1. INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the Super General SGVC-2001-WD Wet & Dry Vacuum Cleaner. This powerful and versatile appliance is designed for efficient cleaning of both dry debris and liquid spills in various environments, including homes, offices, and workshops. Its robust construction and user-friendly features ensure a reliable cleaning experience. Please read this manual thoroughly before operating the appliance to ensure safe and effective use.

2. SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

To reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, or injury, always follow basic safety precautions when using an electrical appliance. Keep this manual for future reference.

- **Read all instructions:** Familiarize yourself with the appliance's operation and safety guidelines before use.
- **Electrical Safety:** Ensure the power supply voltage matches the rating on the vacuum cleaner. Do not use with a damaged cord or plug. Always unplug the vacuum cleaner from the electrical outlet when not in use or before servicing.
- **Avoid Flammable Materials:** Do not vacuum flammable or combustible liquids (e.g., gasoline), or use in areas where they may be present.
- **Wet Use Precautions:** When wet vacuuming, ensure the float valve is clean and moves freely. Do not overfill the tank.
- **Supervision:** This appliance is not intended for use by persons (including children) with reduced physical, sensory, or mental capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge, unless they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance by a person responsible for their safety. Children should be supervised to ensure that they do not play with the appliance.
- **Proper Storage:** Store the vacuum cleaner indoors in a dry place when not in use.
- **Maintenance:** Perform maintenance as described in this manual. Do not attempt to repair the appliance yourself. Contact qualified service personnel.

3. PACKAGE CONTENTS

Carefully unpack your Super General SGVC-2001-WD vacuum cleaner and check that all items are present and in good condition. If any items are missing or damaged, please contact your retailer.

4. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Super General SGVC-2001-WD is designed for ease of use and durability. Below are the main components of your vacuum cleaner.

1. **Motor Head:** Contains the motor, power switch, and filter housing. Features a durable red handle for carrying.

2. **Dust Tank (21L):** Large capacity tank for collecting dry debris or liquids. Made from high-quality iron.
3. **Flexible Hose:** Connects to the suction or blower port.
4. **Extension Wands:** Used to extend reach for floor cleaning.
5. **Floor Nozzle:** Main attachment for cleaning various floor types.
6. **Crevice Tool:** For narrow spaces and corners.
7. **Small Brush:** Ideal for carpets and upholstery.
8. **Wheels:** Two 360-degree swivel front wheels and two large fixed rear wheels for easy maneuverability.
9. **Power Switch:** Prominent red ON/OFF switch with a safety cover.

5. SETUP

Follow these steps to assemble your vacuum cleaner before first use.

1. **Attach Wheels:** Insert the swivel front wheels and fixed rear wheels into their designated slots on the base of the tank until they click securely into place.
2. **Install Filter:** For dry vacuuming, ensure the cartridge filter is securely attached to the motor head. For wet vacuuming, remove the dust bag and ensure the cartridge filter is clean.
3. **Secure Motor Head:** Place the motor head onto the dust tank and secure the latches on both sides.
4. **Connect Hose:** Insert the larger end of the flexible hose into the suction inlet on the front of the motor head. Ensure it is firmly seated. For blower function, connect the hose to the exhaust port.
5. **Attach Extension Wands and Nozzle:** Connect the extension wands to the free end of the hose, then attach your desired cleaning nozzle (e.g., floor nozzle, crevice tool, or brush).

6. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Your Super General vacuum cleaner offers both wet and dry cleaning capabilities, as well as a blower function.

6.1 Dry Vacuuming

1. Ensure the dust bag is installed inside the tank and the cartridge filter is clean and securely attached to the motor head.
2. Connect the hose to the suction inlet.
3. Plug the power cord into a suitable electrical outlet.
4. Press the red ON/OFF switch to turn on the vacuum cleaner.
5. Begin vacuuming dry debris.
6. After use, turn off the vacuum, unplug it, and empty the dust tank.

6.2 Wet Vacuuming

Important: Before wet vacuuming, remove the dust bag if installed. Ensure the cartridge filter is clean and properly seated. The float valve inside the tank will automatically shut off suction when the tank is full to prevent overflow.

1. Remove the dust bag. Ensure the cartridge filter is clean.
2. Connect the hose to the suction inlet.
3. Plug the power cord into a suitable electrical outlet.
4. Press the red ON/OFF switch to turn on the vacuum cleaner.
5. Vacuum liquid spills. Do not immerse the motor head in water.
6. When the tank is full, the suction will stop. Turn off the vacuum, unplug it, and empty the liquid.

6.3 Blower Function

The blower function is useful for clearing debris from hard-to-reach areas or blowing leaves.

1. Disconnect the hose from the suction inlet.
2. Connect the hose to the exhaust port located on the rear of the motor head.
3. Plug the power cord into a suitable electrical outlet.
4. Press the red ON/OFF switch to turn on the vacuum cleaner.
5. Direct the hose to blow away debris.
6. After use, turn off the vacuum and unplug it.

7. MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance ensures optimal performance and extends the life of your vacuum cleaner. Always unplug the appliance before performing any maintenance.

7.1 Emptying the Dust Tank

1. Unplug the vacuum cleaner.
2. Release the latches on the motor head and carefully lift it off the tank.
3. For dry debris, remove the dust bag and empty its contents into a waste bin. For liquids, carefully pour the liquid out of the tank.
4. Clean the inside of the tank with a damp cloth if necessary.
5. Reassemble the vacuum cleaner.

7.2 Cleaning the Filter

The cartridge filter should be cleaned regularly, especially after wet vacuuming, to maintain suction power.

1. Unplug the vacuum cleaner and remove the motor head.
2. Carefully detach the cartridge filter from the motor head.
3. Tap the filter gently to remove loose dust. For thorough cleaning, rinse the filter under running water.
4. Allow the filter to air dry completely before reattaching it to the motor head. Do not use the vacuum with a wet filter.

7.3 Cleaning Accessories

Wipe down the hose, extension wands, and nozzles with a damp cloth. Ensure they are free of blockages.

7.4 Storage

Store the vacuum cleaner in a dry, cool place, away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures. Wrap the power cord

neatly and store accessories on the unit if possible.

8. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter any issues with your vacuum cleaner, refer to the table below for common problems and solutions.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Vacuum cleaner does not start.	No power supply. Power switch is off.	Check if the plug is securely inserted into the outlet. Ensure the power switch is in the 'ON' position.
Low suction power.	Dust tank is full. Filter is clogged. Hose or nozzle is blocked. Motor head not properly sealed.	Empty the dust tank. Clean or replace the filter. Check and clear any blockages in the hose or nozzle. Ensure motor head latches are securely fastened.
Water leaks during wet vacuuming.	Tank is overfilled. Float valve is stuck or dirty.	Empty the tank. Do not exceed maximum fill line. Clean the float valve to ensure free movement.
Unusual noise during operation.	Blockage in the hose or nozzle. Motor issue.	Check for and remove any blockages. If noise persists, discontinue use and contact customer support.
