1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides instructions for the safe and proper installation, operation, and maintenance of your Happybuy Picket #4 Wrought Iron Handrail. This handrail is designed for outdoor steps, specifically fitting 4 or 5 stair risers, and is constructed from durable wrought iron with a matte black powder coating.

Please read this manual thoroughly before installation and retain it for future reference.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

- Always wear appropriate personal protective equipment (PPE) during installation, including safety glasses, gloves, and sturdy footwear.
- Ensure the mounting surface (concrete, wood, etc.) is structurally sound and capable of supporting the handrail and anticipated loads.
- Use the correct tools for drilling and fastening to prevent damage to the handrail or the mounting surface.
- Verify all fasteners are securely tightened after installation to ensure stability.
- Do not modify the handrail structure, as this may compromise its integrity and safety.
- Keep children and pets away from the installation area.

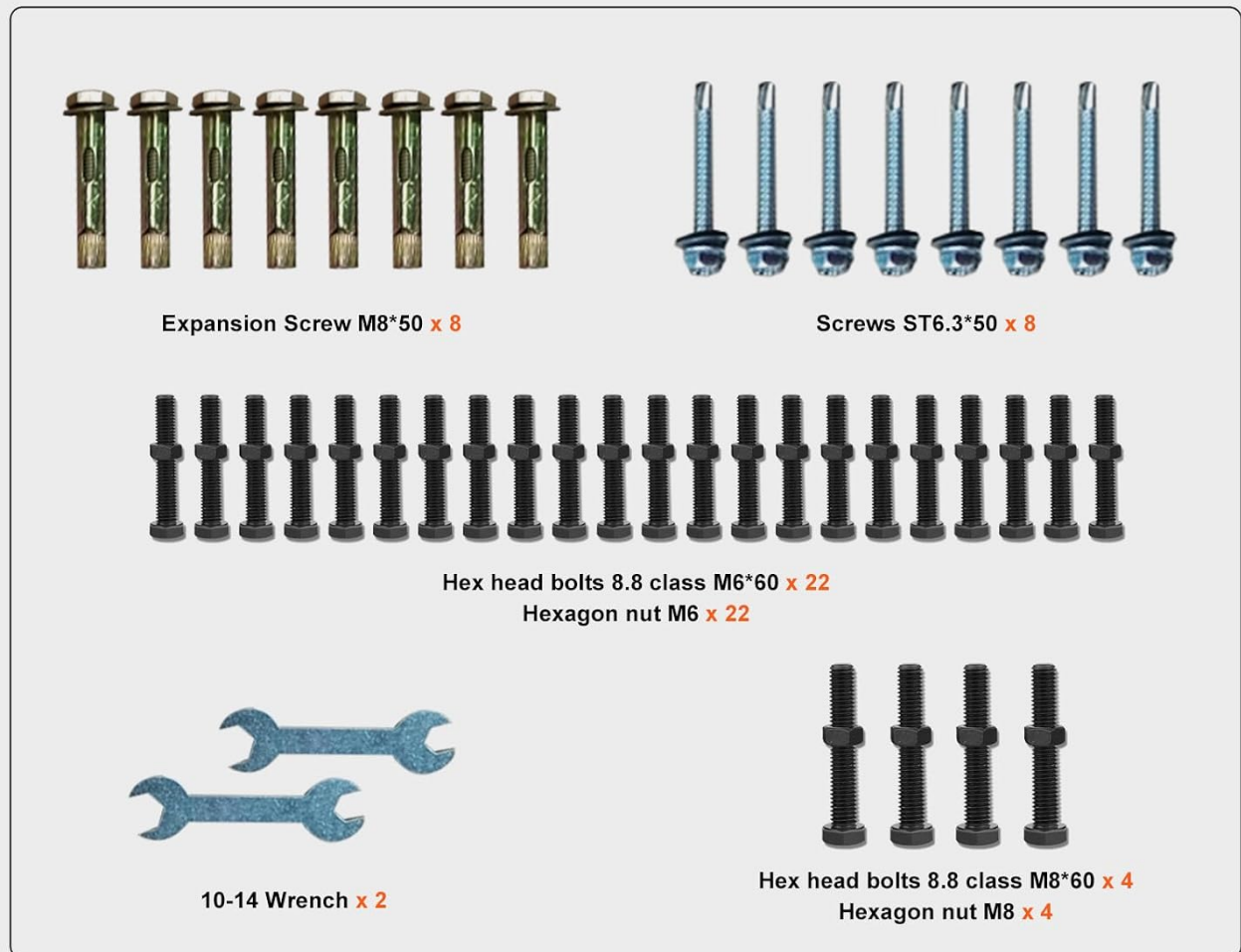


Figure 3.1: Complete Accessories for Installation

4. SETUP AND INSTALLATION

The Happybuy Picket #4 Handrail is designed for straightforward installation on 4 or 5 step outdoor stair risers. The

