PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The ENJOY-UNIQUE 6000CD AUX Input Cable Adapter is designed to connect external audio devices, such as iPhones, iPods, or MP3 players, to compatible Ford car stereos. This cable features a 3.5mm jack and a Quadlock connector, specifically for Ford 6000CD head units that have a central on/off/volume button and an 'AUX' button.

Important Compatibility Note: This adapter is only compatible with Ford 6000CD stereos that feature an 'AUX' button on the front panel. It is **not** compatible with 'CDDJ' stereos (those with an integrated 6-CD changer) or stereos that only have a 'SETUP' button instead of a 'MENU' button for audio source selection.

SETUP AND INSTALLATION

Installation of the AUX input cable requires access to the rear of your car's stereo unit. The package includes four radio removal keys to assist with this process.

Required Tools (Included):

- AUX Input Cable with 3.5mm Jack and Quadlock Connector
- 4x Radio Removal Keys

Installation Steps:

1. **Prepare the Stereo:** Insert the four radio removal keys into the slots on the front panel of your Ford 6000CD stereo. Apply gentle pressure outwards on the keys while pulling the stereo unit forward to release it from the dashboard.
2. **Locate the AUX Port:** Once the stereo is partially removed, locate the Quadlock connector port at the rear of the unit. This is where the AUX cable will be connected.
3. **Connect the AUX Cable:** Carefully insert the Quadlock connector of the AUX cable into the corresponding port on the back of the car stereo. Ensure it clicks securely into place.
Note: Some users have reported that the plastic housing around the Quadlock connector on the AUX cable may need to be partially removed or adjusted for a proper fit into the stereo's port. If the connector does not fit easily, inspect for any removable plastic frames on the cable's connector and adjust as necessary.
4. **Route the Cable:** Route the 3.5mm jack end of the AUX cable to a convenient location within your vehicle, such as the glove compartment or center console, ensuring it does not interfere with driving controls.
5. **Reinstall the Stereo:** Gently push the car stereo back into its dashboard slot until it locks securely. Remove the radio removal keys.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Once the AUX cable is installed, you can begin using it to play audio from your portable devices.

Connecting an Audio Device:

1. **Power On Stereo:** Turn on your Ford 6000CD car stereo.
2. **Connect Device:** Plug the 3.5mm jack of the AUX cable into the headphone or audio output port of your smartphone, MP3 player, or other audio device.
3. **Select AUX Input:** Press the 'AUX' button on the front panel of your car stereo. The stereo display should indicate that the AUX input is active.
4. **Play Audio:** Start playing audio from your connected device. The sound will now be routed through your car's speakers.

Volume Control:

Adjust the volume using the volume knob on your car stereo. You may also need to adjust the volume on your connected audio device for optimal sound levels.

Steering Wheel Controls:

While the volume control on your steering wheel may function, track change controls (next/previous) typically do not work when using a standard AUX input. To change tracks, you will need to control playback directly from your connected audio device.

MAINTENANCE

To ensure the longevity and optimal performance of your AUX input cable, follow these simple maintenance guidelines:

- **Handle with Care:** Avoid excessive bending or pulling of the cable, especially near the connectors, as this can damage internal wiring.
- **Keep Connectors Clean:** Periodically inspect the 3.5mm jack and the Quadlock connector for dust or debris. Clean gently with a dry, lint-free cloth if necessary. Do not use liquids or abrasive cleaners.
- **Store Properly:** When not in use, avoid leaving the cable tangled or in direct sunlight. Coil it loosely to prevent kinks.
- **Avoid Extreme Temperatures:** Do not expose the cable to extreme heat or cold, as this can affect the material integrity.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues while using your ENJOY-UNIQUE AUX input cable, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

No Audio or Poor Audio Quality:

- **Check Connections:** Ensure both the 3.5mm jack and the Quadlock connector are fully and securely plugged in. A loose connection can result in no sound or intermittent audio.
- **Verify AUX Button:** Confirm that you have pressed the 'AUX' button on your car stereo to select the correct input source.
- **Stereo Compatibility:** Double-check that your car stereo is a Ford 6000CD model with an 'AUX' button, not a 'CDDJ' or 'SETUP' only model. Refer to the "Product Overview" section for details.
- **Device Volume:** Ensure the volume on your connected audio device (smartphone, MP3 player) is turned up.
- **Cable Integrity:** Inspect the cable for any visible damage, such as cuts or severe kinks. If damaged, the cable may need replacement.
- **Connector Fit:** If you experienced difficulty during installation, ensure the Quadlock connector is fully seated. As noted in

the setup section, some plastic housing might need adjustment for a perfect fit.

Steering Wheel Controls for Track Change Not Working:

- This is a common limitation of standard AUX inputs. The AUX cable transmits audio signals but typically does not support data signals for track control. This is normal operation for this type of adapter.
