1. INTRODUCTION

The Apple iPhone 8 Plus features an all-glass design and an aerospace-grade aluminum band, offering durability and a premium feel. This device supports wireless charging and is resistant to water and dust, providing enhanced protection for daily use. It is equipped with a 5.5-inch Retina HD display featuring True Tone technology for a vibrant and accurate visual experience. The iPhone 8 Plus includes 12MP Dual cameras with Portrait mode and Portrait Lighting capabilities, along with a 7MP FaceTime HD front camera, enabling high-quality photography and video calls. Powered by the A11 Bionic chip, it delivers robust performance and supports augmented reality experiences in various applications and games. Running on iOS 12, the iPhone 8 Plus provides a secure and intuitive mobile operating system with powerful tools designed to personalize your user experience.

2. WHAT'S IN THE BOX

Upon opening your Apple iPhone 8 Plus package, please verify that all the following items are included:

- Apple iPhone 8 Plus (64GB, Gold)
- EarPods with Lightning Connector
- Lightning to USB Cable
- 5W USB Power Adapter

3. SETUP

Follow these steps to set up your new iPhone 8 Plus for the first time:

1. **Insert SIM Card:** Locate the SIM tray on the right side of your iPhone. Use the SIM ejector tool (often found in the original packaging) to open the tray. Place your nano-SIM card into the tray with the gold contacts facing down and the notched corner aligned. Carefully push the tray back into the iPhone until it is flush with the side.

2. **Charge Your iPhone:** Connect the Lightning to USB Cable to the Lightning port at the bottom of your iPhone and the other end to the 5W USB Power Adapter. Plug the adapter into a power outlet. It is recommended to fully charge your device before initial use.
3. **Power On:** Press and hold the Side button (on the right side of the device) until the Apple logo appears on the screen.
4. **Initial Setup:** Follow the on-screen instructions to complete the setup process. This includes selecting your language and region, connecting to a Wi-Fi network, setting up Touch ID, creating a passcode, and restoring data from a backup or setting up as a new iPhone.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

This section provides guidance on basic operations of your iPhone 8 Plus.

4.1 Basic Navigation

- **Home Button:** Press the Home button once to return to the Home screen. Double-press to open the App Switcher. Press and hold for Siri.
- **Lock/Unlock:** Press the Side button once to lock or unlock the screen.
- **Swipe:** Swipe left or right on the Home screen to navigate between pages of apps. Swipe down from the top to access Search and Siri Suggestions. Swipe down from the top-right corner for Control Center (on iOS 12).

4.2 Making Calls and Sending Messages

- **Calls:** Tap the Phone app icon, then select a contact or dial a number using the Keypad. Tap the green call button to initiate a call.
- **Messages:** Tap the Messages app icon. Tap the new message icon (top right) to compose a new message. Enter the recipient's name or number and type your message. Tap the send button.

4.3 Using the Camera

The iPhone 8 Plus features a powerful dual-camera system.

1. **Open Camera:** Tap the Camera app icon from the Home screen or swipe left from the Lock screen.
2. **Select Mode:** Swipe left or right on the screen to choose between Photo, Portrait, Video, Slo-mo, Time-lapse, and Pano modes.
3. **Take Photo/Record Video:** Tap the Shutter button (white circle) to take a photo or the Record button (red circle) to start/stop video recording.

5. MAINTENANCE AND CARE

Proper care ensures the longevity and optimal performance of your iPhone 8 Plus.

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, lint-free cloth to clean the screen and back of your iPhone. Avoid abrasive materials or harsh chemicals. For stubborn smudges, slightly dampen the cloth with water.
- **Water and Dust Resistance:** The iPhone 8 Plus is splash, water, and dust resistant under controlled laboratory conditions with a rating of IP67 under IEC standard 60529 (maximum depth of 1 meter up

to 30 minutes). This resistance is not permanent and may decrease as a result of normal wear. Do not attempt to charge a wet iPhone.

- **Battery Care:** To maximize battery lifespan, avoid exposing your iPhone to extreme temperatures. If storing for a long period, charge it to about 50% and power it off.
- **Software Updates:** Regularly update your iPhone's iOS software to ensure you have the latest features, security enhancements, and bug fixes. Go to Settings > General > Software Update.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your iPhone 8 Plus, try these common troubleshooting steps:

- **Device Not Responding:** If your iPhone is frozen or unresponsive, perform a force restart. Quickly press and release the Volume Up button, then quickly press and release the Volume Down button, then press and hold the Side button until you see the Apple logo.
- **Battery Draining Quickly:** Check battery usage in Settings > Battery to identify apps consuming the most power. Reduce screen brightness, disable Background App Refresh for non-essential apps, and ensure your software is up to date.
- **Wi-Fi/Cellular Connectivity Issues:** Try toggling Wi-Fi or Cellular Data off and on. Restart your iPhone. For Wi-Fi, try forgetting the network (Settings > Wi-Fi > tap 'i' next to network > Forget This Network) and reconnecting.
- **Apps Crashing:** Ensure the app is updated to its latest version. Try force-quitting the app (double-press Home button, swipe up on the app preview) and reopening it. If the issue persists, delete and reinstall the app.
- **Sound Issues:** Check the Ring/Silent switch on the left side of your iPhone. Ensure volume is turned up using the Volume Up button. Check sound settings in Settings > Sounds & Haptics.
