1. OVERVIEW

The Active Front Grey Brush (9983122-R1) is a durable plastic brush designed for effective scrubbing and cleaning of pool surfaces. It is engineered as a heavy-duty brush to provide powerful scrubbing action, ensuring thorough cleaning by your Dolphin robotic pool cleaner.

4. INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

Follow these steps to replace the Active Front Grey Brush on your Dolphin robotic pool cleaner:

1. **Power Off and Disconnect:** Before beginning, ensure your Dolphin pool cleaner is turned off and unplugged from its power source. Remove the cleaner from the pool.
2. **Access Brush Assembly:** Carefully turn the cleaner upside down or to its side to access the brush assembly located at the front of the unit.
3. **Remove Old Brush:** Depending on your specific Dolphin model, the brush may be held in place by clips, pins, or a sliding mechanism. Gently release any retaining clips or pins, or slide the old brush off its mounting points. Note how the old brush was oriented.
4. **Install New Brush:** Align the new Active Front Grey Brush (9983122-R1) with the mounting points. Slide it into place or secure it with the clips/pins, ensuring it is firmly seated and correctly oriented. The brush should rotate freely once installed.
5. **Verify Installation:** Double-check that the new brush is securely attached and that there are no loose parts.
6. **Return to Operation:** Place your Dolphin cleaner back into the pool, connect the power supply, and turn it on. Observe the cleaner during its initial operation to ensure the new brush is functioning correctly.

5. MAINTENANCE

To ensure the longevity and effectiveness of your Active Front Grey Brush:

- **Regular Cleaning:** After each cleaning cycle, remove any debris (hair, leaves, etc.) that may have become entangled in the brush bristles.
- **Inspection:** Periodically inspect the brush for signs of wear, damage, or excessive flattening of the bristles. Replace the brush if it appears worn to maintain optimal cleaning performance.
- **Storage:** When the pool cleaner is not in use for extended periods, store it in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight to prevent material degradation.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues after replacing the brush, consider the following:

- **Brush Not Fitting:** Ensure you have the correct replacement part (9983122-R1) for your specific Dolphin model. Refer to the compatibility list in Section 3.
- **Poor Cleaning Performance:** Verify that the brush is installed correctly and securely. Check for any debris still caught in the brush or other parts of the cleaner. If the brush is old, it might be time for a replacement.
- **Unusual Noises:** If the cleaner makes unusual noises after brush replacement, immediately power off and inspect the brush for improper installation or foreign objects.
