# Timex Women's TW2T66500 Briarwood 28mm Watch Instruction Manual

## INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential information for the setup, operation, maintenance, and troubleshooting of your Timex Women's TW2T66500 Briarwood 28mm watch. Please read these instructions carefully to ensure proper use and longevity of your timepiece.

## SETUP

### 1. Setting the Time

1. **Pull the Crown:** Gently pull the crown (the small knob on the side of the watch case) out to the time-setting position.
2. **Adjust the Hands:** Turn the crown clockwise or counter-clockwise to move the hour and minute hands to the correct time.
3. **Push the Crown In:** Once the time is set, push the crown back into its original position. This will start the watch movement.

### 2. Adjusting the Strap

The watch features an adjustable 14mm genuine leather slip-thru strap designed to fit wrist circumferences up to 7.5 inches.

1. **Unbuckle the Strap:** Open the buckle and slide the strap through the loops.

2. **Position on Wrist:** Place the watch on your wrist.
3. **Fasten the Buckle:** Insert the pin of the buckle into the desired hole on the strap for a comfortable and secure fit. Ensure the strap is not too tight or too loose.

## OPERATING YOUR WATCH

### Basic Timekeeping

Your Timex Briarwood watch is a quartz analog timepiece, providing accurate time display with hour, minute, and second hands. Once the time is set, the watch will continuously keep time until the battery requires replacement.

### Water Resistance

This watch is water resistant to 30 meters (100 feet). This means it is suitable for splashes or brief immersion in water. It is **not** suitable for swimming, bathing, or diving. Avoid operating the crown while the watch is wet or submerged to prevent water entry.

### Cleaning Your Watch

- **Case:** Wipe the watch case with a soft, dry cloth. For stubborn dirt, a slightly damp cloth can be used, followed by immediate drying.
- **Leather Strap:** Avoid prolonged exposure to water, direct sunlight, and harsh chemicals, as these can damage the leather. Clean the leather strap with a soft, slightly damp cloth and allow it to air dry completely. Do not use abrasive cleaners.

### Battery Replacement

Your watch is powered by one unknown type battery (included). When the watch stops running, it indicates the battery needs replacement. It is recommended to have the battery replaced by a qualified watch technician to ensure proper sealing and maintain water resistance.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

---

- **Watch Not Running:**

- Ensure the crown is fully pushed in.
- The battery may need replacement. Consult a professional watch technician.
- **Time Inaccuracy:**
  - If the watch is consistently running slow or fast, the battery might be low, or the movement may require servicing.
- **Water or Condensation Inside Watch:**
  - Immediately take the watch to a qualified service center. Water damage can be severe if not addressed promptly.
