2. SAFETY INFORMATION

- **Adult Supervision:** Always ensure children use the keyboard under adult supervision.
- **Power Source:** Use only the specified power source (3 AA batteries or 5V USB adapter). Do not mix old and new batteries.
- **Battery Handling:** Remove batteries if the product will not be used for an extended period.
- **Avoid Water:** Keep the keyboard away from water and moisture to prevent electric shock or damage.
- **Proper Handling:** Avoid dropping or subjecting the keyboard to strong impacts.
- **Microphone Care:** Ensure the microphone cable is inserted correctly to prevent damage to the port.

5. SETUP

Power Supply:

The keyboard can be powered by two methods:

1. **Batteries:** Insert 3 new non-rechargeable AA batteries (not included) into the battery compartment located on the underside of the keyboard. Ensure correct polarity. Do not mix old and new batteries.
2. **USB Power:** Connect the provided USB cable to the DC 5V power port on the keyboard and plug the other end into a 5V power adapter (not included) or a compatible USB port.

Note: Please insert the power cord correctly. Applying too much force may damage the port.

Connecting the Microphone:

The microphone is stored in a dedicated slot on the underside of the keyboard. Gently remove it and plug its connector into the microphone jack on the keyboard's control panel.

6. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

6.1. Powering On/Off

Press the **Power** button (usually red) located on the top left of the control panel to turn the keyboard on or off.

6.2. Playing the Piano

Simply press the white and black keys to play musical notes. The keyboard supports chord playing: pressing three or more keys simultaneously will produce a richer harmonic sound.

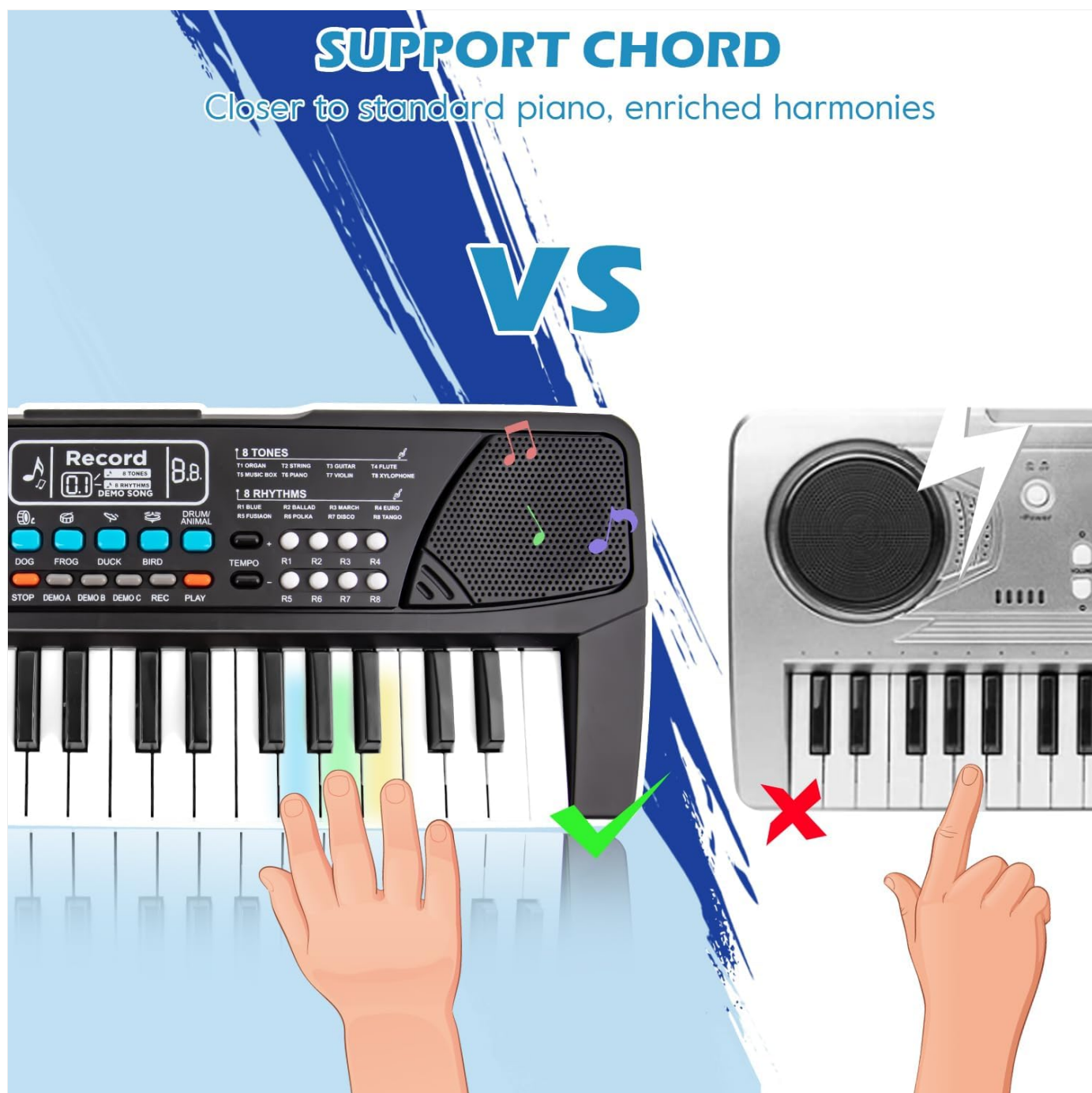


Image: A hand playing chords on the M SANMERSEN Kids Piano Keyboard, illustrating the chord support feature.

6.3. Tones and Rhythms

- **Tones:** Use the **T1-T8** buttons to select different instrument tones (e.g., Piano, Organ, Violin, Trumpet).
- **Rhythms:** Use the **R1-R8** buttons to select various rhythm patterns (e.g., Rock, Disco, March).

6.4. Drum and Animal Sounds

Press the dedicated buttons for **Drum/Animal** sounds to add percussive elements or fun animal noises (Dog, Frog, Duck, Bird) to your music.

6.5. Volume and Tempo Control

- **Volume:** Adjust the overall sound level using the **Volume +/-** buttons.
- **Tempo:** Modify the speed of rhythms and demo songs using the **Tempo +/-** buttons.

6.6. Recording and Playback

To record your performance, press the **REC** button. Play your desired notes. To stop recording, press **STOP**. To listen to your recorded melody, press the **PLAY** button.

6.7. Using the Microphone

Once connected, the microphone allows you to sing along while playing the keyboard. Adjust the keyboard's volume to balance the sound of your voice with the music.

7. MAINTENANCE

8. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Keyboard does not turn on.	No power, batteries depleted, or USB cable not connected properly.	Replace batteries or ensure USB cable is securely connected to a working power source.
No sound from speakers.	Volume too low or mute.	Increase volume using the Volume + button.
Microphone not working.	Microphone not plugged in correctly or faulty.	Ensure microphone is fully inserted into its jack. Test with another microphone if available.
Keys are unresponsive.	Low battery power or internal issue.	Replace batteries or try USB power. If problem persists, contact customer support.
