# Havells Insta Cook QT Induction Metal Cooktop

## INSTRUCTION MANUAL

### Important Safety Information

---

Please read all instructions carefully before using the Havells Insta Cook QT Induction Metal Cooktop. Retain this manual for future reference.

- **Dry-braising is not permitted.** This can damage the appliance and pose a safety risk.
- The ceramic plate becomes hot after cooking. **Do not touch the ceramic plate with your hand immediately after use.** Allow it to cool completely.
- Ensure the appliance is placed on a stable, flat, and heat-resistant surface.
- Do not immerse the cooktop in water or any other liquid.
- Keep out of reach of children.

## Setup

1. **Unpacking:** Carefully remove the cooktop from its packaging. Inspect for any damage.
2. **Placement:** Place the cooktop on a dry, stable, and level surface, ensuring adequate ventilation around the unit. Do not place it near heat sources or flammable materials.
3. **Power Connection:** Plug the power cord into a grounded electrical outlet. Ensure the voltage matches the specifications of the appliance.
4. **Cookware:** Use only induction-compatible cookware. This typically includes cast iron, enameled iron, or stainless steel with a magnetic bottom.

## Operating Instructions

1. **Power On:** Place induction-compatible cookware containing food or liquid on the center of the ceramic plate. Press the power button (often indicated by an 'I' symbol) to turn on the cooktop.
2. **Mode Selection:** The control panel features various cooking modes. Select your desired mode:
  - **Manual:** For general cooking, allowing manual adjustment of power/temperature.
  - **Milk Tea:** Optimized setting for preparing milk tea.

- **Curry:** Optimized setting for cooking curries.
  - **Fry:** Optimized setting for frying.
3. **Adjusting Power/Temperature:** Use the '+' and '-' buttons to increase or decrease the power level or temperature setting as needed.
  4. **Power Off:** After cooking, press the power button to turn off the cooktop. The fan may continue to run for a short period to cool down the internal components.

## Maintenance and Cleaning

Regular cleaning ensures optimal performance and extends the life of your cooktop.

- **Before Cleaning:** Always unplug the cooktop from the power outlet and allow it to cool completely.
- **Ceramic Plate:** Wipe the ceramic surface with a soft, damp cloth and mild detergent. For stubborn stains, use a non-abrasive ceramic cooktop cleaner. Dry thoroughly.
- **Control Panel:** Wipe the control panel with a soft, damp cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or scrubbers.
- **Ventilation Openings:** Ensure the ventilation openings are free from dust and debris. Use a soft brush or vacuum cleaner to gently clear them.
- **Storage:** Store the cooktop in a dry place when not in use.

## Troubleshooting

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Cooktop does not turn on	No power supply; Power cord not plugged in; Faulty outlet	Check power cord connection; Test outlet with another appliance; Check circuit breaker
Cooktop beeps and displays an error code	No cookware detected; Incorrect cookware type; Overheating	Place induction-compatible cookware; Use appropriate cookware; Allow cooktop to cool down
Cooking process is slow or inefficient	Cookware not flat or too small; Low power setting	Use flat-bottomed, appropriately sized cookware; Increase power setting
