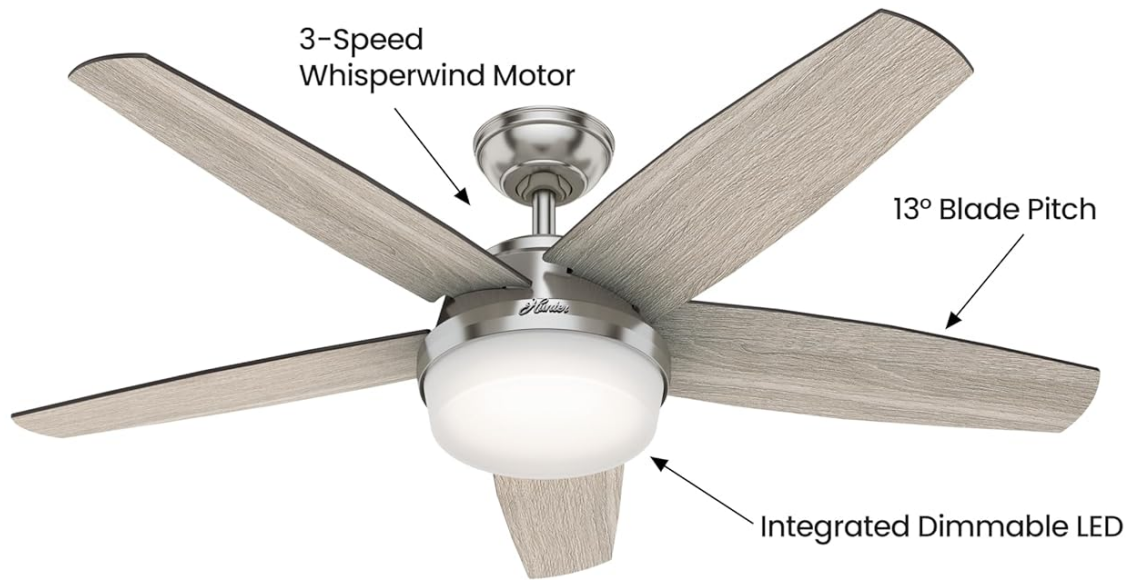
SETUP AND INSTALLATION

Proper installation is crucial for the safe and efficient operation of your ceiling fan. It is recommended that installation be performed by a qualified electrician.

Mounting Options

The fan features an Installer's Choice three-position mounting system, allowing for standard, low, or angled mounting to suit your room's requirements.

- **Standard Mounting:** Utilizes a 4-inch downrod (included).
- **Low Profile Mounting:** Requires a 2-inch downrod (not included).
- **Angled Mounting:** Requires a 36-inch downrod (not included) for sloped ceilings.

Pre-Installation Checklist

- Ensure power is disconnected at the circuit breaker.
- Verify all components are present as per the packing list.
- Confirm the mounting location can support the fan's weight.

Wiring Instructions

Connect the fan wiring to the household wiring according to local electrical codes. Ensure all connections are secure and insulated.

Blade Installation

Attach the five reversible blades to the motor housing. The blades feature Light Grey Oak on one side and Grayed Walnut on the other, allowing for customization.

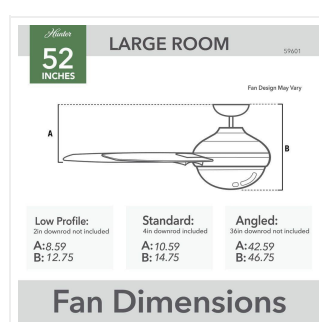


Image: Close-up view of the light grey oak finish on one side of a fan blade.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Your Hunter ceiling fan comes with a convenient remote control for easy operation of fan speed and light functions.

Remote Control Functions

- **Light Button:** Press to turn the light ON/OFF. Hold to dim the light.
- **Fan Speed Buttons (Up/Down Arrows):** Adjust the fan speed (3-speed WhisperWind motor).
- **Fan Direction Button (Star/Asterisk):** Reverses the direction of the fan blades for seasonal use.

Reversible Motor Function

The WhisperWind reversible motor allows you to change the direction of the fan blades for optimal air circulation throughout the year.

- **Summer Mode (Counter-clockwise):** Downward airflow creates a cooling effect.
- **Winter Mode (Clockwise):** Upward airflow circulates warm air trapped near the ceiling.

MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance ensures the longevity and optimal performance of your ceiling fan.

Cleaning

- Always turn off power to the fan before cleaning.
- Use a soft, damp cloth to clean the fan blades and motor housing.
- Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents, as they may damage the finish.

Light Bulb Replacement

The integrated light kit includes two 9-Watt energy-efficient, dimmable LED bulbs. When replacing, ensure the power is off and allow bulbs to cool before handling.

- Recommended Light Bulb Shape Code: E26
- Light Bulb Base Code: A19

TROUBLESHOOTING

Before contacting customer support, please refer to the following common issues and their solutions.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Fan does not start	No power to the fan; Loose wire connections; Remote control battery low.	Check circuit breaker; Verify all wire connections are secure; Replace remote control battery.
Light does not work	Bulb loose or burnt out; Incorrect bulb type; Wiring issue.	Tighten or replace bulb; Ensure correct bulb type (E26/A19 LED); Check light kit wiring.
Fan wobbles	Loose blades or blade holders; Unbalanced blades; Loose mounting bracket.	Tighten all blade screws; Use balancing kit (not included) if necessary; Secure mounting bracket.
Remote control not working	Battery dead or incorrectly installed; Remote not paired with fan.	Replace battery, ensuring correct polarity; Refer to remote pairing instructions (if applicable, not detailed in product info).

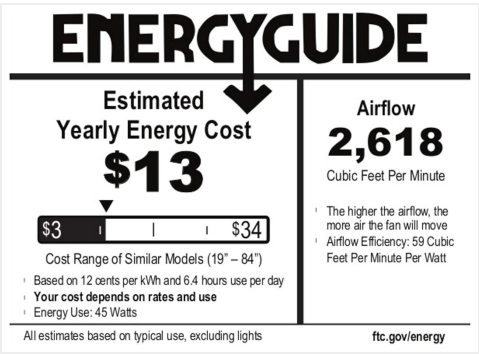

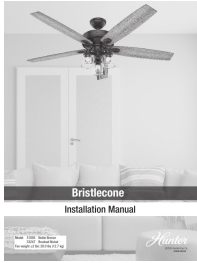
