# **Uten 6.9QT/6.5L Digital Air Fryer**

Model: Uten 1088TS Air Fryer

### INTRODUCTION

The Uten 6.9QT/6.5L Digital Air Fryer is designed to provide a healthier alternative to traditional deep frying, utilizing rapid hot air circulation to cook food with significantly less oil. This appliance offers a large capacity suitable for family meals and features an intuitive LED digital touchscreen for easy operation. It is equipped with multiple pre-set cooking modes and advanced safety features to ensure a convenient and secure cooking experience.

### IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

When using electrical appliances, basic safety precautions should always be followed to reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, and injury.

- Read all instructions before operating the appliance.
- Do not immerse the cord, plug, or the appliance housing in water or other liquid.
- Close supervision is necessary when any appliance is used by or near children.
- Unplug from outlet when not in use and before cleaning. Allow to cool before putting on or taking off parts.
- Do not operate any appliance with a damaged cord or plug, or after the appliance malfunctions or has been damaged in any manner.
- Do not use attachments not recommended by the appliance manufacturer.
- Do not let cord hang over edge of table or counter, or touch hot surfaces.
- Do not place on or near a hot gas or electric burner, or in a heated oven.
- Extreme caution must be used when moving an appliance containing hot oil or other hot liquids.
- Always attach plug to appliance first, then plug cord into the wall outlet. To disconnect, turn any control to "off", then remove plug from wall outlet.
- Do not use appliance for other than intended use.

### **Integrated Safety Features:**

• Enclosed Cooking System: Minimizes exposure to hot surfaces during operation.

- Auto-Pause: The air fryer automatically pauses operation when the basket is pulled out, resuming when reinserted.
- Auto Shut-Off: Prevents overcooking and ensures safety by automatically turning off the appliance after the set cooking time or if overheating occurs.
- **High Temperature Resistant Material:** Constructed with materials designed to withstand high cooking temperatures safely.
- Thermal Fuse Protection: Provides an additional layer of safety by cutting off power in case of extreme temperature fluctuations.

## PRODUCT COMPONENTS

Familiarize yourself with the main parts of your Uten Air Fryer:

- Main Unit: Houses the heating element, fan, and control panel.
- **LED Digital Touchscreen:** For setting time, temperature, and selecting pre-set modes.
- Removable Fryer Basket: The primary cooking container, featuring a non-stick coating.
- Interlayer/Crisper Plate: Sits inside the basket to allow air circulation around food and drain excess fat.

• Handle: For safely pulling out and reinserting the fryer basket.

## SETUP AND FIRST USE

- 1. **Unpack:** Carefully remove all packaging materials from the air fryer.
- 2. **Clean:** Wash the removable fryer basket and interlayer with warm soapy water. Rinse thoroughly and dry completely. Wipe the exterior of the main unit with a damp cloth.
- 3. **Placement:** Place the air fryer on a stable, heat-resistant surface, ensuring adequate air circulation around the unit. Do not place it directly against a wall or other appliances.
- 4. **Initial Run (Optional):** For the first use, it is recommended to run the air fryer empty for about 10-15 minutes at 350°F (175°C) to eliminate any manufacturing odors. A slight odor may be present, which is normal and will dissipate.

# **OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS**

The Uten Air Fryer uses 360° hot air circulation technology to cook food evenly and efficiently.

### **Basic Operation:**

- 1. **Prepare Food:** Place your ingredients into the fryer basket. Do not overfill the basket to allow for proper air circulation.
- 2. Insert Basket: Slide the fryer basket firmly into the main unit until it clicks into place.
- 3. Power On: Plug the air fryer into a grounded electrical outlet. The digital touchscreen will illuminate.
- 4. Set Temperature and Time:
  - Use the temperature control buttons (usually + and -) to adjust the desired cooking temperature.
  - Use the time control buttons (usually + and -) to set the cooking duration.
- 5. **Start Cooking:** Press the Start/Pause button to begin the cooking process.
- 6. **Shake/Flip (Optional):** For even cooking, especially for fries or smaller items, pull out the basket halfway through the cooking time and shake or flip the contents. The air fryer will pause automatically. Reinsert the basket to resume cooking.
- 7. **End of Cooking:** The air fryer will beep when the cooking time is complete and automatically shut off. Carefully pull out the basket and transfer the cooked food.

### **Using Pre-Set Modes:**

The Uten Air Fryer features 8 pre-set cooking modes for common dishes. To use a pre-set mode:

- 1. After placing food in the basket and inserting it, press the Menu/Mode button on the touchscreen to cycle through the available pre-sets.
- 2. Once the desired pre-set icon is selected, the air fryer will automatically set the optimal temperature and time for that food type.
- 3. Press the Start/Pause button to begin cooking. You can manually adjust the time and temperature even after selecting a pre-set if needed.

# COOKING GUIDE (APPROXIMATE)

The following table provides approximate cooking times and temperatures for various foods. Actual times may vary based on food quantity, size, and desired crispiness. Always ensure food is cooked to safe

internal temperatures.

Food Item	Temperature	Time	
Chicken	180°C (356°F)	8-18 minutes	
Cake	160°C (320°F)	8-25 minutes	
Meat	180°C (356°F)	10-25 minutes	
Fries	180°C-200°C (356°F-392°F)	9-22 minutes	
Shrimp	180°C (356°F)	4-8 minutes	
Steak	180°C (356°F)	10-12 minutes	
Fish	180°C (356°F)	7-10 minutes	

## CARE AND MAINTENANCE

Proper cleaning and maintenance will extend the life of your air fryer.

- Before Cleaning: Always unplug the air fryer from the power outlet and allow it to cool completely before cleaning.
- Fryer Basket and Interlayer: The removable fryer basket and interlayer are dishwasher-safe. For manual cleaning, wash with warm water, a mild detergent, and a non-abrasive sponge. The special non-stick coating helps prevent food from bonding, making cleanup easy.
- Exterior: Wipe the exterior of the air fryer with a damp cloth. Do not use harsh abrasive cleaners or scouring pads, as they may damage the surface.
- Interior: If necessary, wipe the interior of the appliance with a damp cloth. Do not immerse the main unit in water.
- Storage: Ensure all parts are clean and dry before storing the air fryer in a cool, dry place.

### **TROUBLESHOOTING**

If you encounter issues with your Uten Air Fryer, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

#### · Appliance does not turn on:

- Ensure the power cord is securely plugged into a grounded electrical outlet.
- Check if the fryer basket is fully inserted into the main unit. The appliance will not operate if the basket is not correctly seated.

#### · Food is not cooked evenly:

- Do not overfill the basket. Cook food in smaller batches if necessary.
- Shake or flip the food halfway through the cooking process to ensure even browning.
- Ensure the correct temperature and time settings are used for the specific food item.

#### · White smoke comes from the appliance:

- This may indicate that fatty residue from previous use is burning off. Clean the basket and interior thoroughly after each use.
- If cooking very fatty foods, excess oil may drip into the drawer. Remove excess oil from the drawer during cooking if needed.

#### · Basket is difficult to insert or remove:

- $\circ~$  Ensure the basket and interlayer are clean and free of food debris.
- Push the basket in firmly until it clicks into place.




