1. INTRODUCTION

- Clearance:** Be aware of increased vehicle height when entering garages, car washes, or low-clearance areas.
- Weather Conditions:** While the bag is waterproof, extreme weather conditions (e.g., heavy storms, strong winds) may require extra caution.
- Sharp Objects:** Avoid placing sharp or abrasive objects directly inside the bag without proper padding to prevent damage to the material.

5. SETUP AND INSTALLATION

The Zacro cargo bag is designed for easy installation on various vehicle types, with or without existing roof racks.

5.1 Compatibility

The bag is compatible with:

- Vehicles with side rails
- Vehicles with crossbars
- Vehicles with roof baskets or trays
- Vehicles without any roof rack (using door frame hooks)

5.2 Installation Steps (General)

- 1. Prepare the Bag:** Unfold the cargo bag and place it on the vehicle's roof. If using an anti-slip mat (recommended), place it under the bag first.
- 2. Assemble Buckles and Straps:** Ensure all buckles are correctly attached to their respective straps.
- 3. Secure Straps:**
 - With Roof Rack (Side Rails/Crossbars): Pass the adjustable straps around your vehicle's roof rack bars. Ensure the straps are not twisted.
 - Without Roof Rack (Door Frame Hooks):
 - Gently pull down the weather stripping/door seal around your car's door frame.
 - Attach the provided door hooks to the metal door frame.
 - Push the weather stripping back into place, securing the hooks.
 - Attach the cargo bag's straps to these hooks.
- 4. Tighten and Secure:** Pull all straps firmly to secure the bag to the roof. Ensure the bag is centered and stable. The bag should not move or flap. Tuck away any excess strap length to prevent flapping during travel.
- 5. Load Cargo:** Load your items into the bag, distributing weight evenly. Close the waterproof zipper and secure the Velcro flap over it.

6. OPERATION AND USAGE

6.1 Loading the Bag

- Open the main zipper and the Velcro flap.
- Place items inside, starting with heavier items at the bottom and center to maintain vehicle stability.
- Utilize the bag's flexible soft-shell design to accommodate irregularly shaped items.
- Avoid overfilling the bag to ensure the zipper can close properly and the material is not unduly stressed.
- For maximum waterproofing, ensure the zipper is fully closed and the protective Velcro flap is securely sealed over it. The side without the zipper should face the front of the vehicle.

6.2 Driving with the Cargo Bag

- Before each drive, double-check all straps for tightness and security.
- During long trips, periodically stop and re-check the straps to ensure they remain taut.
- Be mindful of crosswinds and sudden braking, as these can affect vehicle handling with a rooftop load.
- The bag is designed to withstand various weather conditions, including rain and snow.

7. MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Clean the cargo bag with a damp cloth and mild soap. Do not use harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners. Rinse thoroughly and allow to air dry completely before storage.
- **Storage:** When not in use, fold the bag compactly and store it in its provided storage bag in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.

- **Inspection:** Periodically inspect the bag, zippers, straps, and buckles for any signs of wear, tear, or damage. Replace or repair as necessary to ensure continued safe operation.

8. TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Bag is flapping or noisy during driving:**

Ensure all straps are pulled taut and securely fastened. Tuck away any excess strap length. Verify the bag is centered and evenly loaded. An anti-slip mat can also help reduce movement.

- **Water leakage:**

Ensure the zipper is fully closed and the Velcro flap is completely sealed over the zipper. The side without the zipper should face the front of the vehicle to minimize water ingress from wind and rain. Check for any punctures or tears in the material.

- **Difficulty closing zipper:**

The bag may be overfilled. Remove some items to reduce tension on the zipper. Ensure items are not snagging the zipper path.

- **Bag feels unstable:**

Re-check all strap connections and tension. Ensure weight is evenly distributed inside the bag. If using door hooks, confirm they are properly seated under the weather stripping.
