INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential information for the installation, operation, and maintenance of your Lorex LBV8541XB 4K Security Camera. This add-on bullet camera is designed for both indoor and outdoor surveillance, offering 4K resolution, color night vision, and active deterrence features.

SETUP AND INSTALLATION

The Lorex LBV8541XB camera is designed for wall mounting and requires a wired connection to a compatible Lorex Digital Video Recorder (DVR) system. Ensure you have a compatible DVR from the LHV5100, LHV5100W, D841, D841B, D861, D862, D862B, or D871 series.

1. Mounting the Camera

Select a suitable location for the camera, ensuring it provides the desired field of view and is within reach of the 60ft extension cable. Use the provided mounting kit to securely attach the camera to a wall or other stable surface. The camera's durable housing is IP65-rated, making it suitable for both indoor and outdoor environments, capable of withstanding temperatures from -22°F to 140°F.

2. Connecting the Camera

1. Connect the 60ft UL Extension Cable to the camera's BNC video output.
2. Connect the other end of the extension cable to an available BNC input on your compatible Lorex DVR.
3. Connect the power adapter to the camera's power input and then plug it into a standard electrical outlet.
4. Ensure all connections are secure to prevent signal loss or power interruptions.

OPERATING THE CAMERA

Once connected to your Lorex DVR, the camera will begin transmitting video. You can access and control the camera's features through your DVR interface or via the Lorex mobile application on compatible smartphones and tablets.

Key Features:

- **4K Resolution:** Provides ultra-high-definition video for clear and detailed surveillance.
- **87-Degree Field of View:** Captures a wide area, reducing the need for multiple cameras in certain locations.

- **Color Night Vision:** Utilizes ambient light to provide full-color video in low-light conditions. In complete darkness, infrared LEDs provide crisp black and white video up to 135 feet.
- **Active Deterrence:** Features a motion-activated LED warning light and a remote-triggered siren to deter intruders. The siren can be activated manually via the Lorex app or DVR interface.
- **Motion-Only Alerts:** The camera is configured to trigger alerts based on motion detection, which can be customized through your DVR settings.

MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance ensures optimal performance and longevity of your Lorex security camera.

- Cleaning:** Periodically clean the camera lens and housing with a soft, damp cloth to remove dust, dirt, or water spots that may obstruct the view. Avoid abrasive cleaners.
- Cable Inspection:** Regularly inspect the video and power cables for any signs of wear, damage, or loose connections. Secure or replace damaged cables promptly.
- Firmware Updates:** Check the Lorex website or your DVR system for available firmware updates for your camera and DVR to ensure you have the latest features and security enhancements.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Lorex LBV8541XB camera, refer to the following common troubleshooting steps:

- **No Video Signal:**

- Ensure the camera is properly powered and the power adapter is functioning.
- Verify that the BNC cable is securely connected at both the camera and the DVR.
- Check if the camera is connected to a compatible DVR input.

- **Poor Image Quality:**

- Clean the camera lens to remove any smudges or dirt.
- Ensure the camera is focused correctly (if adjustable).
- Check the cable for damage or interference.

- **Night Vision Issues:**

- Ensure there are no obstructions blocking the infrared LEDs.
- Verify that the camera's night vision settings are correctly configured on your DVR.
- Note that color night vision requires some ambient light; in complete darkness, the camera will switch to black and white infrared mode.

- **Siren Volume is Low:**

- Confirm that the siren volume settings on your DVR or Lorex app are set to the maximum level.
- Ensure the camera's speaker is not obstructed.
