INTRODUCTION

This manual provides comprehensive instructions for the setup, operation, maintenance, and troubleshooting of your Apple iPhone 8. Please read this manual thoroughly to ensure proper use and to maximize the device's capabilities. The Apple iPhone 8 features an all-glass design and an aerospace-grade aluminum band. It supports wireless charging and is resistant to water and dust. It is equipped with a 4.7-inch Retina HD display with True Tone technology and a 12MP camera with an advanced image signal processor. The device is powered by the A11 Bionic chip and supports augmented reality experiences. It runs on iOS 12, Apple's advanced mobile operating system.

WHAT'S IN THE BOX

Upon unboxing your Apple iPhone 8, please verify that all the following components are present:

- iPhone
- Adapter
- USB Cable

SETUP GUIDE

1. Initial Power On and Activation

To power on your iPhone 8, press and hold the Side button until the Apple logo appears. Follow the on-screen instructions to select your language, region, and connect to a Wi-Fi network. If your device is locked to a specific carrier, you will need to activate it with that carrier's SIM card and subscription plan.

Note: This specific iPhone 8 model is locked and requires a carrier subscription for activation and use.

2. SIM Card Installation

Locate the SIM tray on the side of the iPhone. Use the SIM ejector tool (not included, typically comes with a new phone) to open the tray. Insert your nano-SIM card into the tray with the gold contacts facing down and the notched corner aligned. Gently push the tray back into the iPhone until it clicks into place.

3. Data Transfer (Optional)

If you are upgrading from another iPhone, you can transfer your data using iCloud Backup, iTunes Backup, or by using the Quick Start feature during initial setup.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Basic Navigation

- **Home Button:** Press once to return to the Home screen. Double-press to open the App Switcher. Press and hold for Siri.
- **Touch ID:** Use your fingerprint to unlock your device and make purchases. Set up Touch ID in Settings > Touch ID & Passcode.
- **Side Button:** Press to wake or sleep the device. Press and hold to power off or activate Siri.
- **Volume Buttons:** Adjust media and ringtone volume.

Camera Usage

The iPhone 8 features a 12MP camera. Open the Camera app from the Home screen or Control Center. Tap the shutter button to take a photo. Swipe left or right to switch between modes like Photo, Portrait, Pano, and Video.

Wireless Charging

The iPhone 8 supports wireless charging. Place the iPhone face up on a Qi-certified wireless charging mat. Ensure the iPhone is centered on the charger for optimal performance. A charging indicator will appear on the screen.

MAINTENANCE AND CARE

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, lint-free cloth to clean the iPhone. Avoid abrasive materials, sprays, or solvents.
- **Water and Dust Resistance:** The iPhone 8 is splash, water, and dust resistant under controlled laboratory conditions (rated IP67 under IEC standard 60529). Resistance is not permanent and may decrease as a result of normal wear. Do not attempt to charge a wet iPhone.
- **Battery Care:** To prolong battery lifespan, avoid extreme temperatures. If storing the device long-term, charge it to about 50% every six months.
- **Software Updates:** Regularly update iOS to the latest version to ensure optimal performance, security, and access to new features. Go to Settings > General > Software Update.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Solution
Device not turning on	Ensure the battery is charged. Connect to a power adapter for at least 10 minutes. If still unresponsive, perform a force restart: Press and quickly release the Volume Up button. Press and quickly release the Volume Down button. Press and hold the Side button until you see the Apple logo.
Apps freezing or crashing	Close the app from the App Switcher (double-press Home button and swipe up on the app). Restart the iPhone. Ensure iOS and the app are updated to the latest versions.
Poor battery life	Check battery usage in Settings > Battery. Reduce screen brightness, disable background app refresh for non-essential apps, and limit location services.
Cannot connect to Wi-Fi	Toggle Wi-Fi off and on in Control Center or Settings. Restart your Wi-Fi router. Go to Settings > General > Reset > Reset Network Settings.
Touch ID not working	Ensure your finger and the Home button are clean and dry. Re-register your fingerprints in Settings > Touch ID & Passcode.
