PRODUCT OVERVIEW

SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

Assembly of the alazyhome Metal Bed Frame is designed to be straightforward. It is recommended to assemble the bed frame with two people.

Tools Required:

- All necessary tools are included in the screw bags.

Assembly Steps:

1. **Step 1: Unpack and Identify Parts.** Carefully remove all components from the packaging. Lay them out on a clean, soft surface (like a carpet) to prevent scratches. Identify each part using the included parts list.

OPERATING AND USAGE

The alazyhome Metal Bed Frame is designed for supporting a Queen size mattress. No box spring is required as the steel slats provide adequate support.

- Place your Queen size mattress directly onto the steel slats.
- The headboard and footboard are designed to keep the mattress securely in place, preventing it from sliding.
- Utilize the 12.6 inches of under-bed space for convenient storage of boxes, bins, or other items.

MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance will help prolong the life and appearance of your alazyhome Metal Bed Frame.

- **Cleaning:** Wipe down the metal frame with a soft, damp cloth. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners, as these can damage the finish.
- **Fastener Check:** Periodically (e.g., every 3-6 months) check all bolts and screws to ensure they remain tight. Retighten if necessary to maintain stability and prevent squeaking.
- **Floor Protection:** The bed frame is equipped with plastic pads on the bottom of the legs to protect your floor. Ensure these pads remain intact.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Bed frame is wobbly or unstable.	Loose bolts or screws.	Check and tighten all fasteners. Ensure all connections are fully secured.
Squeaking noises.	Loose connections or friction between metal parts.	Tighten all bolts. If squeaking persists, apply a small amount of silicone lubricant to connection points. Ensure plastic pads on legs are intact.
Mattress slides on the frame.	Mattress not properly seated or headboard/footboard not fully secured.	Ensure the mattress is centered and fully within the confines of the headboard and footboard. Verify headboard and footboard connections are tight.
Missing parts during assembly.	Packaging error or lost part.	Double-check all packaging materials. Contact alazyhome customer support with the specific part number from the instruction manual.
