


Image: Front view of the leather-bound book, showcasing the intricate golden detailing on the spine and cover edges, with a red ribbon bookmark visible at the bottom.




Image: Interior view of the book, displaying the unique handmade marbled endpapers in cream and gold, which add to the book's aesthetic appeal.




Image: Inside view of the book, showing the plain black inner cover and a black ribbon bookmark, indicating the book's simple yet functional design.
