Your guide to setting up, operating, and maintaining your JISULIFE Humidifier.

1. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The JISULIFE Mini Portable Humidifier Model JB07 is designed to provide personal humidification in various environments. Its compact size and USB-rechargeable battery make it suitable for office, bedroom, travel, and car use. This humidifier utilizes ultrasonic technology for quiet operation and offers flexible water container options.

Key Features:

- **Portable Design:** Compact and lightweight for easy transport.
- **Container Diversity:** Compatible with various water containers, including glasses, bottles, and car cup holders.
- **Rechargeable Battery:** Provides up to 7 hours of operation on a full charge.
- **Two Misting Modes:** Continuous and intermittent mist options.
- **Ultra-Quiet Operation:** Less than 30dB noise level.
- **Auto Shut-Off:** Automatically turns off when water levels are low.

2. SETUP AND CHARGING

2.1 Initial Preparation

1. **Unpack:** Carefully remove all components from the packaging. Ensure you have the humidifier unit, two filters, and the USB charging cable.
2. **Soak Cotton Wick:** Before first use, ensure the cotton wick (filter) is fully soaked in water for 5-10 minutes. This is crucial for proper mist generation.
3. **Water Type:** Use clean tap water or mineral water. **Do not use pure water or distilled**

water, as this can cause water accumulation at the mist outlet and affect performance.

4. **Container Selection:** Place the humidifier into a suitable water container. The design allows for use with various containers, such as glasses, mugs, or water bottles. It also fits standard car cup holders.

2.2 Charging the Humidifier

The humidifier comes with a built-in rechargeable Lithium Polymer battery. It is recommended to fully charge the device before its first use.

- Connect the provided USB cable to the humidifier's charging port.
- Plug the other end of the USB cable into a power source such as a USB port on a computer, a power bank, a wall adapter (5V), or a car charger.
- A full charge typically takes 2-3 hours. The indicator light will change to show charging status (e.g., red for charging, off/blue for fully charged, refer to specific product light indicators if available).
- Once fully charged, the humidifier can operate for approximately 4 hours in continuous mist mode or 7 hours in intermittent mist mode.

3. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

3.1 Power On/Off and Mist Modes

The humidifier features a single button for all operations.

1. **Power On (Continuous Mist):** Press the power button once to turn on the humidifier. It will start operating in continuous mist mode, emitting mist constantly.
2. **Intermittent Mist Mode:** Press the power button a second time to switch to intermittent mist mode. In this mode, the humidifier will mist for 5 seconds and then pause for 3 seconds, repeating the cycle.
3. **Power Off:** Press the power button a third time to turn off the humidifier.

3.2 Quiet Operation and Auto Shut-Off

- **Quietness:** The humidifier operates at less than 30dB, ensuring it does not disturb your rest or work.
- **Automatic Shut-Off:** For safety and to prevent damage, the humidifier will automatically shut off when the water level in the container is too low. This protects the internal components and prevents dry burning of the filter.

4. MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance ensures optimal performance and extends the lifespan of your humidifier.

4.1 Cleaning the Humidifier

- **General Cleaning:** If the humidifier develops an odor or if the water appears dirty, clean the water container thoroughly.
- **Drying:** After cleaning, dry the container and humidifier unit in the air before reassembly and use.
- **Avoid Essential Oils:** **Do not use essential oils or perfumes** in the humidifier. These substances can clog the cotton wick and render the humidifier unusable.

4.2 Replacing the Cotton Wick (Filter)

The cotton wick is a consumable part and needs periodic replacement.

- It is recommended to change the cotton wick every one to two months, depending on usage and water quality.
- To replace, gently pull out the old wick from the humidifier unit.
- Insert a new, pre-soaked cotton wick into the designated slot. Ensure it is properly seated.

5. TROUBLESHOOTING

If your humidifier is not working normally, perform the following checks:

Problem	Cause Analysis	Solution
No or Less Mist	No power	Charge the humidifier.
No or Less Mist	The wick is not fully soaked.	Soak the wick in water for 5-10 minutes before use.
No or Less Mist	Water in the spraying nozzle.	Absorb the water at the spraying nozzle with a swab before use.
No or Less Mist	Water shortage (water level below dry heating resistant probe).	Add water to the humidifier container.
No or Less Mist	Purified, distilled, or bottled water is used.	Replace with running or mineral water.
Smelly Mist	Water is dirty or product stored too long.	Clean the container and dry it in the air for use.
