### **NTRODUCTION**

The BEABA Babycook Neo is a versatile 4-in-1 baby food maker designed for steam cooking, blending, defrosting, and reheating. This appliance features a durable glass bowl, a stainless steel steam basket, and a large stainless steel water reservoir, ensuring that food comes into contact only with non-toxic materials. It facilitates the quick preparation of fresh baby food in under 20 minutes, offering a generous capacity of 1,250ml, suitable for up to 20 servings. Key features include an auto shut-off timer for enhanced safety and a unique blending function that allows for precise control over puree consistency, from fine to chunky. # **S**ETUP

Before first use, ensure all removable parts are thoroughly cleaned. Place the Babycook Neo on a stable, flat surface. The unit consists of two main sections: the steaming unit (left) and the blending unit (right).

# **Initial Assembly**

- 1. **Water Reservoir:** Open the lid of the steaming unit. Fill the stainless steel water reservoir with distilled water up to the indicated fill line. Close the lid securely.
- 2. Steam Basket: Place your chopped ingredients into the stainless steel steam basket. Ensure not to overfill.
- 3. Glass Bowl: Insert the steam basket into the glass blending bowl.
- 4. Lid Placement: Secure the lid onto the glass blending bowl, ensuring it clicks into place.

## **OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS**

## 1. Steaming

- 1. Prepare ingredients by washing and chopping them into small, uniform pieces (approximately 1-inch cubes).
- 2. Place ingredients into the stainless steel steam basket.
- 3. Fill the water reservoir with distilled water to the appropriate level (refer to markings for guidance based on cooking time).
- 4. Place the steam basket into the glass bowl and secure the lid.
- 5. Press the steam button (indicated by a cloud icon). The button will illuminate, and the unit will begin steaming.
- 6. The auto shut-off timer will activate, and the unit will beep three times when steaming is complete. The button light will blink.

# 2. Blending

- 1. Once steaming is complete, carefully remove the steam basket from the glass bowl.
- 2. Pour the steamed ingredients directly into the glass blending bowl. You may retain some of the cooking liquid to adjust puree consistency.
- 3. Secure the blending lid onto the glass bowl.
- 4. Press and hold the blend button (indicated by a blade icon) in short pulses until the desired consistency is achieved. The unique blending feature allows for control from fine to chunky purees.
- 5. Release the button to stop blending.



## 3. Defrosting and Reheating

The Babycook Neo can also defrost and reheat pre-prepared baby food. Place the food in the glass bowl (without the lid for defrosting/reheating). Fill the water tank to the appropriate level and press the steam button. The unit will automatically shut off when complete.

# MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

Regular cleaning ensures optimal performance and hygiene. All removable parts, including the glass cooking bowl and stainless steel steam basket, are dishwasher safe. For longevity, hand washing is recommended for delicate parts.

# **Daily Cleaning**

- 1. Disassemble all removable parts: glass bowl, steam basket, blending blade, and lids.
- 2. Wash all parts with warm, soapy water or place them in the dishwasher.
- 3. Ensure all food residue is removed, especially from the blending blade and around the handle area of the glass bowl.
- 4. Allow all parts to air dry completely before reassembling or storing.

## **Descaling**

To prevent mineral buildup, descale the water reservoir every 50 cycles or as needed. Use a descaling solution suitable for kitchen appliances, following the manufacturer's instructions. Rinse thoroughly after descaling.

# **TROUBLESHOOTING**

- **Unit Not Powering On:** Ensure all components are properly locked into place. The Babycook Neo has a safety lock design that prevents operation if parts are not correctly assembled.
- Leaking During Operation: Verify that all lids and components are securely aligned and locked. Misalignment, particularly of the handles, can cause minor leaks.
- Food Not Blending Smoothly: Ensure ingredients are chopped into small, uniform pieces before steaming. Add a small amount of cooking liquid or water to achieve desired consistency during blending.
- Steam Function Not Working: Check if the water reservoir is filled to the correct level. Descale the unit if mineral buildup is suspected.
