INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential information for the proper installation, operation, and maintenance of your Pioneer Carrozzeria AVIC-RZ06 Hands-Free Voice Recognition Microphone. This microphone is designed to enable voice control and hands-free communication features on compatible car navigation systems. Please read this manual thoroughly before use to ensure safe and effective operation.

PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Pioneer Carrozzeria AVIC-RZ06 microphone is a genuine accessory for your car navigation system, enabling voice commands and hands-free calling. It includes the microphone unit, a clip for secure placement, and double-sided tape for installation.

SETUP AND INSTALLATION

Follow these steps for proper installation of your microphone:

- 1. Choose a Mounting Location:** Select a location that allows clear voice pickup and does not obstruct your view or vehicle controls. Common locations include the sun visor, dashboard, or A-pillar.
- 2. Secure the Microphone:** Use the provided microphone clip to attach the microphone to the chosen location. For a more permanent fixture, use the included double-sided tape.
- 3. Route the Cable:** Carefully route the microphone cable to your car navigation unit. Ensure the cable is not pinched, stretched, or exposed to moving parts. Use the included cord clamps to secure the cable along its path.
- 4. Connect to Navigation Unit:** Plug the microphone's 3.5mm jack into the designated microphone input port on your Pioneer Carrozzeria AVIC-RZ06 navigation system.

Important Note:

The microphone's wiring is delicate. Exercise caution during installation and replacement to prevent wire breakage or damage to the microphone's plastic housing. Damage from improper handling is not covered by warranty.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Once installed, the microphone integrates with your Pioneer Carrozzeria AVIC-RZ06 navigation system for voice control and hands-free communication.

- 1. Activating Voice Control:** Refer to your car navigation system's main manual for specific instructions on how to activate voice control. Typically, this involves pressing a dedicated voice command button on the unit or steering wheel.

- 2. Speaking Commands:** Speak clearly and naturally towards the microphone. Avoid speaking too loudly or too softly. Minimize background noise for optimal recognition.
- 3. Hands-Free Calling:** When a call comes in, your navigation system will typically prompt you to answer. Use voice commands or the system's interface to accept or decline calls. Your voice will be transmitted through this microphone.
- 4. Adjusting Sensitivity:** If available, adjust the microphone sensitivity settings within your navigation system's audio menu to optimize performance for your vehicle's environment.

MAINTENANCE

The Pioneer Carrozzeria AVIC-RZ06 microphone requires minimal maintenance.

- 1. Cleaning:** Gently wipe the microphone unit with a soft, dry cloth to remove dust. Do not use liquid cleaners or abrasive materials.
- 2. Cable Inspection:** Periodically check the cable for any signs of wear, fraying, or damage. Ensure all cord clamps are securely holding the cable.
- 3. Connection Check:** Ensure the microphone jack is firmly seated in the navigation unit's port. Poor contact at the terminal can impair functionality and may require replacement.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you experience issues with your Pioneer Carrozzeria AVIC-RZ06 microphone, consider the following:

No Voice Recognition/Hands-Free Function:

- Check Connection:** Ensure the microphone's 3.5mm jack is fully and securely plugged into the car navigation system's microphone input. A loose connection can prevent operation.
- Inspect Cable:** Visually inspect the entire length of the microphone cable for any signs of damage, cuts, or severe bends. The thin wiring is susceptible to breakage, especially if mishandled during installation or removal. If damage is found, the microphone may need to be replaced.
- Terminal Contact:** Poor contact at the terminal can cause operational issues. If the connection appears secure but functionality is absent, try gently wiggling the connector or re-inserting it. If the problem persists, the terminal or microphone may be faulty and require replacement.
- Navigation System Settings:** Verify that voice control and hands-free functions are enabled in your car navigation system's settings. Refer to your navigation system's manual for details.

Poor Voice Recognition Performance:

- Microphone Placement:** Ensure the microphone is positioned correctly, facing the driver, and not obstructed by any objects.
- Background Noise:** Minimize cabin noise (e.g., close windows, turn down radio) when using voice commands.
- Speak Clearly:** Speak clearly and at a normal volume directly towards the microphone.
- Sensitivity Settings:** If your navigation system allows, adjust the microphone sensitivity to a higher or lower setting as needed.
