INTRODUCTION

This manual provides comprehensive instructions for the safe and efficient operation of your OPPO Reno 10x Zoom smartphone. Please read this manual thoroughly before using the device to ensure optimal performance and longevity.

PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The OPPO Reno 10x Zoom is a high-performance smartphone designed for advanced photography and mobile entertainment. Key features include a powerful camera system, a large AMOLED display, and robust processing capabilities.

WHAT'S IN THE BOX

Upon unboxing your OPPO Reno 10x Zoom, verify that all components are present:

- OPPO Reno 10x Zoom Smartphone
- SIM Tray Ejector Tool
- USB Type-C Cable (for charging and data transfer)
- Power Adapter
- User Manual (this document)
- Protective Case (may vary by region)

SETUP

1. Inserting SIM Cards and microSD Card

The OPPO Reno 10x Zoom supports dual-SIM functionality and a microSD card for expandable storage (uses shared SIM slot).

1. Locate the SIM card tray on the side of the device.
2. Insert the SIM tray ejector tool into the small hole next to the tray and push gently until the tray pops out.
3. Place your Nano-SIM card(s) and/or microSD card into the designated slots on the tray. Ensure the gold contacts face downwards.
4. Carefully push the tray back into the slot until it is flush with the device.

Important Note: This smartphone is compatible with GSM networks such as AT&T and T-Mobile. It will **NOT** work with CDMA networks like Verizon, Sprint, or US Cellular. Verify network compatibility with your provider before use.

2. Initial Power On and Setup Wizard

1. Press and hold the Power button (located on the right side) until the OPPO logo appears.
2. Follow the on-screen instructions to complete the initial setup, including language selection, Wi-Fi connection, Google account setup, and fingerprint registration.

OPERATING YOUR SMARTPHONE

1. Display and Navigation

The device features a 6.6-inch AMOLED capacitive touchscreen with a resolution of 1080 x 2340 pixels, protected by

Corning Gorilla Glass 6. Navigation is primarily touch-based.

In-Display Fingerprint Sensor: To unlock your device, place your registered finger on the illuminated fingerprint icon on the screen. The sensor is designed for quick and reliable authentication.

2. Camera Features

The OPPO Reno 10x Zoom boasts a versatile triple camera system and a unique pop-up front camera.

- **Rear Cameras:**

- 48 MP, f/1.7, 26mm (wide), 1/2.0", 0.8µm, Laser/PDAF, OIS (Sony IMX586 sensor)
- Periscope 13 MP, f/3.0, 130mm (telephoto), 5x optical zoom, Laser/PDAF, OIS
- 8 MP, f/2.2, 16mm (ultrawide)

- **Front Camera:** Motorized pop-up 16 MP, f/2.0, 26mm (wide)

The camera system offers 5x optical zoom and up to 10x hybrid zoom, providing exceptional detail even at long distances.

The "Shark-fin" pop-up mechanism for the front camera also houses a front-facing flash and earpiece.

3. Battery and Charging

The device is equipped with a 4065 mAh Lithium Polymer battery. It supports fast charging via the USB Type-C port. To charge, connect the provided USB Type-C cable to the phone and the power adapter, then plug the adapter into a wall outlet.

Note: This device does not support wireless charging.

MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, lint-free cloth to clean the screen and body of the phone. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive materials.
- **Software Updates:** Regularly check for and install system updates to ensure optimal performance, security, and access to new features. Navigate to *Settings > Software Update*.
- **Storage Management:** Periodically clear unnecessary files and applications to maintain sufficient storage space and device speed.
- **Physical Protection:** While the screen is protected by Corning Gorilla Glass 6, using a screen protector and a protective case is recommended to prevent scratches and damage from drops.
- **Water and Dust Resistance:** This device is **not** IP-rated for water and dust resistance. Avoid exposure to liquids and excessive dust to prevent damage.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Solution
Device not powering on	Ensure the battery is charged. Press and hold the Power button for at least 10 seconds to force restart.
Apps freezing or crashing	Close background apps. Clear app cache (Settings > App Management > [App Name] > Storage Usage > Clear Cache). Restart the device.
Poor camera image quality	Ensure camera lens is clean. Check lighting conditions. Use Night Mode in low light.
Fingerprint sensor not responding	Ensure your finger and the screen are clean and dry. Re-register your fingerprint if issues persist.
Network connectivity issues	Check SIM card insertion. Toggle Airplane Mode on/off. Restart the device. Verify network compatibility (GSM only).
