4. INSTALLATION

The N3 Steering Stabilizer kit is designed for a 100% bolt-on installation process, which can typically be performed using common tools. For detailed, vehicle-specific instructions, always refer to the appropriate shop manual for your 2005-2007 Ford Super Duty.

General Installation Steps:

1. Securely lift and support the front of the vehicle.
2. Remove the existing steering stabilizer (if applicable).
3. Attach the new Rough Country N3 Steering Stabilizer using the provided mounting hardware. Ensure all bolts are tightened to the manufacturer's specifications.

6. MAINTENANCE

- **After the first 500 miles:** Check all bolts and nuts for tightness.
- **Every 1,000 miles thereafter:** Re-check all bolts and nuts for tightness.
- **Every 3,000 miles:** Have a qualified, professional mechanic inspect the wheel alignment, steering system, suspension, and driveline systems.

Inspect the stabilizer for any signs of leaks, damage, or excessive wear on the bushings. Replace components as necessary.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you experience issues such as continued bump steer, excessive steering play, or unusual noises after installation, consider the following:

- **Loose Fasteners:** Re-check all mounting bolts and nuts for proper torque.
- **Incorrect Installation:** Verify that the stabilizer is installed according to the manufacturer's instructions and

vehicle-specific shop manual.

- **Worn Components:** Inspect other steering and suspension components (e.g., tie rod ends, ball joints) for wear, as a new stabilizer may highlight existing issues.
- **Alignment Issues:** Ensure proper wheel alignment has been performed after any suspension modifications.



