1. Introduction

This manual provides detailed instructions for the assembly, operation, and maintenance of your One For All WM7471 Universal TV Tripod Stand. Please read this manual thoroughly before installation and retain it for future reference. This stand is designed to securely hold televisions ranging from 32 to 65 inches with VESA mounting patterns between 200x100mm and 400x400mm.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

WARNING: Failure to read and follow these instructions can result in serious personal injury, property damage, or voiding of your warranty. If you have any questions, please contact customer support.

- Ensure all components are present and undamaged before assembly. Do not use damaged parts.
- Do not exceed the maximum weight capacity or screen size specified in the specifications section.
- Always assemble the stand on a flat, stable surface.
- Ensure the TV is securely attached to the mounting brackets and the stand is stable before releasing the TV.
- Keep children and pets away during assembly. Small parts can be a choking hazard.
- Do not attempt to modify the stand.
- Periodically check all screws and connections to ensure they remain tight and secure.

3. PACKAGE CONTENTS

Verify that all parts listed below are included in your package. If any parts are missing or damaged, do not proceed with assembly and contact customer support.

- Tripod Base Assembly (Wooden legs, central column)
- TV Mounting Brackets (Horizontal bars)
- Vertical Support Bar
- Cable Management Strap (Leather)
- Universal Soundbar Attachment
- Hardware Kit (Screws, washers, spacers for TV mounting)
- Instruction Manual (This document)

4. SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

Follow these steps carefully to assemble your TV tripod stand. It is recommended to have a second person assist with mounting the television.

1. Assemble the Tripod Base:

Carefully attach the three wooden legs to the central column. Ensure they are securely fastened according to the provided diagrams in the separate assembly guide (if applicable). The design allows for tool-free or minimal tool assembly.

2. Attach TV Mounting Brackets to TV:

Identify the VESA mounting holes on the back of your television. Select the appropriate screws, washers, and spacers from the hardware kit that match your TV's specifications. Attach the horizontal TV mounting brackets to the back of your TV. Ensure they are level and securely tightened.

3. Mount TV to Stand:

With assistance, carefully lift the television and hook the attached mounting brackets onto the vertical support bar of the tripod stand. Ensure the TV is centered and level. Secure the TV to the stand using the provided safety mechanisms, such as locking screws or clips, to prevent accidental dislodgement.

4. Cable Management:

Utilize the integrated cable management strap and clips to route and conceal TV and accessory cables along the central column and down one of the legs. This helps maintain a tidy appearance and prevents tripping hazards.

5. Soundbar Attachment (Optional):

If using a soundbar, attach the universal soundbar attachment to the TV mounting brackets as per its specific instructions. This allows the soundbar to move with the TV when adjusted.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS (ADJUSTMENTS)

The One For All WM7471 stand offers flexibility in TV positioning.

• Height Adjustment:

The TV can be adjusted vertically along the central column. Loosen the height adjustment mechanism (refer to the assembly guide for specific details), slide the TV to the desired height, and then securely tighten the mechanism. Always ensure the TV is level after adjustment.

• 360° Swivel:

The entire TV and mounting assembly can be rotated 360 degrees around the central column. Gently rotate the TV to achieve the optimal viewing angle. Ensure no cables are snagged or strained during rotation.

6. MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance ensures the longevity and safe operation of your TV stand.

- Cleaning: Use a soft, dry cloth to wipe down the stand. For stubborn marks, a slightly damp cloth with mild soap can be used, followed by immediate drying. Avoid abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- **Inspections:** Periodically check all screws, bolts, and connections for tightness. Re-tighten if necessary.
- Cable Management: Ensure cables remain neatly organized and are not pinched or strained.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your TV stand, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Stand feels unstable.	Loose connections; uneven floor; TV too heavy/large.	Ensure all screws are tightened. Move stand to a level surface. Verify TV weight and size are within specifications.
TV is not level.	Mounting brackets unevenly attached; stand not level.	Re-adjust TV mounting brackets. Ensure stand is on a level surface.
Difficulty adjusting height or swivel.	Adjustment mechanism is too tight or obstructed.	Loosen adjustment mechanism slightly. Check for cable obstructions. Do not force movement.
