# ReadyWired Power Cable Cord User Manual

## INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential information for the safe and effective use of your ReadyWired Power Cable Cord. This power cable is designed to provide reliable power connectivity for compatible devices.

**Compatibility:** This power cable is compatible with various Pfaff sewing machine models, including 4870, 6112, 6122, 6152, 6230, 6232, 6270, 7510, 7530, 7550, 7560, and 7570.

## PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The ReadyWired Power Cable Cord features a standard Type B male plug for connecting to a wall outlet or power strip, and a C7 (figure-8) female connector for connecting to compatible electronic devices. It is approximately 72 inches (6 feet) in length.

## SETUP

1. Ensure the device you intend to power is turned off and unplugged from any existing power source.
2. Locate the power input port on your device. This port is typically a two-pin, figure-8 shaped receptacle.
3. Insert the C7 (figure-8) female connector of the ReadyWired Power Cable Cord firmly into the device's power input port.
4. Insert the standard Type B male plug of the power cable into a compatible wall outlet or surge protector.
5. Once connected, you may turn on your device.

**Important Safety Note:** Always ensure the power cable is fully inserted into both the device and the power outlet to prevent loose connections and potential hazards.

## OPERATING

The ReadyWired Power Cable Cord functions as a passive power conduit. Once properly connected, it supplies electrical power from the outlet to your device. Its operation is entirely dependent on the power source and the connected device.

- Do not bend or crimp the cable excessively.
- Avoid placing heavy objects on the cable.
- Ensure the cable is not a tripping hazard.

## MAINTENANCE

This power cable requires minimal maintenance to ensure its longevity and safe operation.

- **Cleaning:** Disconnect the cable from all power sources and devices before cleaning. Wipe the cable and connectors with a dry, soft cloth. Do not use liquid cleaners or abrasive materials.
- **Storage:** When not in use, coil the cable loosely and store it in a dry, cool place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures. Avoid tight coiling or kinking.
- **Inspection:** Periodically inspect the cable for any signs of damage, such as cuts, fraying, exposed wires, or bent pins on the connectors. If any damage is observed, discontinue use immediately and replace the cable.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Device not powering on.	Cable not fully inserted.	Ensure both ends of the cable are firmly seated in the device and the power outlet.
Device not powering on.	Power outlet is not active.	Test the power outlet with another device or try a different outlet. Check circuit breaker.
Device not powering on.	Cable is damaged.	Inspect the cable for visible damage. If damaged, replace the cable immediately. Do not use a damaged cable.
Loose connection.	Improper insertion or worn connectors.	Re-insert the cable firmly. If the connection remains loose, the cable or device port may be worn and require replacement.
