# **SETUP INSTRUCTIONS**

### 1. Setting Analog Time:

- 1. Pull out the crown (E) on the right side of the watch.
- 2. Rotate the crown to adjust the analog hands to the desired time.
- 3. Push the crown back in to start the analog timekeeping.

### 2. Setting Digital Time and Date:

- 1. Press the Mode button (B) repeatedly until the digital time display starts flashing, indicating it's in setting mode.
- 2. Use the Reset/Adjust button (D) to select the item you wish to adjust (e.g., seconds, hour, minute, month, date, day of week).
- 3. Use the Start/Stop button (C) to increase the selected value.
- 4. Once all settings are correct, press the Mode button (B) to exit the setting mode.

## 3. Strap Adjustment:

The stainless steel strap can be adjusted to fit your wrist. This typically involves removing or adding links. For precise and safe adjustment, it is recommended to visit a professional jeweler or watch repair shop.

# **OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS**

#### 1. Mode Switching:

Press the Mode button (B) to cycle through the different functions: Time Mode, Chronograph (Stopwatch) Mode, Alarm Mode, and Dual Time Mode.

## 2. Using the Chronograph (Stopwatch):

- 1. Enter Chronograph Mode by pressing the Mode button (B).
- 2. Press the Start/Stop button (C) to start the stopwatch.
- 3. Press the Start/Stop button (C) again to pause the stopwatch.
- 4. Press the Reset/Adjust button (D) to reset the stopwatch to zero.

# 3. Setting the Alarm:

- 1. Enter Alarm Mode by pressing the Mode button (B).
- 2. Press the Reset/Adjust button (D) to select the hour or minute to set.
- 3. Use the Start/Stop button (C) to adjust the selected value.
- 4. Press the Mode button (B) to confirm and exit alarm setting.
- 5. To turn the alarm on/off, press the Start/Stop button (C) while in Alarm Mode.

# 4. Activating the LED Backlight:

Press the Light button (A) to illuminate the digital display for a few seconds, providing visibility in dark environments.

#### 5. Dual Time Function:

The watch allows you to set and display a second time zone. Enter Dual Time Mode by pressing the Mode button (B) until 'ALM' or 'T2' appears. Use the Reset/Adjust button (D) and Start/Stop button (C) to set the second time zone.

# MAINTENANCE

#### 1. Water Resistance:

Your SKMEI 1389 watch is rated 30M water resistant. This means it is protected against splashes, rain, and brief immersion in water, such as during hand washing. It is **not** suitable for swimming, diving, or showering with hot water, as steam and direct water pressure can compromise the seals.

#### 2. Cleaning:

Wipe the watch case and strap regularly with a soft, dry cloth to remove dirt and sweat. For the stainless steel strap, a slightly damp cloth can be used, followed by immediate drying. Avoid using chemical cleaners or abrasive materials.

# 3. Battery Replacement:

The watch is powered by a Lithium Ion battery (CR2016/SR626SW). When the display dims or the watch stops functioning, the battery may need replacement. It is recommended to have the battery replaced by a qualified watch technician to ensure proper sealing and water resistance.


# **TROUBLESHOOTING**

- Watch not keeping time: Check if the crown (E) is fully pushed in. If the digital display is dim or blank, the battery may need replacement.
- **Digital display not responding:** Try pressing all buttons to ensure none are stuck. If unresponsive, a battery replacement might be necessary.
- Water inside the watch: If moisture appears inside the watch, stop using it immediately and take it to a professional for inspection and repair to prevent further damage.


