INTRODUCTION

This manual provides instructions for the proper use and care of your ANDTOBO 3.5mm Male to 1/4 Inch Female Stereo Audio Adapter. This adapter is designed to convert a 3.5mm (1/8 inch) stereo male plug to a 6.35mm (1/4 inch) stereo female jack, enabling connection between devices with different audio port sizes.

PRODUCT FEATURES

- **Universal Compatibility:** Connects 3.5mm male plugs to 6.35mm female jacks, suitable for headphones, amplifiers, guitars, digital pianos, audio mixers, and sound consoles.
- **Pure Copper Construction:** Manufactured from pure copper for enhanced durability and extended service life compared to plastic or gold-plated alternatives.
- **Optimal Signal Transfer:** Pure copper connectors resist corrosion, ensuring minimal signal loss and high-fidelity audio transmission.
- **Portable Design:** Compact and easy to carry, making it convenient for various audio setups.

SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

Follow these steps to correctly set up your audio adapter:

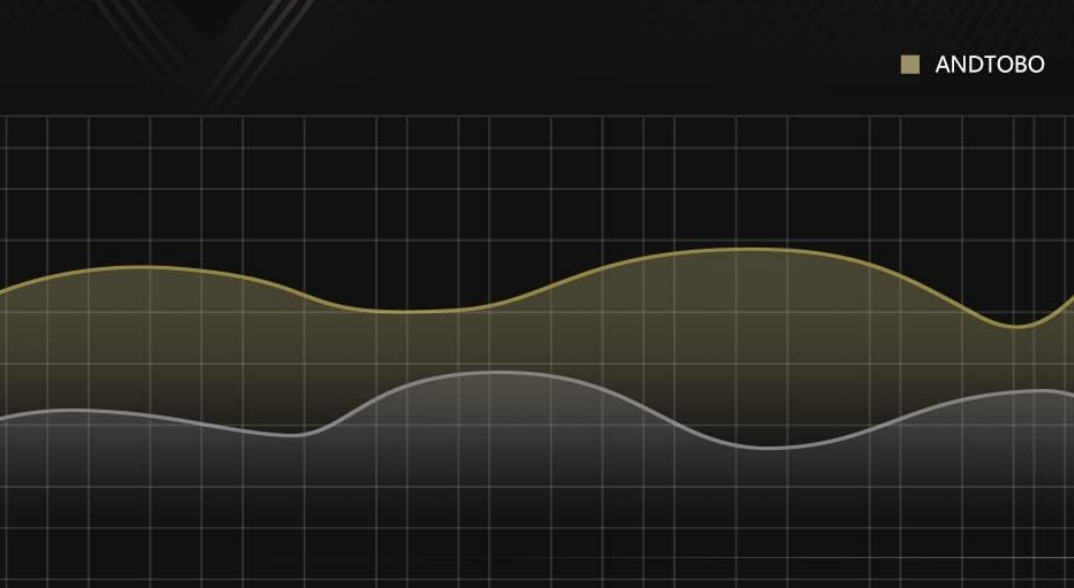
1. Identify the 3.5mm male plug (smaller end) and the 6.35mm (1/4 inch) female jack (larger end) on the adapter.
2. Insert the 3.5mm male plug of the adapter into the 3.5mm audio output port of your source device (e.g., smartphone, tablet, computer, MP3 player). Ensure it is fully inserted for a secure connection.
3. Take the 6.35mm (1/4 inch) male plug of your audio equipment (e.g., headphones, amplifier, guitar cable) and insert

