INTRODUCTION

The Veho M-Series MD-1 is a portable wireless speaker designed for versatile audio playback. It features Bluetooth connectivity for streaming from smart devices, a built-in DAB/FM radio for digital and analog broadcasts, and an auxiliary input for wired connections. Its retro design includes a leather-effect carry strap, enhancing portability. The integrated rechargeable battery supports extended use, making it suitable for various indoor and outdoor environments.

PRODUCT OVERVIEW

Familiarize yourself with the speaker's components and controls.

Controls and Ports:

- Power/Mode Button: Press and hold to power on/off. Short press to switch between Bluetooth, DAB, FM, and AUX modes.
- Volume Knob: Rotate to adjust volume.
- Play/Pause Button: Play or pause audio in Bluetooth mode.
- Track Skip Buttons (Previous/Next): Skip tracks in Bluetooth mode. Navigate presets in radio mode.
- Scan/Preset Button: Initiate station scan in radio mode. Save/recall presets.
- Display Screen: Shows time, mode, station information, and battery status.
- USB Charging Port: For charging the internal battery.
- 3.5mm AUX Input: For connecting external audio devices via cable.
- Microphone: For hands-free calling.

SETUP

1. Charging the Speaker

- 1. Connect the supplied USB charging cable to the speaker's USB charging port.
- 2. Connect the other end of the USB cable to a suitable USB power adapter (not supplied) or a computer's USB port.
- 3. The display will indicate charging status. Allow approximately 3-4 hours for a full charge.
- 4. Disconnect the cable once fully charged.

2. Powering On/Off

- To Power On: Press and hold the Power/Mode button for a few seconds until the display illuminates.
- To Power Off: Press and hold the Power/Mode button again until the display turns off.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Bluetooth Mode

- 1. Power on the speaker. It will typically enter Bluetooth pairing mode automatically, indicated by a flashing Bluetooth icon on the display. If not, short press the Power/Mode button until "Bluetooth" is displayed.
- 2. On your smartphone or other Bluetooth device, enable Bluetooth and search for available devices.
- 3. Select "Veho MD-1" from the list.
- 4. Once paired, the Bluetooth icon will become solid, and you can begin streaming audio.
- 5. Use the Play/Pause and Track Skip buttons on the speaker or your connected device to control playback.
- 6. Adjust volume using the volume knob.

2. DAB/FM Radio Mode

- 1. Short press the Power/Mode button until "DAB" or "FM" is displayed.
- 2. **Automatic Scan:** In DAB or FM mode, press and hold the Scan/Preset button to initiate an automatic scan for available stations. The speaker will store found stations.
- 3. Manual Tuning/Station Selection: Use the Track Skip buttons to cycle through available stations or presets.
- 4. Saving Presets (DAB/FM):

- · Tune to the desired station.
- Press and hold the Scan/Preset button until "Preset Store" appears.
- Use the Track Skip buttons to select a preset number (e.g., P01, P02).
- Press the Scan/Preset button again to confirm and save.
- 5. **Recalling Presets:** Short press the Scan/Preset button, then use the Track Skip buttons to select and play a saved preset.

3. AUX Mode

- 1. Connect one end of the 3.5mm AUX cable to the speaker's AUX input port.
- 2. Connect the other end to the headphone jack or audio output of your external device (e.g., MP3 player, laptop).
- 3. Short press the Power/Mode button until "AUX" is displayed.
- 4. Control playback directly from your connected external device. Adjust volume using the speaker's volume knob.

4. Hands-Free Calling

- · When connected via Bluetooth to a smartphone, incoming calls will automatically interrupt audio playback.
- · Press the Play/Pause button to answer an incoming call.
- Press the Play/Pause button again to end the call.
- The built-in microphone allows for clear communication.

MAINTENANCE

- Cleaning: Wipe the speaker's surface with a soft, dry, lint-free cloth. Do not use liquid cleaners, aerosols, or solvents.
- Battery Care: To prolong battery life, avoid fully discharging the battery frequently. Charge the speaker regularly, even if not in use for extended periods. Store in a cool, dry place.
- Storage: When storing the speaker for a long time, ensure it is fully charged and power it off.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No power	Battery is depleted.	Charge the speaker fully using the supplied USB cable.
No sound	Volume is too low; incorrect mode selected; device not paired (Bluetooth); AUX cable not fully inserted.	Increase volume. Ensure correct mode (Bluetooth, DAB, FM, AUX) is selected. Re-pair Bluetooth device. Check AUX cable connection.
Bluetooth pairing fails	Speaker is not in pairing mode; device is too far; interference; previously paired device connected.	Ensure speaker is in Bluetooth pairing mode. Move device closer to speaker. Turn off other Bluetooth devices. Disconnect from previously paired devices.
Poor radio reception	Weak signal; environmental interference.	Relocate the speaker to an area with better reception. Try rescanning for stations.
