging. Retain the packaging materials for future transport or storage.

#### **5.2 Speaker Connection**

Connect the wired shelf speakers to the speaker output terminals on the rear of the main unit. Ensure correct polarity (positive to positive, negative to negative) for optimal sound quality.

#### **5.3 Power Connection**

Plug the power adapter into the DC IN jack on the back of the unit, then plug the other end into a standard wall outlet (AC 100-240V, 50/60Hz).

# 6. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

#### **6.1 General Controls**

- Power/Volume Knob: Rotate to turn the unit on/off and adjust volume.
- **Mode/Function Button:** Press to cycle through different modes (Turntable, CD, Cassette, FM, USB, SD, AUX, Bluetooth).

#### **6.2 Turntable Operation**

- 1. Lift the dust cover.
- 2. Place a record on the platter.
- 3. Select the appropriate speed (33, 45, or 78 RPM) using the speed selector switch.
- 4. Move the tonearm to the desired position on the record. The platter will begin to spin automatically.
- 5. Lower the tonearm gently onto the record.
- 6. To stop playback, lift the tonearm and return it to its rest.

# **6.3 CD Player Operation**

- 1. Press the Mode/Function button to select CD mode.
- 2. Press the OPEN/CLOSE button to open the CD tray.
- 3. Place a CD with the label side facing up.
- 4. Press the OPEN/CLOSE button to close the tray. The CD will begin playing automatically.
- 5. Use the PLAY/PAUSE, STOP, SKIP FORWARD, and SKIP BACKWARD buttons for control.

# **6.4 Cassette Player Operation**

- 1. Press the Mode/Function button to select Cassette mode.
- 2. Insert a cassette tape into the cassette slot.
- 3. Use the PLAY, PAUSE, FAST FORWARD, REWIND, and STOP buttons for control.

#### 6.5 FM Radio Operation

- 1. Press the Mode/Function button to select FM Radio mode.
- 2. Use the TUNER knob or SEEK buttons to find radio stations.
- 3. Press the PRESET button to save or recall favorite stations.

# 6.6 USB/SD Playback

- 1. Insert a USB drive into the USB port or an SD card into the SD slot.
- 2. Press the Mode/Function button to select USB or SD mode.
- 3. The unit will automatically detect and play compatible audio files.
- 4. Use the PLAY/PAUSE, STOP, SKIP FORWARD, and SKIP BACKWARD buttons for control.

#### **6.7 Recording Functions**

The Trexonic TRX-68B-AMZ allows recording from various sources to USB or SD card.

#### • Recording from Vinyl, CD, Cassette, or AUX to USB/SD:

- a. Insert a USB drive or SD card into the respective slot.
- b. Select the desired source mode (Turntable, CD, Cassette, or AUX).
- c. Begin playback of the source material.
- d. Press the RECORD button. The recording indicator will illuminate.
- e. Press the STOP button to end the recording.

# 7. MAINTENANCE

# 7.1 Cleaning the Unit

Wipe the unit with a soft, dry cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents. For the dust cover, use a soft cloth and a mild detergent solution if necessary, then wipe dry.

# 7.2 Stylus Care and Replacement

The turntable stylus (needle) is a delicate component. Clean it periodically with a soft brush, brushing from back to front. A worn stylus can damage records and degrade sound quality. Replace the stylus approximately every 300-500 hours of playback, or if you notice a decrease in sound quality or increased record wear.

#### 8. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No power	Power cord not connected; Power outlet faulty	Ensure power cord is securely connected; Try a different outlet.
No sound	Volume too low; Speakers not connected; Incorrect mode selected	Increase volume; Check speaker connections; Select correct input mode.
Turntable not spinning	Unit not powered on; Tonearm not moved over platter	Turn on unit; Move tonearm over the record to activate platter.
CD not playing	CD inserted incorrectly; CD scratched/dirty; Incorrect mode	Reinsert CD correctly; Clean or replace CD; Select CD mode.
Recording issues	USB/SD full or incompatible; Source not playing	Check USB/SD capacity and format; Ensure source is playing during recording.


