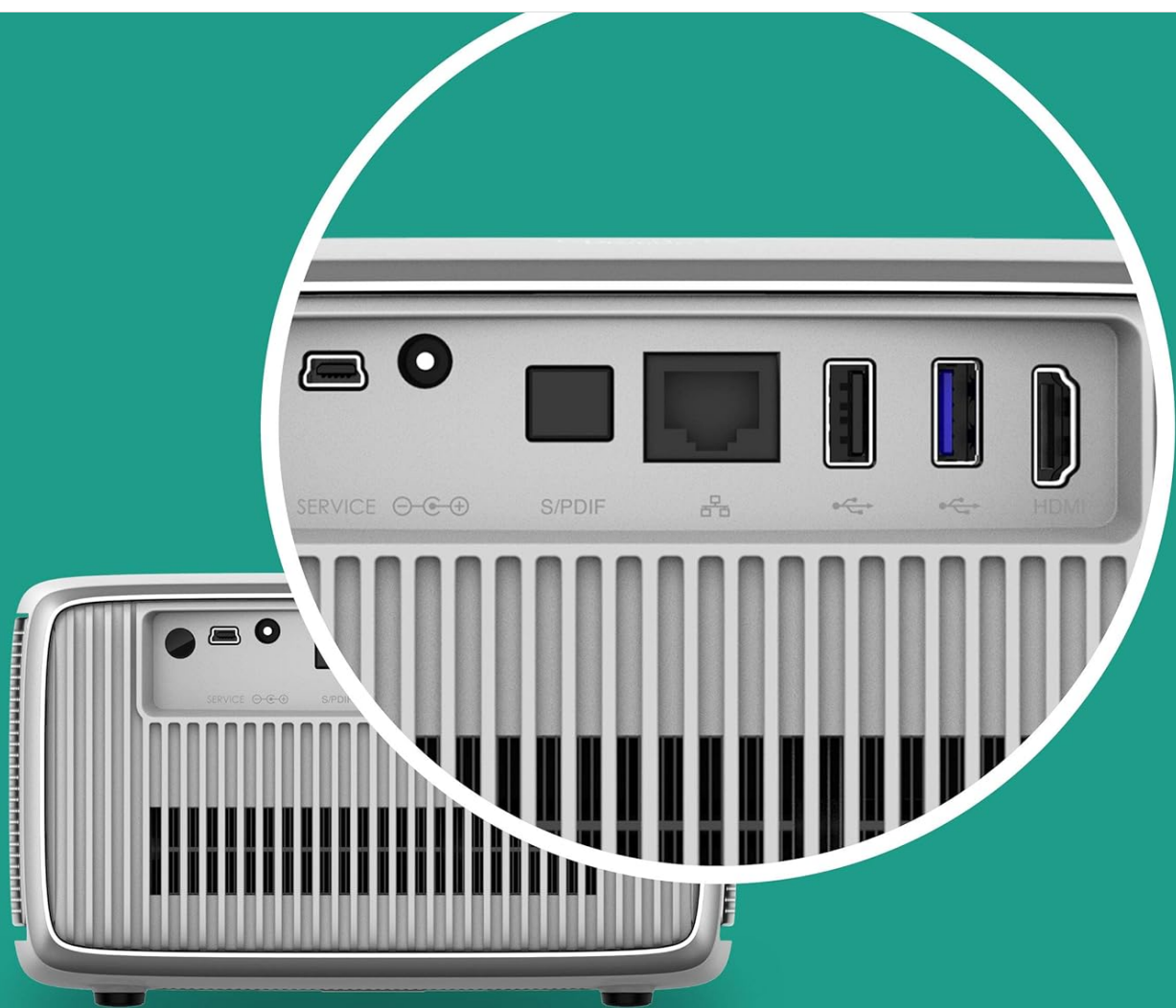

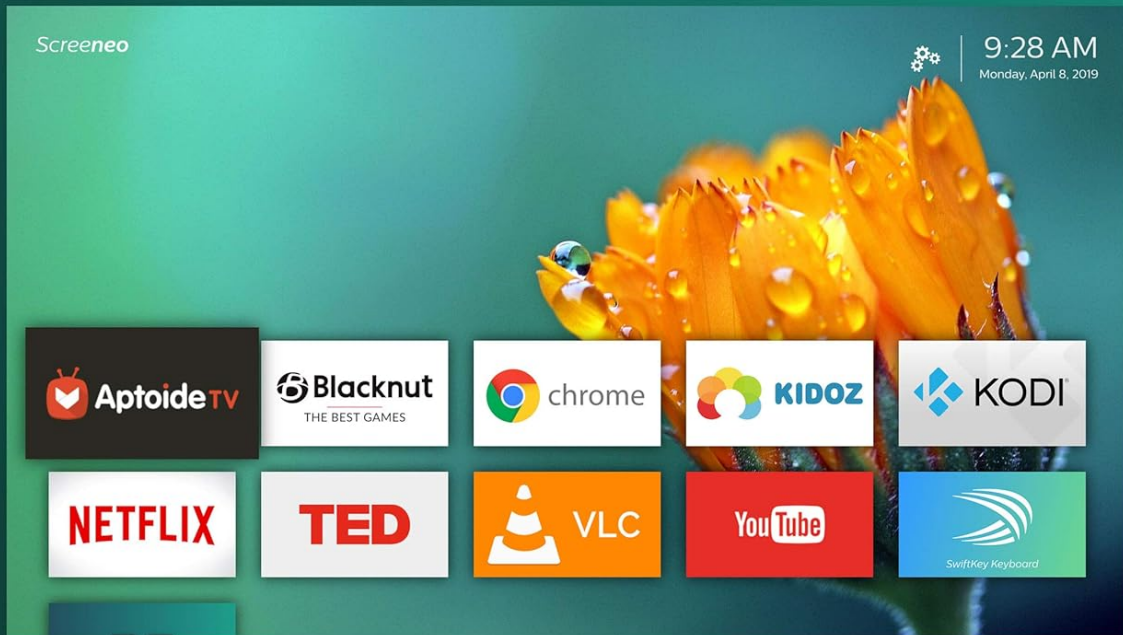
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### Power On/Off

The built-in media player allows direct playback from USB drives. Wi-Fi screen mirroring enables content sharing from compatible devices.

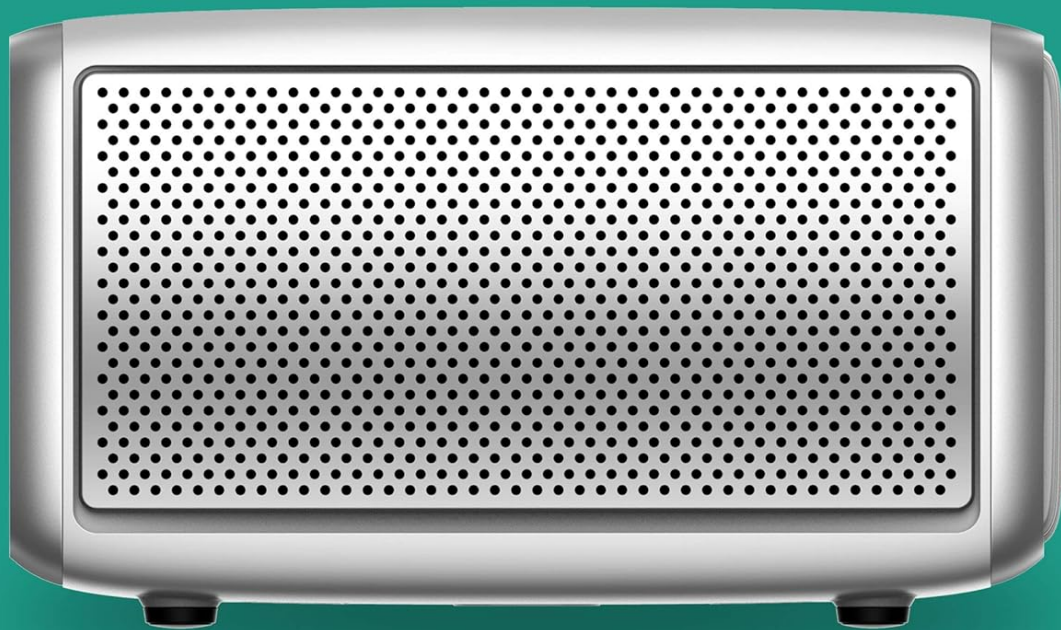

## 6. MAINTENANCE

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### Cleaning the Projector

- **Lens:** Use a soft, lint-free cloth specifically designed for optical lenses. Do not use abrasive cleaners.
- **Casing:** Wipe the exterior with a soft, dry cloth. For stubborn marks, dampen the cloth slightly with water.
- **Ventilation Grilles:** Use a soft brush or compressed air to remove dust from the ventilation grilles.

Always ensure the projector is turned off and unplugged before cleaning.

## 7. TROUBLESHOOTING

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If you encounter issues with your projector, refer to the following common solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No image displayed	Loose cable connection, incorrect input source, projector off.	Check all cable connections. Select the correct input source. Ensure projector is powered on.
Image is blurry	Out of focus, incorrect projection distance.	Adjust the focus ring on the lens. Adjust the projector's distance from the screen.
No sound	Volume too low, muted, external audio device not connected.	Increase volume. Check mute settings. Ensure external audio device is properly connected and powered.
Projector overheats	Blocked ventilation, prolonged use.	Ensure ventilation grilles are clear. Turn off the projector and allow it to cool down.