kit provides all necessary hardware for concrete steps. For wooden stairs, appropriate wood fasteners (not included) may be required.

4.1 Tools Required (Not Included)

- Pencil or marker
- Drill (hammer drill recommended for concrete)
- Drill bits (appropriate size for anchors, e.g., 3/8" masonry bit for concrete)
- Hammer
- Level
- Measuring tape
- Adjustable wrench or socket set (for hex bolts)

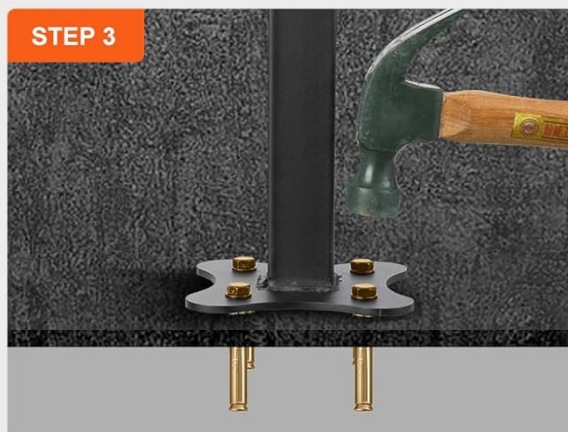

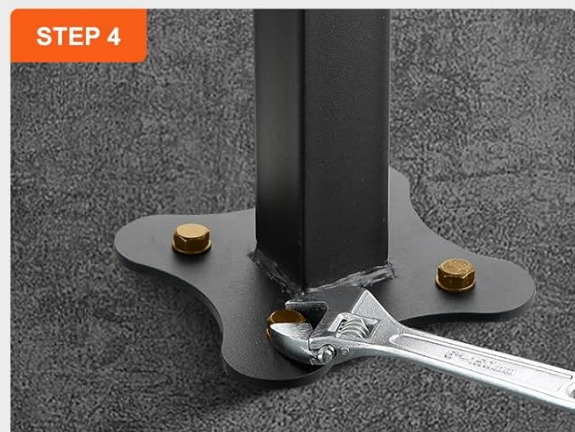

1. Step 1: Mark Hole Positions

Position the handrail on your steps to determine the desired location. Use a pencil or marker to mark the drilling points through the base plates of the handrail posts onto the step surface. Ensure the handrail is level and correctly aligned with the stairs.

2. Step 2: Drill Holes

Using an appropriate drill bit (e.g., 3/8" masonry bit for concrete), drill holes at the marked positions. The depth of the holes should match the length of the expansion screws or anchors provided.

3. Step 3: Install Bolts/Anchors

Insert the expansion screws or anchors into the drilled holes. For expansion anchors, ensure the expander insert is started into the sleeve before placing it in the hole to allow proper tightening. Gently tap them into place with a hammer if necessary.

4. Step 4: Secure with Metal Anchors

Align the handrail base plates over the installed anchors. Insert the bolts through the base plate holes and into the anchors. Tighten all bolts securely using the provided wrenches or your own tools. Ensure the handrail is firm and stable before use.

4.3 Important Considerations

- The handrail is designed to span 4 stair risers and measures approximately 4 feet post to post. This length is unadjustable.
- The angle of the handrail can be adjusted to fit different step heights.
- For optimal stability, ensure the handrail is level and all fasteners are fully tightened.
- If installing on wooden steps, use appropriate wood lag screws or bolts (not included) that are suitable for outdoor use and the thickness of your wood.

