1. Introduction

This manual provides detailed instructions to help you set up and operate your new alarm clock, ensuring you can fully utilize all its features, including the large LED display, adjustable brightness, multi-color night light, and convenient USB charging ports. Please read this manual thoroughly before use and keep it for future reference.

3. Product Overview

Table 3.1: Key Features and Controls

No.	Feature/Control	Description
1	Clear Large Display	7.5-inch LED display for easy time reading.
2	Time Setting Buttons	Buttons on top for setting hour and minute.
3	Snooze Button / Night Light Control	Press for 9-minute snooze. Tap to change night light color. Press and hold to turn night light on/off.
4	DST Switch	Toggle for Daylight Saving Time adjustment.

No.	Feature/Control	Description
5	Time Format Switch	Switch between 12-hour and 24-hour display.
6	Alarm Volume Control	Slider to adjust alarm volume (Low-Medium-High).
7	Alarm ON/OFF Switch	Toggle to enable or disable the alarm.
8	Alarm Pause Button	Dedicated button to pause the alarm for the day.
9	Dual USB Charging Ports	Two USB ports for charging external devices.
10	Battery Backup Compartment	Holds 2 AAA batteries for time and alarm settings retention during power outages.
11	Dimmer Slider	Adjusts the brightness of the LED display from 0-100%.

4. Setup

4.1 Power Connection

- 1. Unpack the alarm clock and power adapter from the box.
- 2. Insert the DC plug of the power adapter into the DC IN port on the back of the alarm clock.
- 3. Plug the power adapter into a standard electrical outlet. The display will light up.

4.2 Battery Backup Installation

The alarm clock requires 2 AAA batteries (not included) for backup power. This ensures that time and alarm settings are retained during a power outage, though the display will not be visible.




Figure 4.1: Battery Backup Compartment

- 1. Open the battery compartment cover on the back of the clock.
- 2. Insert 2 new AAA batteries, observing the correct polarity (+ and -) as indicated inside the compartment.
- 3. Close the battery compartment cover securely.

5. Operating Instructions

5.1 Setting the Time

- 1. Press the **SET TIME** button on the back of the clock. The hour digits will begin to flash.
- 2. Use the **HOUR** and **MINUTE** buttons on the top of the clock to adjust the time.
- 3. Press **SET TIME** again to confirm the setting.

5.2 Setting the Alarm

- 1. Press the **SET ALARM** button on the back of the clock. The alarm hour digits will flash.
- 2. Use the **HOUR** and **MINUTE** buttons on the top to set your desired alarm time.
- 3. Press SET ALARM again to confirm.
- 4. Ensure the ALARM ON/OFF switch on the back is set to 'ON'.

5.3 Adjusting Alarm Volume

Use the **ALARM VOLUME** slider on the back of the clock to select between Low, Medium, or High volume settings for the alarm buzzer.

5.4 Adjusting Display Brightness

The clock features a 0-100% dimmable display. Use the **DIMMER** slider on the back of the clock to adjust the brightness to your preference, from completely off to full brightness.




Figure 5.1: Adjustable Display Brightness

5.5 Using the 7-Color Night Light

The clock includes a built-in night light with 7 selectable colors.

- To turn the night light ON/OFF: Press and hold the SNOOZE button on top of the clock.
- To change the night light color: Tap the SNOOZE button repeatedly to cycle through the 7 available colors.

5.6 Snooze Function

When the alarm sounds, press the large **SNOOZE** button on the top of the clock to temporarily silence the alarm for 9 minutes. The alarm will sound again after 9 minutes.

5.7 Alarm Pause

To turn off the alarm for the current day without affecting the alarm setting for subsequent days, press the dedicated red **ALARM PAUSE** button on the back of the clock. The alarm will reset for the next scheduled time.

5.8 12/24 Hour Format

Use the **TIME FORMAT** switch on the back of the clock to toggle between 12-hour (AM/PM) and 24-hour display formats.

5.9 Daylight Saving Time (DST) Adjustment

To adjust for Daylight Saving Time, use the **DST** switch on the back of the clock. This will automatically add or subtract one hour from the current time.

5.10 Using Dual USB Charging Ports

The alarm clock is equipped with two USB charging ports (USB-A and USB-C) to charge your electronic devices while you sleep.




Figure 5.3: Dual USB Charging Ports

- Connect your device's USB charging cable to one of the USB ports on the back of the alarm clock.
- Connect the other end of the cable to your device. Charging will begin automatically.

6. Maintenance

- To clean the clock, wipe it with a soft, dry cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- Keep the clock away from direct sunlight, extreme temperatures, and high humidity.
- Do not disassemble the clock. This will void the warranty.

7. Troubleshooting

Table 7.1: Common Issues and Solutions

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Display is blank.	No power connection or power outage.	Ensure power adapter is securely plugged in. Check power outlet. If power outage, display will be off but settings retained with backup batteries.
Alarm does not sound.	Alarm is OFF or volume is too low.	Check the ALARM ON/OFF switch on the back. Adjust ALARM VOLUME slider.
Time/Alarm settings reset after power outage.	Backup batteries are not installed or are depleted.	Install or replace 2 AAA backup batteries.
Night light not working or stuck on one color.	Night light is OFF or button not pressed correctly.	Press and hold the SNOOZE button to turn ON. Tap to cycle colors.
USB charging not working.	Cable issue or device not compatible.	Ensure cable is properly connected. Try a different USB cable or device.
