### INTRODUCTION

This manual provides comprehensive instructions for the safe and efficient operation of your Amazon Basics Programmable Bread Maker. Designed for ease of use, this appliance automatically mixes, kneads, rises, and bakes fresh bread, offering a convenient solution for homemade baked goods.

Please read all instructions carefully before using the appliance to ensure proper function and safety.

- 3 Crust Color Options: Select from light, medium, or dark crusts.
- ExpressBake Setting: Bakes bread in less than 90 minutes for quick results.
- LCD Display: Provides clear information on selected settings and remaining time.

- Bread Pan: The primary baking vessel with a non-stick coating.
- Kneading Blade: Attaches to the shaft inside the bread pan for mixing and kneading.
- Measuring Cup: For accurate liquid measurements.
- Measuring Spoon: Features both tablespoon and teaspoon measurements for dry ingredients.
- Metal Hook: Used to safely remove the kneading blade from the baked loaf.

### **SETUP**

- 1. Unpacking: Carefully remove all packaging materials and accessories.
- 2. Initial Cleaning: Wash the bread pan, kneading blade, measuring cup, and measuring spoon with warm, soapy water. Rinse

thoroughly and dry completely. Wipe the exterior of the bread maker with a damp cloth.

- 3. **Placement:** Place the bread maker on a stable, flat, heat-resistant surface, away from direct sunlight and heat sources. Ensure adequate ventilation around the appliance.
- 4. **First Use (Burn-in):** Before first use, it is recommended to run the "Bake" program (Program 13) for 10 minutes without any ingredients. This helps to burn off any manufacturing residues and odors. Allow the unit to cool completely before cleaning.

### **OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS**

Follow these steps to bake a loaf of bread using your Amazon Basics Bread Maker:

### 1. Adding Ingredients:

- 1. Open the lid and remove the bread pan by lifting the handle.
- 2. Attach the kneading blade securely onto the shaft inside the bread pan.
- 3. Add ingredients to the bread pan in the order specified by your recipe (typically liquids first, then dry ingredients, with yeast added last on top of the dry ingredients, away from liquids and salt).
- 4. Ensure the ingredients are evenly distributed.
- 5. Place the bread pan back into the bread maker, pressing down firmly until it clicks into place. Close the lid.

### 2. Selecting Program:

- Plug in the bread maker. The display will show "1 3:00" (Basic program, 3 hours).
- Press the MENU button repeatedly to cycle through the 14 available programs until your desired program number appears
  on the display.
- Refer to the list on the bread maker's top panel for program descriptions (e.g., 1. BASIC, 2. FRENCH, 6. GLUTEN FREE, 11. JAM).



### 3. Selecting Loaf Size:

Press the LOAF button to toggle between 1.5 LB (0.7 kg) and 2.0 LB (0.9 kg) loaf sizes. The selected size will be indicated
on the display.

### 4. Selecting Crust Color:

Press the COLOR button to choose your preferred crust color: Light, Medium, or Dark. The indicator on the display will
move to your selection.

### 5. Starting the Baking Process:

- Once all settings are configured, press the **START/STOP** button. The bread maker will begin its cycle.
- The display will show the remaining time.

### 6. Removing the Baked Bread:

- When the cycle is complete, the bread maker will beep. Press and hold the **START/STOP** button for a few seconds to stop the operation.
- Carefully open the lid. Using oven mitts, lift the bread pan by its handle and remove it from the bread maker.
- Invert the bread pan onto a wire rack or clean surface to release the bread. If the kneading blade remains in the bread, use the provided metal hook to carefully remove it.
- Allow the bread to cool on a wire rack for at least 15-20 minutes before slicing to ensure proper texture.

### MAINTENANCE & CLEANING

Proper maintenance ensures the longevity and performance of your bread maker.

- 1. Unplug: Always unplug the appliance and allow it to cool completely before cleaning.
- 2. **Bread Pan and Kneading Blade:** Wash with warm, soapy water. Do not use abrasive cleaners or metal scouring pads, as this can damage the non-stick coating. Rinse and dry thoroughly.
- 3. **Exterior:** Wipe the exterior of the bread maker with a soft, damp cloth. Do not immerse the main unit in water or any other liquid.
- 4. Interior: Use a soft, damp cloth to wipe the interior of the baking chamber. Remove any crumbs or residue.

## **T**ROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Bread does not rise.	Yeast is old or inactive; incorrect water temperature; too much salt or sugar.	Check yeast expiration date; use lukewarm water (105-115°F); ensure correct ingredient measurements.
Bread is too dense.	Too much flour; not enough liquid; incorrect program selected.	Measure flour accurately (spoon into cup, level off); adjust liquid amount; select appropriate program for bread type.
Kneading blade stuck in bread.	Common occurrence.	Use the provided metal hook to carefully remove the blade after the bread has cooled slightly.
Bread maker emits smoke/odor on first use.	Manufacturing residues burning off.	This is normal for first use. Ensure good ventilation. If it persists, contact support.


