SETUP

The Pongori TTR 100 table tennis bat comes pre-assembled and ready for immediate use. No complex setup or assembly is required.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The Pongori TTR 100 bat is designed for all-round play, focusing on control and spin. Here are general guidelines for effective use:

- **Grip:** Hold the bat firmly but comfortably. The handle is designed for a natural grip, allowing for wrist flexibility.
- **Spin Control:** The tacky rubber surface allows for imparting spin on the ball. For topspin, brush upwards on the ball. For backspin, brush downwards.
- **Ball Control:** Focus on the angle of the bat face upon impact to direct the ball accurately. The bat's design aids in controlling the ball's trajectory.
- **Practice:** Consistent practice is key to mastering control and spin with this bat.

MAINTENANCE

Proper maintenance will extend the life and performance of your table tennis bat.

- **Cleaning the Rubber:** After each use, gently wipe the rubber surface with a damp, soft cloth to remove dust and sweat. Avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive materials, as they can damage the rubber.
- **Storage:** Store the bat in a cool, dry place, away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures. Using a bat cover (not included) is recommended to protect the rubber from dust and damage.
- **Handle Care:** Keep the wooden handle dry. If it becomes dirty, wipe it with a slightly damp cloth and dry immediately.
- **Avoid Impact:** Do not drop the bat or hit it against hard surfaces, as this can damage the wood blade or rubber.

TROUBLESHOOTING

This section addresses common concerns you might encounter with your table tennis bat.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Reduced Spin/Tackiness	Dust, dirt, or oil buildup on the rubber surface.	Clean the rubber surface with a damp, soft cloth. For stubborn dirt, use a specialized table tennis rubber cleaner.
Rubber Peeling/Bubbling	Exposure to extreme temperatures, improper storage, or excessive moisture.	Ensure proper storage in a cool, dry place. If damage is significant, the rubber may need replacement (professional service recommended).
Handle feels slippery	Sweat or dirt on the handle.	Wipe the handle with a dry or slightly damp cloth. Ensure hands are clean and dry before playing.
