## 1. INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the Telefunken T-11-300-W Condenser Dryer. This manual provides essential information for the safe and efficient operation, installation, and maintenance of your appliance. Please read it thoroughly before first use and keep it for future reference.

This condenser dryer is designed for household use, offering a 7 kg capacity and a variety of programs to suit different fabric types and drying needs.

## 2. SAFETY INFORMATION

Always adhere to the following safety precautions to prevent personal injury or damage to the appliance.

### 2.1 General Safety

- Ensure the dryer is connected to a grounded power outlet.
- Do not operate the dryer with a damaged power cord or plug.
- Keep children and pets away from the appliance during operation.
- Do not dry unwashed items in the tumble dryer.
- Items that have been soiled with substances such as cooking oil, acetone, alcohol, petrol, kerosene, spot removers, turpentine, waxes, and wax removers should be washed in hot water with an extra amount of detergent before being dried in the tumble dryer.
- Do not install the dryer in an area exposed to direct sunlight or extreme temperatures.

### 2.2 Electrical Safety

- Before cleaning or maintenance, always unplug the appliance from the power supply.
- Do not pull the power cord to disconnect the appliance. Always grasp the plug firmly.

### 2.3 Installation Safety

- The dryer must be installed on a firm, level surface.
- Ensure adequate ventilation around the appliance. Do not block ventilation openings.
- Do not install the dryer behind a lockable door, a sliding door, or a door with a hinge on the opposite side to that of the tumble dryer, in such a way that a full opening of the tumble dryer door is restricted.

## **3. SETUP AND FIRST USE**

### **3.1 Unpacking**

Carefully remove the dryer from its packaging. Inspect for any damage during transit. Keep packaging materials out of reach of children.

### **3.2 Positioning the Dryer**

Place the dryer on a stable, flat surface. Adjust the leveling feet to ensure the appliance is perfectly balanced. This will minimize vibrations and noise during operation.

### 3.3 Electrical Connection

Connect the dryer to a suitable grounded electrical outlet. Refer to the specifications section for power requirements.

### 3.4 First Use

Before drying clothes for the first time, it is recommended to run a short cycle with a damp cloth to remove any manufacturing residues from the drum.

## 4. OPERATING THE DRYER

### 4.1 Control Panel Overview

The control panel consists of a program selection knob, an LED display, and function buttons.

## 4.2 Loading Laundry

Open the extra-large door (Ø 47 cm) and load the laundry into the drum. Do not overload the dryer; ensure there is enough space for clothes to tumble freely.

### 4.3 Program Selection

Turn the program selection knob to choose one of the 15 available programs:

- **Cotton Extra Dry:** For very thick cotton items.
- **Cotton Cupboard Dry:** For cotton items that can be put directly into the cupboard.
- **Cotton Iron Dry:** For cotton items that require ironing.
- **Synthetics Cupboard Dry:** For synthetic items that can be put directly into the cupboard.

- **Synthetics Iron Dry:** For synthetic items that require ironing.
- **Delicates:** For delicate fabrics requiring gentle drying.
- **Mix:** For mixed loads of cotton and synthetics.
- **Baby Clothes:** Gentle drying for baby garments.
- **Time Program:** Allows setting a specific drying duration.
- **Refresh:** For airing out clothes without heat.
- **Extra Quick 29 Min.:** Fast drying for small loads.
- **Shirts/Blouses 12 Min.:** Quick drying for shirts and blouses.
- **Sport:** For sportswear.
- **Wool Refresh:** For refreshing wool items.
- **Jeans:** Specific program for denim.

#### 4.4 Additional Functions

- **Anti-Crease (Knitterschutz):** Reduces creasing by periodically tumbling the load after the cycle ends.
- **Child Lock (Kindersicherung):** Prevents accidental changes to settings during operation. Activate by pressing and holding the designated button (usually indicated on the panel).
- **Delay Start (Startvorwahl):** Allows you to set a delayed start time for the drying cycle.
- **Drum Reversal (Trommelreversierung):** The drum rotates in both directions to prevent tangling and ensure even drying.
- **Drum Lighting (Trommelbeleuchtung):** Illuminates the drum interior for better visibility when loading and unloading.

#### 4.5 Starting a Cycle

After selecting the program and any desired additional functions, press the **Start/Pause** button to begin the drying cycle. The LED display will show the remaining time.

### 5. MAINTENANCE AND CARE

Regular maintenance ensures optimal performance and extends the lifespan of your dryer.

#### 5.1 Cleaning the Lint Filter

The lint filter should be cleaned after every drying cycle. A clogged filter can reduce drying efficiency and increase energy consumption.

1. Open the dryer door.
2. Pull out the lint filter located inside the door opening.
3. Remove any accumulated lint by hand or with a soft brush.
4. Reinsert the filter firmly into its position.

## 5.2 Emptying the Water Container

As a condenser dryer, water extracted from the laundry collects in a removable container. This container must be emptied after each cycle.

1. Locate the water container, typically at the top left of the control panel.
2. Pull out the container carefully.
3. Empty the collected water into a sink.
4. Push the container back into its slot until it clicks into place.



### 5.3 Cleaning the Condenser

The condenser unit should be cleaned periodically (e.g., monthly or every 20-30 cycles) to maintain drying efficiency. Refer to the full instruction manual for detailed steps on accessing and cleaning the condenser unit, which is usually located behind a lower panel.

### 5.4 Exterior Cleaning

Wipe the exterior of the dryer with a soft, damp cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.

## 6. TROUBLESHOOTING

Before contacting customer service, please check the following common issues and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Dryer does not start.	Not plugged in; door not closed properly; program not selected; Start/Pause button not pressed.	Check power connection; ensure door is fully closed; select a program; press Start/Pause.
Clothes are not drying properly.	Lint filter clogged; water container full; condenser dirty; overloaded; incorrect program selected.	Clean lint filter; empty water container; clean condenser; reduce load size; select appropriate program.
Dryer is noisy.	Appliance not level; foreign objects in drum; loose components.	Adjust leveling feet; check drum for objects; contact service if noise persists.
"Empty Water Container" indicator is on.	Water container is full.	Empty the water container.
"Clean Filter" indicator is on.	Lint filter is clogged.	Clean the lint filter.



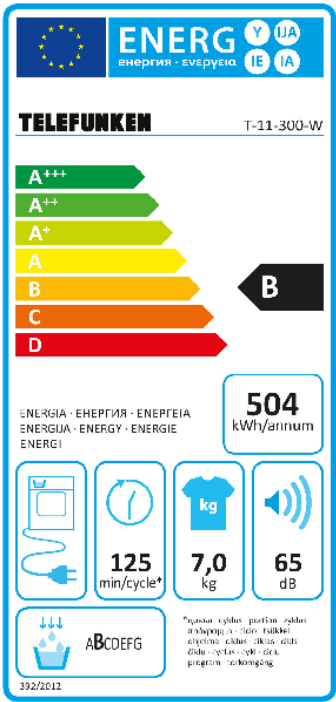
