Kedok Vintage 3-Speed Bluetooth Vinyl Turntable Instruction Manual

Model: M435

1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential information for the safe and efficient operation of your Kedok Vintage 3-Speed Bluetooth Vinyl Turntable. Please read this manual thoroughly before using the product and retain it for future reference.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

- Do not expose the unit to rain or moisture.
- Do not open the cabinet. Refer servicing to qualified personnel only.
- Ensure proper ventilation around the unit.
- Avoid placing the unit on unstable surfaces.
- Keep the unit away from direct sunlight, heat sources, and strong magnetic fields.
- Clean only with a dry cloth.

4. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Kedok Vintage 3-Speed Bluetooth Vinyl Turntable is designed for playing vinyl records and streaming audio via Bluetooth. It features a suitcase design for portability and includes built-in stereo speakers.

4.1. Controls and Features

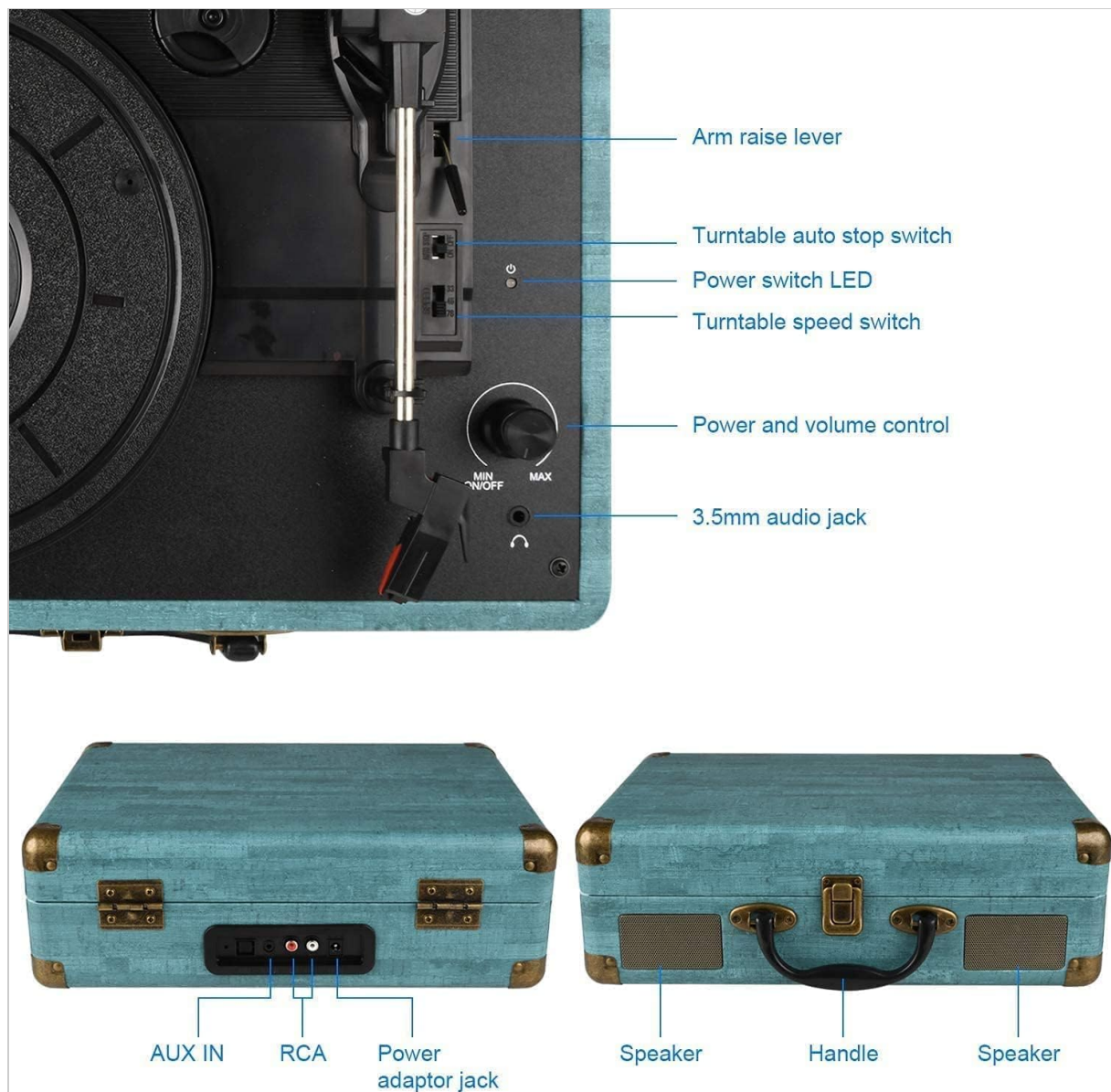


Figure 2: Turntable Controls

- **Arm Raise Lever:** Lifts and lowers the tonearm.
- **Turntable Auto Stop Switch:** Enables or disables the auto-stop function. When ON, the turntable will stop rotating automatically after a record finishes.
- **Power Switch LED:** Indicates power status (red for power on, blue for Bluetooth mode).
- **Turntable Speed Switch:** Selects playback speed (33, 45, or 78 RPM).
- **Power and Volume Control:** Turns the unit ON/OFF and adjusts the volume.
- **3.5mm Audio Jack:** For connecting headphones.

4.2. Rear Panel Connections

- **AUX IN Jack:** Connect external audio devices (e.g., smartphone, laptop) using a 3.5mm audio cable.
- **RCA Out Jacks:** Connect to external speakers for enhanced sound output.
- **Power Adaptor Jack:** Connect the provided power adapter.

5. SETUP

1. **Unpack the Turntable:** Carefully remove the turntable from its packaging.
2. **Power Connection:** Connect the power adapter to the Power Adaptor Jack on the rear panel and plug it into a wall outlet.
3. **Open the Lid:** Open the turntable lid.
4. **Remove Protective Cover:** Remove the stylus protective cover from the needle.
5. **Place a Record:** Place a vinyl record on the turntable platter.

6. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

6.1. Playing Vinyl Records

1. **Power On:** Turn the Power and Volume Control knob clockwise to power on the unit. The Power Switch LED will illuminate red.
2. **Select Speed:** Set the Turntable Speed Switch to the appropriate speed (33, 45, or 78 RPM) for your record.
3. **Auto Stop:** Set the Turntable Auto Stop Switch to ON if you want the turntable to stop automatically after the record finishes. Set to OFF for continuous play.
4. **Position Tonearm:** Gently lift the tonearm using the Arm Raise Lever. Move the tonearm over the desired track on the record.
