1. Introduction

2. Safety Information

For your safety, always follow these basic precautions when using electrical appliances, especially when children are present. Keep away from water. Do not use while bathing. Do not place or store appliance where it can fall or be pulled into a tub or sink. Do not place in or drop into water or other liquid. If an appliance falls into water, unplug it immediately. Do not reach into the water. Always unplug this appliance immediately after using it.

- This appliance is hot when in use. Do not let eyes or bare skin touch heated surfaces.

4. Setup

1. Unpack the flat iron and ensure all components are present.
2. Plug the appliance into a suitable electrical outlet. The universal dual voltage feature allows for use in various regions.
3. Press and hold the power button to turn on the appliance. The digital display will illuminate.

5. Operating Instructions

The Hot Tools Pro Signature Flat Iron offers precise temperature control and quick heating for efficient styling.

5.1. Temperature Settings

- The flat iron heats up in less than 30 seconds.
- Use the digital display and control buttons to select your desired temperature, ranging up to 450°F.

- **Tip:** Always start with a lower heat setting to minimize potential heat damage, then increase if necessary for your hair type.

5.2. Styling Your Hair

1. Ensure hair is clean, dry, and detangled. For best results, apply a heat protectant spray.
2. Divide your hair into manageable sections.
3. Take a small section of hair and place it between the ceramic plates, close to the roots.
4. Gently clamp the plates together and glide the flat iron slowly down the hair section, from roots to ends.
5. For curled ends, utilize the rounded plate edges by rotating the iron slightly as you reach the ends of the hair section.
6. Repeat for all sections until desired style is achieved.

5.3. Auto Shut-Off

The flat iron features a 2-hour automatic shut-off for enhanced safety and peace of mind. If left unattended for two hours, the appliance will power down automatically.

5.4. Dual Voltage

This appliance is equipped with universal dual voltage, making it suitable for international travel. No voltage converter is needed, though a plug adapter may be required depending on the country.

6. Maintenance

To ensure the longevity and optimal performance of your Hot Tools flat iron, follow these maintenance guidelines:

- Always unplug the appliance and allow it to cool completely before cleaning.
- Wipe the plates and exterior surfaces with a soft, damp cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- Ensure no moisture enters the internal components.

- Store the appliance in a cool, dry place, away from direct sunlight and moisture.
- Do not wrap the cord tightly around the appliance, as this can damage the cord.

7. Troubleshooting

If you encounter any issues with your Hot Tools flat iron, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Appliance does not turn on.	Not plugged in correctly, power outlet issue, or internal fault.	Check power connection. Try a different outlet. If problem persists, contact customer support.
Appliance not heating up.	Temperature not set, or internal heating element issue.	Ensure desired temperature is set on the digital display. Allow adequate time to heat.
Hair is snagging or pulling.	Hair not properly detangled, or plates are dirty.	Ensure hair is fully detangled before styling. Clean plates as per maintenance instructions.
Auto shut-off activates too soon.	Appliance left idle for 2 hours.	This is a safety feature. Simply turn the appliance back on if you wish to continue styling.
