1. Introduction

2. SETUP

Follow these steps to set up your BH 90120 for the first time.

- Unpacking: Carefully remove all components from the packaging. Retain packaging materials for future transport or storage.
- 2. **Placement:** Place the BH 90120 on a flat, stable, and dry surface, ensuring adequate space for ventilation around all sides. Avoid direct sunlight or heat sources.

3. Power Connection:

Connect the power adapter cable to the DC IN port on the rear of the BH 90120.

- Plug the power adapter into a standard electrical outlet.
- Ensure the power indicator light (if present) illuminates, indicating power is supplied.
- 4. **Initial Power On:** Press and hold the power button (usually located on the front or top panel) for 3 seconds until the device powers on.

- Before Cleaning: Always ensure the device is powered off and unplugged from the power source before cleaning.

- Power off and unplug the device.
- · Clean the device thoroughly as described above.
- Store in a cool, dry place, away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Device does not power on.	No power supply; loose connection; faulty power adapter.	Ensure power adapter is securely plugged into both the device and the outlet. Try a different outlet. Verify power adapter is functional.
Display is blank or flickering.	Power issue; display settings; internal fault.	Power cycle the device (turn off, unplug, wait 30 seconds, plug in, turn on). Check brightness settings.
Buttons are unresponsive.	Software glitch; physical obstruction.	Restart the device. Ensure no debris is lodged around the buttons.
Device overheats.	Blocked ventilation; prolonged heavy use.	Ensure ventilation ports are clear. Allow the device to cool down. Operate in a well-ventilated area.
