

4. Setup Instructions

- 1. **Prepare Components:** Ensure you have all four mobile posts, the desired shelving units, and appropriate casters (if not already attached to the posts).
- 2. **Attach Casters (if applicable):** If your posts do not have pre-installed casters, securely screw or insert the casters into the bottom of each mobile post. Ensure they are tightened to prevent wobbling.
- 3. Position Posts: Stand the four posts upright in the desired location for your shelving unit.
- 4. **Install First Shelf:** Determine the desired height for your bottom shelf. Slide the shelf collars onto each post at the chosen height, aligning them with the double grooves for even placement. Then, lower the shelf onto the collars, ensuring it locks securely into place.
- 5. **Install Subsequent Shelves:** Repeat the process for additional shelves, using the double grooves on the posts to maintain consistent spacing and alignment.
- 6. Verify Stability: Once all shelves are installed, gently push on the unit to ensure it is stable and all components are

5. Operating Your Mobile Shelving Unit

Once assembled, your mobile shelving unit can be easily moved by pushing or pulling it to the desired location. Ensure the casters are unlocked for movement and locked when the unit needs to remain stationary. Avoid overloading shelves beyond their rated capacity to maintain stability and prevent damage.

6. Maintenance

- Cleaning: Wipe down the posts regularly with a damp cloth and mild detergent. The METROseal 3 coating with Microban is designed to resist microbial growth, but regular cleaning helps maintain hygiene and appearance. Avoid abrasive cleaners or harsh chemicals that could damage the coating.
- **Inspection:** Periodically check all connections, especially where shelves attach to the posts and where casters attach to the posts, to ensure they remain tight and secure.
- Caster Care: If using casters, keep them free of debris and lubricate them periodically if they become difficult to roll.

7. Troubleshooting

- · Unit is Wobbly:
 - Ensure all shelves are properly seated on their collars and that the collars are securely fastened to the posts.
 - Verify that casters (if used) are fully tightened and functioning correctly.
 - · Check that the unit is on a level surface.

. Missing Parts:

 If any parts, such as leveling feet or top caps, are expected but missing, please contact METRO customer support or your retailer immediately.

• Difficulty Moving Unit:

- · Ensure caster locks are disengaged.
- $\circ\,$ Check casters for debris or damage. Clean or replace as necessary.
