1. OVERVIEW

2. SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

Please read and follow all safety instructions carefully to prevent injury or damage to the projector.

- **Power Supply:** Use only the specified power adapter. Ensure the power voltage is compatible with the projector's requirements.
- **Ventilation:** Do not block the ventilation openings. Ensure adequate airflow around the projector to prevent overheating.
- **Placement:** Place the projector on a stable, flat surface. Avoid placing it in direct sunlight, near heat sources, or in humid environments.
- **Cleaning:** Disconnect the power before cleaning. Use a soft, dry cloth. Do not use liquid or aerosol cleaners.
- **Eye Protection:** Do not look directly into the projector lens when the lamp is on, as it can cause eye damage.

- **Efficient Cooling System:** Features SmartEco technology and updated double tube cooling to minimize lamp consumption and extend lamp life up to 50,000 hours.

5. SETUP

5.1 Initial Placement

Choose a dark or semi-dark environment for optimal viewing. Position the projector on a stable surface at the desired distance from your projection screen or wall.

5.2 Power Connection

Connect the power cable to the projector's power input and then plug it into a power outlet.

5.3 Focus and Keystone Adjustment

Use the focus ring and keystone correction dial located on the projector to achieve a clear and rectangular image. Adjust until the image appears sharp and undistorted.

6. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

6.1 Power On/Off

Press the power button on the projector or the remote control to turn the device on or off.

6.2 Source Selection

Use the 'Source' button on the remote or projector control panel to select the desired input source (HDMI, VGA, USB, AV, TF Card).

6.3 Menu Navigation

Navigate through the on-screen menu using the arrow keys and 'OK' button on the remote or projector. Adjust settings such as picture mode, brightness, contrast, and color temperature as needed.

7. CONNECTIVITY

The Crenova BL-76 projector offers various ports for connecting external devices:

- **HDMI:** Connects to devices like TV sticks, game consoles (PS4, Xbox), laptops, and Blu-ray players.
- **USB:** For playing media directly from USB drives or connecting devices like Amazon Fire Stick.
- **VGA:** Connects to older computers or laptops.
- **AV:** Connects to devices with RCA outputs (e.g., DVD players).
- **TF Card:** Insert a TF card to play media files directly.
- **Audio Out:** Connect external speakers or headphones for enhanced audio.

7.1 Smartphone Connection

To connect a smartphone, an additional HDMI adapter (not included) is required. This allows for a stable wired connection. Note that copyrighted content from services like Hulu or Netflix cannot be mirrored or screencast directly from a smartphone due to copyright restrictions.

8. MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance ensures the longevity and optimal performance of your projector:

- **Lens Cleaning:** Use a soft lens cleaning cloth to gently wipe the projector lens. Avoid abrasive materials that could scratch the lens.
- **Dust Removal:** Periodically clean the ventilation grilles to prevent dust buildup, which can affect cooling efficiency. Use a soft brush or compressed air.
- **Storage:** When not in use for extended periods, store the projector in a cool, dry place, protected from dust and extreme temperatures.
- **Lamp Life:** The LED lamp has a lifespan of up to 50,000 hours. No user replacement is typically required for the lamp.

9. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your projector, refer to the following common solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No image displayed	Incorrect input source selected; loose cable connection; device not powered on.	Select the correct input source; check all cable connections; ensure connected device is powered on.
Blurred image	Lens out of focus; incorrect keystone adjustment.	Adjust the focus ring; adjust the keystone correction dial.
No sound	Volume too low; audio cable not connected; external device audio settings.	Increase projector volume; ensure audio cables are connected correctly; check audio output settings on the connected device.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Remote control not working	Batteries depleted; obstruction between remote and projector; remote sensor blocked.	Replace batteries; ensure clear line of sight to projector's IR sensor; remove any obstructions.
