5.2 Remote Control Issues

- Replace the batteries in the remote control.
- Ensure there are no obstructions between the remote and the TV's IR sensor.
- If the remote is a Wi-Fi direct remote, try re-pairing it according to the Roku TV instructions.

5.3 Network Connectivity Problems

- Restart your Wi-Fi router and modem.
- Check the TV's network settings to ensure it's connected to the correct network and the signal strength is adequate.
- If issues persist, try connecting the TV via an Ethernet cable.