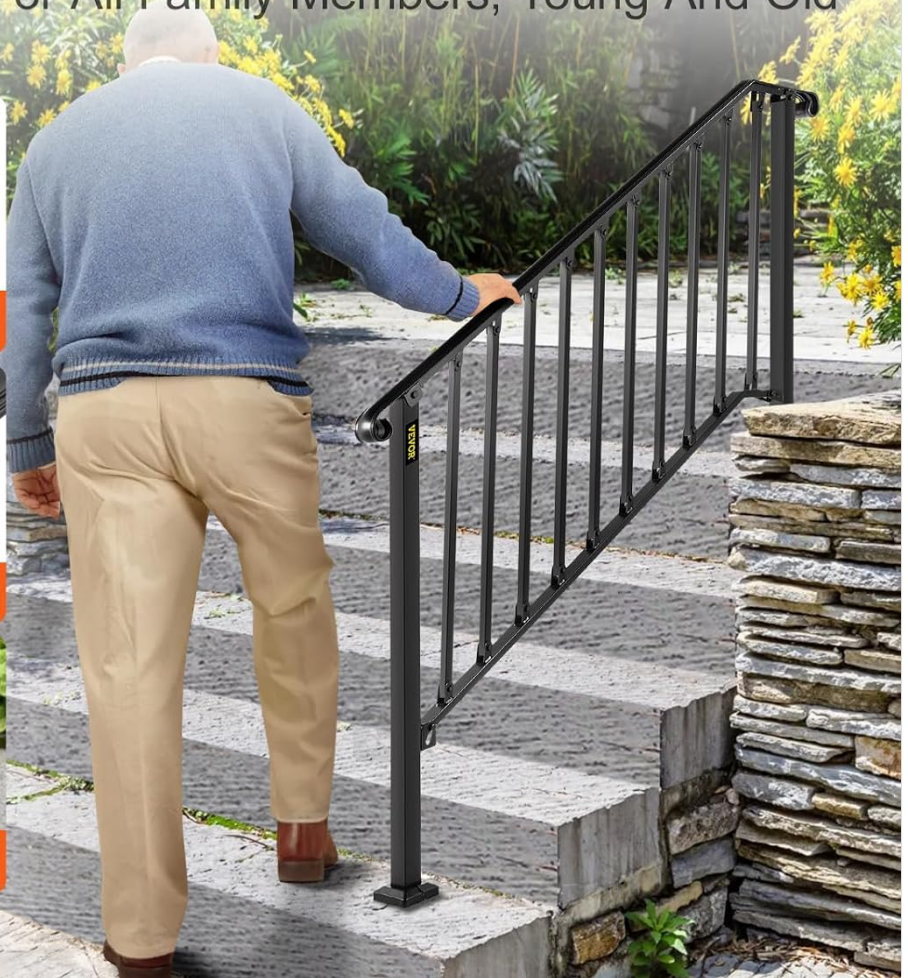


Figure 5.1: Handrail in Use

6. MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance will ensure the longevity and continued safe operation of your Happybuy handrail.

- **Cleaning:** The powder-coated surface is easy to clean. Use a soft cloth with mild soap and water to wipe down the handrail. Avoid abrasive cleaners or harsh chemicals that could damage the finish.
- **Inspection:** Periodically inspect all bolts and connections to ensure they remain tight. Re-tighten any loose fasteners.
- **Rust Prevention:** Although constructed from wrought iron with a powder coating for durability and rust resistance, inspect for any chips or scratches in the finish. Touch up any damaged areas with rust-inhibiting

paint to prevent corrosion, especially in harsh weather conditions.

- **Drainage:** Ensure that water does not accumulate in any open sections of the posts, as this can lead to internal rusting. If necessary, consider drilling small drainage holes at the lowest point of the posts, though this is not a manufacturer-specified modification.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Handrail feels wobbly after installation.	Fasteners are not sufficiently tightened; incorrect anchor installation; unstable mounting surface.	Re-tighten all bolts. Ensure expansion anchors are properly seated and expanded. Verify the structural integrity of the steps.
Difficulty drilling into concrete.	Incorrect drill bit type or size; insufficient drill power.	Use a hammer drill with a new, sharp masonry drill bit of the correct diameter (e.g., 3/8 inch).
Rust spots appearing on the handrail.	Damage to the powder coating exposing bare metal; water accumulation inside posts.	Clean the rust, sand lightly, and apply rust-inhibiting paint to the affected area. Consider drilling small drainage holes at the bottom of posts if water is accumulating.
Missing parts in the package.	Packaging error.	Contact Happybuy customer support with your purchase details.