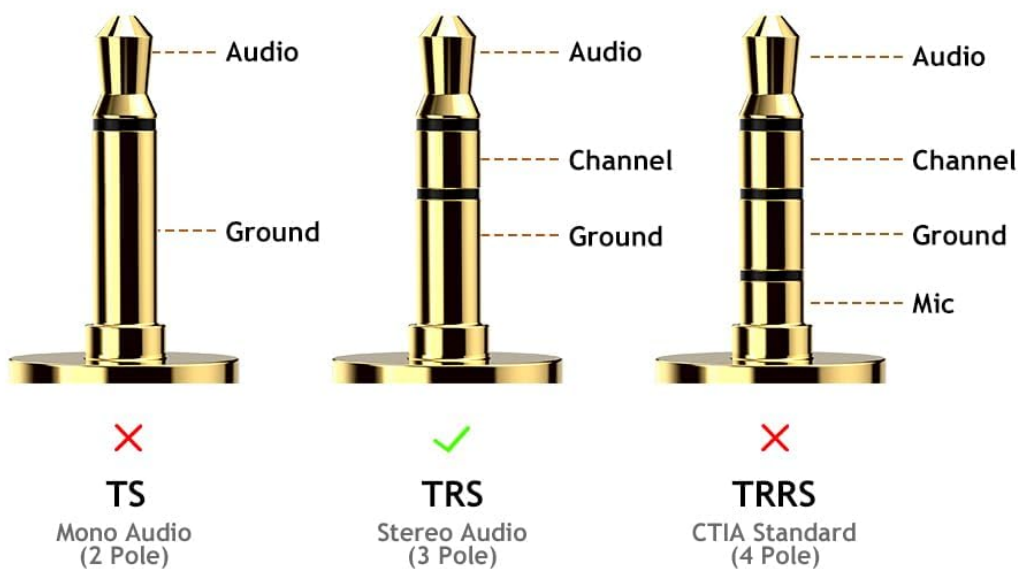
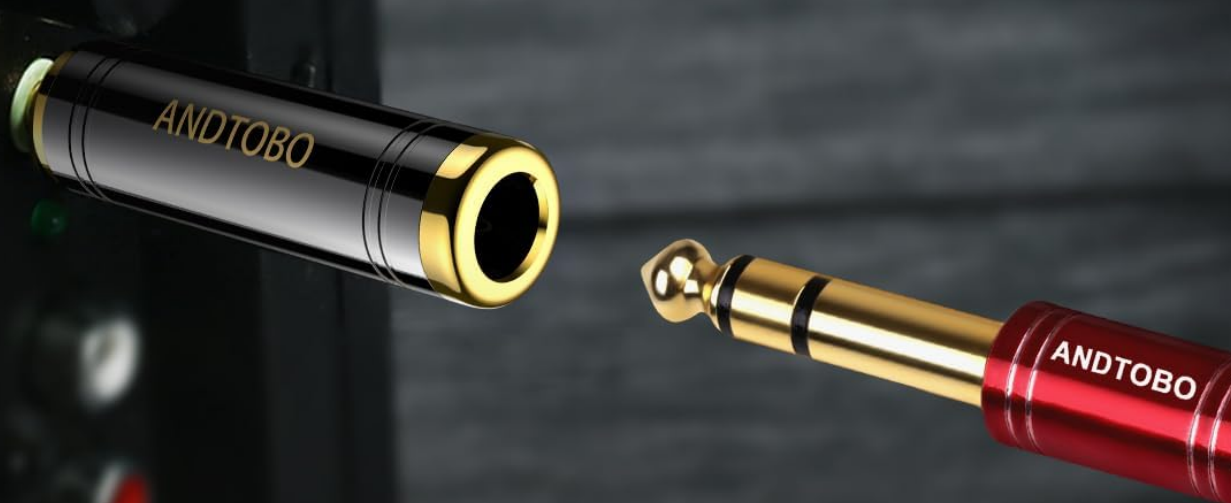


Image: Illustration of a 1/4 inch male plug being inserted into the adapter, demonstrating a secure connection.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Once the adapter is securely connected between your audio source and output device:

- Audio will automatically transmit from the 3.5mm source device to the 6.35mm receiving equipment.
- Adjust the volume directly on your source device (e.g., smartphone, computer) or on the connected audio equipment

(e.g., amplifier, headphones) to your desired level.

- The adapter supports stereo audio transmission, ensuring a full and clear sound experience.

