1. Introduction

The Water Tech Pool Blaster Hydro is a cordless, lithium-ion battery-powered pool, hot tub, and spa cleaner designed for quick spot-cleaning and easy maintenance in tight spaces. Its lightweight and portable design eliminates the need for hoses or cords, offering convenient operation.

2. WHAT'S INCLUDED

Your Pool Blaster Hydro package includes the following components:

- One (1) Pool Blaster Hydro Cleaner Unit
- One (1) Omni-Directional Brush Head (for general cleaning)
- One (1) Standard Aqua Broom Head (for hard-to-reach areas)
- One (1) All-Purpose Filter Bag
- One (1) Charging Cable (USB)
- Four (4) Piece Pole Set (60 inches total length)

3. SETUP

Before first use, ensure the Pool Blaster Hydro is fully charged. The unit uses a rechargeable lithium-ion battery.

3.1 Charging the Unit

Connect the provided USB charging cable to the charging port on the cleaner unit and plug it into a suitable USB power adapter (not included). Allow sufficient time for a full charge, typically around 4 hours, to achieve up to 40 minutes of run time.

3.2 Assembling for Use

- 1. Ensure the product is fully charged.
- 2. For general cleaning, attach the Omni-Directional Brush Head. For hard-to-reach areas, attach the Standard Aqua Broom head.
- 3. The unit can be used by hand or attached to the provided 4-piece pole set for extended reach. Connect the pole pieces securely if using.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The Pool Blaster Hydro is designed for simple push-button operation, requiring no external hoses, pumps, or water hook-ups.

- 1. Once assembled and charged, submerge the cleaner unit into the water.
- 2. Press the power button to activate the vacuum.
- 3. Manually guide the vacuum over the pool, hot tub, or spa surfaces to clean debris. The multi-head design allows for versatile cleaning: use the Omni-Directional Brush Head for broad areas and the Standard Aqua Broom head for corners and tight spots.
- 4. The unit is designed to run for up to 40 minutes on a full charge.







5. MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance ensures the longevity and efficiency of your Pool Blaster Hydro cleaner.

5.1 Cleaning the Filter Bag and Debris Container

After each use, or when suction power decreases, remove and empty the all-purpose filter bag and debris container. Rinse them thoroughly with clean water to remove all collected debris. Ensure they are completely dry before reassembling.

5.2 Battery Care and Storage

To maximize battery life, always fully charge the unit after each use. Store the cleaner in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures. Do not store the unit with a depleted battery for extended periods.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Pool Blaster Hydro, refer to the following common troubleshooting tips:

- Unit not turning on: Ensure the battery is fully charged. Check the power button for any obstructions.
- **Weak suction:** The filter bag may be full or clogged. Remove and clean the filter bag and debris container. Ensure the vacuum head is properly attached and sealed.
- **Short run time:** The battery may not be fully charged, or it may be reaching the end of its lifespan. Ensure proper charging procedures are followed.
- **Unit floats or pops out of water:** Ensure the unit is fully submerged and the pole is providing adequate downward pressure.
