1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential instructions for the proper setup, operation, and maintenance of your Terrillon 14477 Tradition 500 Analog Kitchen Scale. Please read this manual thoroughly before using the scale to ensure accurate measurements and prolonged product life. Keep this manual for future reference.

2. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Terrillon Tradition 500 is a robust and reliable analog kitchen scale designed for precise weighing of ingredients. It features a durable metal construction and an easy-to-read dial.

Key Components:

- Weighing Bowl (removable, stainless steel)
- Scale Base (metal housing)
- Analog Dial (with measurement markings)
- Zero Adjustment Knob (tare function)

3. SETUP

1. **Unpacking:** Carefully remove the scale and all components from the packaging. Retain packaging

for future storage or transport.

2. **Placement:** Place the scale on a firm, flat, and stable surface to ensure accurate readings. Avoid placing it on soft or uneven surfaces.
3. **Attach Weighing Bowl:** Position the removable weighing bowl securely onto the scale's platform.
4. **Zero Adjustment (Tare):** Before first use or after placing the empty weighing bowl, turn the zero adjustment knob (usually located below the bowl or on the side of the dial) until the indicator needle points exactly to zero. This ensures that only the weight of the ingredients is measured.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Weighing Ingredients:

1. Ensure the scale is placed on a stable surface and the weighing bowl is attached.
2. Adjust the zero adjustment knob so the needle points to '0' on the dial.
3. Carefully place the item(s) to be weighed into the weighing bowl.
4. Read the weight indicated by the needle on the analog dial. The dial typically shows measurements in both grams/kilograms and pounds/ounces.

Using the Tare Function (Zero Adjustment):

The tare function allows you to weigh multiple ingredients in the same bowl without emptying it, or to account for the weight of a container.

1. Place your first ingredient or an empty container into the weighing bowl.
2. Note its weight, or if you wish to add more ingredients, turn the zero adjustment knob until the needle returns to '0'.
3. Add the next ingredient. The scale will now display the weight of only the newly added ingredient.
4. Repeat as necessary.

5. MAINTENANCE AND CARE

- **Cleaning:** The weighing bowl can be removed and washed with warm soapy water. The scale base should be wiped clean with a damp cloth. Do not immerse the scale base in water or use abrasive cleaners.
- **Storage:** Store the scale in a dry place, away from extreme temperatures and humidity.
- **Handling:** Handle the scale with care. Avoid dropping it or subjecting it to strong impacts, as this may

affect its accuracy.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Inaccurate Readings:**
 - Ensure the scale is on a flat, stable surface.
 - Verify the needle is at '0' before weighing. Adjust with the zero adjustment knob if necessary.
 - Check if the weighing bowl is properly seated.
- **Needle Not Returning to Zero:**
 - Ensure nothing is resting on the scale.
 - Gently turn the zero adjustment knob to bring the needle back to '0'. If it cannot be adjusted, the scale may require service.
