3. SETUP

Unpacking and Initial Setup

- 1. Unpack the HP EliteDesk 800 G3 Mini PC, keyboard, and mouse from their packaging.
- 2. Place the Mini PC on a stable, flat surface with adequate ventilation to prevent overheating.
- 3. Connect your monitor(s) to the DisplayPort or VGA ports on the rear of the PC.
- 4. Connect the keyboard and mouse to the available USB ports on either the front or rear of the PC.
- 5. Connect the power adapter to the PC's power connector and then plug it into a power outlet.
- 6. Press the power button on the front panel to turn on the PC.

4. OPERATING SYSTEM AND INITIAL CONFIGURATION

Windows 10 Pro Setup

Your HP EliteDesk 800 G3 Mini PC comes pre-installed with Windows 10 Professional (64-bit). Upon first boot, follow the on-screen prompts to complete the initial setup, including language selection, network connection, and user account creation.

Connecting to a Network

- Wired Connection: Connect an Ethernet cable from your router or modem to the RJ-45 LAN port on the rear of the PC.
- Wireless Connection: The PC supports 802.11ac Wi-Fi. During Windows setup or via the Network & Internet settings, select your Wi-Fi network and enter the password.

Bluetooth Connectivity

The PC includes Bluetooth functionality. To connect Bluetooth devices, navigate to Settings > Devices > Bluetooth & other devices and follow the pairing instructions for your specific device.

5. MAINTENANCE

Cleaning

- Regularly clean the exterior of the PC with a soft, dry, lint-free cloth.
- Ensure ventilation grilles are free from dust and obstructions to maintain optimal airflow and prevent overheating.
- Use compressed air to gently clear dust from ports and vents.

Software Updates

- Keep your Windows operating system updated by regularly checking for updates viaSettings > Update & Security > Windows Update.
- Install driver updates from the official HP support website to ensure optimal performance and compatibility with hardware components.

Data Backup

Regularly back up your important data to an external drive or cloud storage service to prevent data loss in case of system failure or other unforeseen events.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

Common Issues and Solutions

- **No Power:** Ensure the power cable is securely connected to both the PC and a functional power outlet. Verify the power button is pressed.
- **No Display:** Check all monitor cable connections (DisplayPort, VGA). Ensure the monitor is powered on and set to the correct input source. Try connecting to a different display if possible.
- No Internet Connection: For wired connections, check the Ethernet cable and router/modem status.
 For wireless, verify Wi-Fi is enabled in Windows settings and connected to the correct network with the correct password.
- Slow Performance: Close unnecessary applications running in the background. Check for pending Windows updates. For SSDs, ensure sufficient free space.
- **Peripheral Not Detected:** Ensure USB devices are properly connected. Try a different USB port. Install or update device drivers if necessary from the manufacturer's website.
