- **Solution:** Gently clean around the axles and wheels with a soft brush or compressed air. Ensure no foreign objects are obstructing movement. Avoid attempting to bend or force axles, as this may cause permanent damage.

Paint or Decal Damage:

- **Cause:** Rough play, accidental drops, or prolonged exposure to harsh conditions.
- **Solution:** Minor scuffs or scratches are generally not repairable without specialized tools and paints. For collectors, careful handling and proper storage are key to preventing such damage.