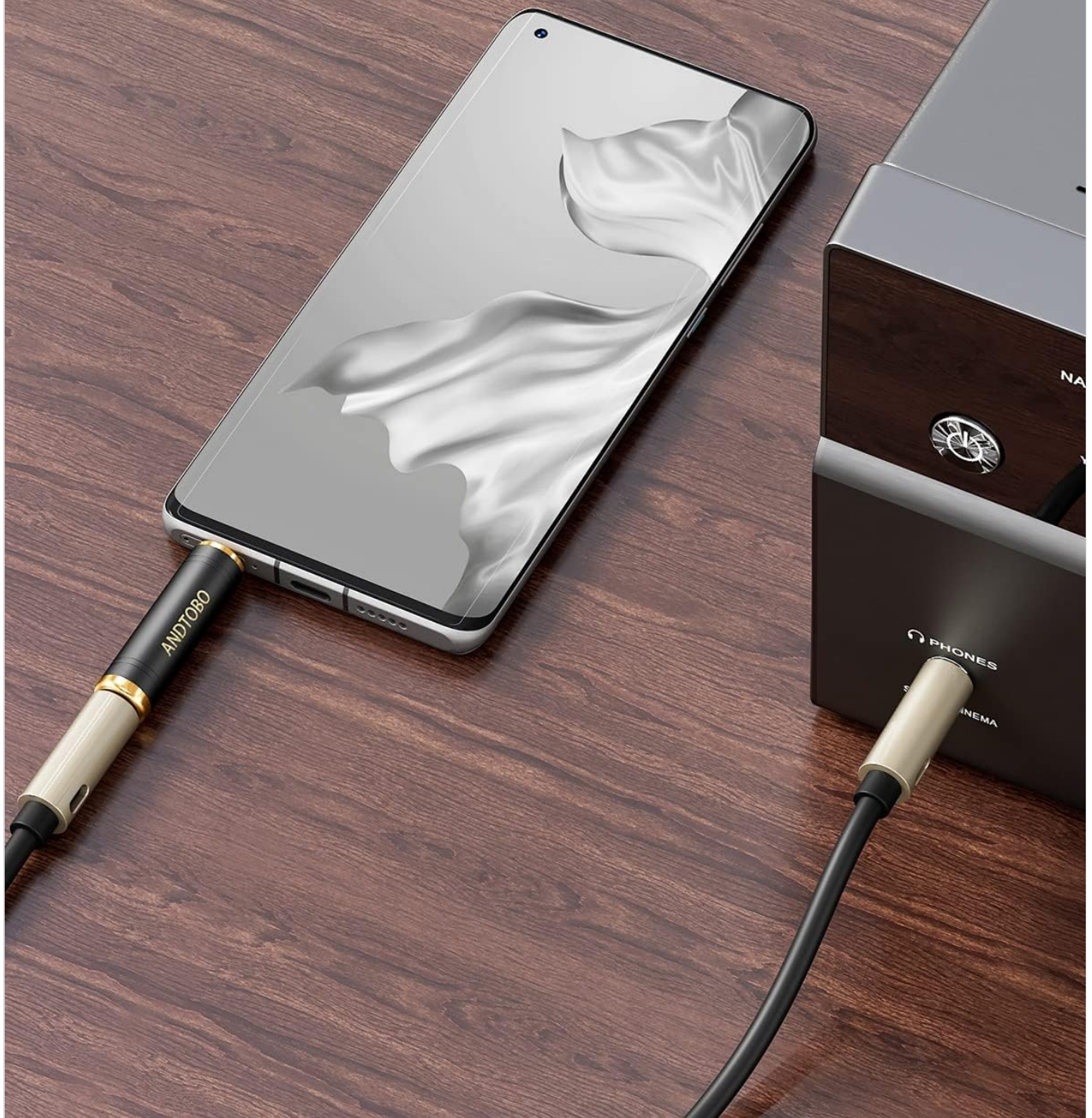


Image: A laptop connected to an electric guitar, demonstrating the adapter's use for recording or monitoring.

MAINTENANCE

To ensure the longevity and optimal performance of your ANDTOBO audio adapter, please follow these maintenance guidelines:

- Keep the adapter clean and dry. Use a soft, dry cloth to wipe away any dust or debris.

- Avoid exposing the adapter to extreme temperatures, humidity, or direct sunlight.
- When connecting or disconnecting, always grasp the adapter by its body, not by the cable, to prevent strain on the connectors.
- Store the adapter in a cool, dry place when not in use.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your adapter, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No sound or intermittent audio.	Loose connection, incorrect port, or faulty cable/device.	Ensure both the 3.5mm and 6.35mm plugs are fully and securely inserted. Verify that you are using the correct audio input/output ports on your devices. Test the adapter with different cables and devices to isolate the issue.
Poor sound quality (e.g., static, distortion).	Loose connection, damaged adapter/cable, or interference.	Check all connections for tightness. Inspect the adapter and cables for any visible damage. Ensure no other electronic devices are causing interference nearby.
Adapter does not fit.	Incorrect jack size or type.	Confirm that your devices require a 3.5mm male to 6.35mm female stereo adapter. This adapter is not designed for mono or TRRS (4-pole) connections that include a microphone.