5. **Lower Tonearm:** Slowly lower the tonearm onto the record using the Arm Raise Lever. The record will begin to play.
6. **Adjust Volume:** Adjust the volume using the Power and Volume Control knob.
7. **Stop Playback:** To stop playback, lift the tonearm using the Arm Raise Lever and return it to its rest. Turn the Power and Volume Control knob counter-clockwise to power off.

6.2. Bluetooth Connectivity

The turntable can receive audio wirelessly from your Bluetooth-enabled devices.

1. **Activate Bluetooth:** Turn the Power and Volume Control knob clockwise. The Power Switch LED will flash blue, indicating Bluetooth pairing mode.
2. **Pair Device:** On your smartphone or other Bluetooth device, search for 'BT-M435' (or similar model

name) in the Bluetooth settings and select it to pair.

3. **Confirmation:** Once paired, the Power Switch LED will glow solid blue. You can now stream audio from your device to the turntable's built-in speakers.
4. **Adjust Volume:** Control the volume using both your device and the turntable's Power and Volume Control knob.

6.3. AUX Audio Input

Connect external audio sources directly to the turntable.

1. **Connect Cable:** Use a 3.5mm audio cable (not included) to connect your external device to the AUX IN Jack on the rear panel.
2. **Play Audio:** Play audio from your connected device. The sound will output through the turntable's speakers.
3. **Adjust Volume:** Adjust the volume using both your external device and the turntable's Power and Volume Control knob.

6.4. Headphone Output

For private listening, connect headphones to the 3.5mm Audio Jack on the front panel.

7. MAINTENANCE

7.1. Cleaning the Turntable

- Wipe the exterior with a soft, dry cloth.
- Do not use harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners.
- Keep the stylus clean using a soft brush, brushing gently from back to front.

7.2. Stylus Replacement

The stylus (needle) is a consumable part and will wear out over time. Replace it when you notice a decrease in sound quality or if it becomes damaged. Contact customer support for replacement stylus information.

8. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No power	Power adapter not connected or faulty.	Ensure power adapter is securely connected and plugged into a working outlet.
No sound from speakers	Volume too low; incorrect input mode; stylus not properly seated.	Increase volume; ensure tonearm is lowered onto the record; check stylus.
Record skips	Dirty record; worn or damaged stylus; turntable not level.	Clean record; replace stylus; place turntable on a stable, level surface.
Bluetooth not connecting	Device not in pairing mode; turntable too far from device.	Ensure turntable LED is flashing blue; move device closer to turntable.

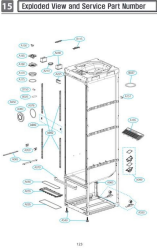
