Navitel E200 GPS Navigation System User Manual

Model: E200T

1. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Navitel E200 is a portable GPS navigation device designed to provide reliable guidance for your journeys. It operates on a Windows CE / Linux operating system and includes a suite of features to enhance your driving experience.

Key Features

- GPS navigation system running on Windows CE / Linux operating system.
- Extensive and regularly updated speed camera database with speed limit notifications.
- Navitel Navigator software with advanced settings, including options for cargo transport navigation.
- Pre-installed offline maps for Eastern European countries: Belarus, Bulgaria, Czech Republic, Hungary, Moldova, Poland, Romania, Slovakia, and Ukraine.

2. SETUP AND INSTALLATION

2.1 Charging the Device

Before initial use, fully charge your Navitel E200 device. Connect the provided car charger to your vehicle's cigarette lighter socket and the device's charging port. Alternatively, use the USB cable to connect the device to a computer or a compatible USB power adapter.

2.2 Mounting the Device

1. Clean the desired area on your windshield to ensure a secure suction cup attachment.
2. Attach the suction cup mount to the windshield by pressing firmly and engaging the lever (if present) to create a vacuum seal.
3. Slide the Navitel E200 device onto the cradle of the mount until it clicks securely into place.
4. Adjust the angle of the device for optimal viewing without obstructing your view of the road.

3. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

3.1 Powering On/Off

- To power on: Press and hold the power button located on the device until the screen illuminates.
- To power off: Press and hold the power button until a shutdown prompt appears, then confirm. A short press will typically put the device into standby mode.

3.2 Basic Navigation

1. From the main menu, tap on the 'Navigation' or 'Destination' icon.

2. Enter your desired destination using the on-screen keyboard or stylus. You can typically input by address, point of interest (POI), or coordinates.
3. Confirm your destination. The device will calculate the route and display it on the map.
4. Follow the voice prompts and on-screen directions to reach your destination. The display will show current speed, speed limits, distance to next turn, and estimated arrival time.

3.3 Speed Camera and Speed Limit Alerts

The Navitel E200 features a built-in database of speed cameras and speed limits. The device will provide visual and audible warnings when approaching a known speed camera location or when exceeding the posted speed limit. Ensure the speed camera database is regularly updated for optimal performance.

3.4 Map Updates

To ensure accurate navigation, it is recommended to regularly update the maps on your Navitel E200. Refer to the Navitel official website or the included software instructions for detailed steps on how to download and install map updates.

4. MAINTENANCE AND CARE

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, dry, lint-free cloth to clean the device screen and body. Avoid using abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- **Storage:** Store the device in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures when not in use.
- **Battery Care:** To prolong battery life, avoid fully discharging the battery frequently. Charge the device regularly, even if not in constant use.

- **Environmental Conditions:** Do not expose the device to water, excessive humidity, or dust.

5. TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Device not powering on:** Ensure the device is fully charged. Connect it to a power source using the car charger or USB cable. If the issue persists, perform a soft reset by pressing the reset button (if available) or holding the power button for an extended period.
- **No GPS signal:** Ensure the device has a clear view of the sky. GPS signal acquisition can take longer in urban areas, tunnels, or indoors. Move to an open area and wait for the device to acquire satellites.
- **Touchscreen unresponsive:** If the touchscreen is not responding, try restarting the device. Ensure the screen is clean and free of debris. Use the provided stylus for precise input.
- **Map data outdated:** Connect the device to a computer and use the Navitel software to check for and install the latest map updates.
- **Inaccurate speed limit warnings:** While the speed camera database is regularly updated, discrepancies can occur. Always adhere to posted road signs. Ensure your map data is current.
