ZEBRONICS Zeb-Envy Bluetooth Wireless Over-Ear Headphones User Manual

1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides detailed instructions for the ZEBRONICS Zeb-Envy Bluetooth Wireless Over-Ear Headphones. Please read this guide thoroughly before using the product to ensure correct operation, optimal performance, and longevity. Keep this manual for future reference.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

- Do not expose the headphones to extreme temperatures, humidity, or corrosive substances.
- Avoid dropping or subjecting the headphones to strong impacts.
- Do not attempt to disassemble or modify the headphones. This will void the warranty.
- Clean the headphones with a soft, dry cloth. Do not use harsh chemicals or abrasive materials.
- Listen at moderate volume levels to prevent hearing damage. Prolonged exposure to loud sounds can cause irreversible hearing loss.
- Keep out of reach of children.

3. PACKAGE CONTENTS

Verify that all items are present in your package:

- 1 x ZEBRONICS Zeb-Envy Over-Ear Headphone
- 1 x Detachable Microphone
- 1 x Charging Cable (USB)
- 1 x Aux Cable (3.5mm)
- 1 x User Manual

4. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

Familiarize yourself with the components and controls of your Zeb-Envy headphones.

Controls and Ports:

1. **Volume - / Previous Track:** Short press for volume down, long press for previous track.
2. **Play / Pause / ON / OFF:** Short press to play/pause music or answer/end calls. Long press to power on/off. Double press for voice assistant.
3. **Volume + / Next Track:** Short press for volume up, long press for next track.
4. **Aux / Detachable Mic Input:** Port for 3.5mm audio cable or detachable microphone.
5. **Charging Port:** USB port for charging the headphones.
6. **LED Control Switch:** Button to cycle through or turn off RGB lighting modes.

5. SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

5.1. Charging the Headphones

Before first use, fully charge your Zeb-Envy headphones.

- Connect the provided USB charging cable to the charging port on the headphones.
- Connect the other end of the USB cable to a USB power adapter (5V DC) or a computer's USB port.
- The LED indicator will show charging status (e.g., red while charging, off when fully charged).
- Charging time is approximately 3 hours for up to 33 hours of playback.

5.2. Powering On/Off

- **To Power On:** Long press the Play/Pause/ON/OFF button until the LED indicator lights up.
- **To Power Off:** Long press the Play/Pause/ON/OFF button until the LED indicator turns off.

5.3. Bluetooth Pairing

Pair your headphones with a Bluetooth-enabled device.

- Ensure the headphones are powered off.
- Long press the Play/Pause/ON/OFF button until the LED indicator flashes blue and red alternately, indicating pairing mode.
- Enable Bluetooth on your device (smartphone, tablet, PC, etc.).
- Search for "Zeb-Envy" in the list of available Bluetooth devices and select it to connect.
- Once connected, the LED indicator will flash blue periodically.

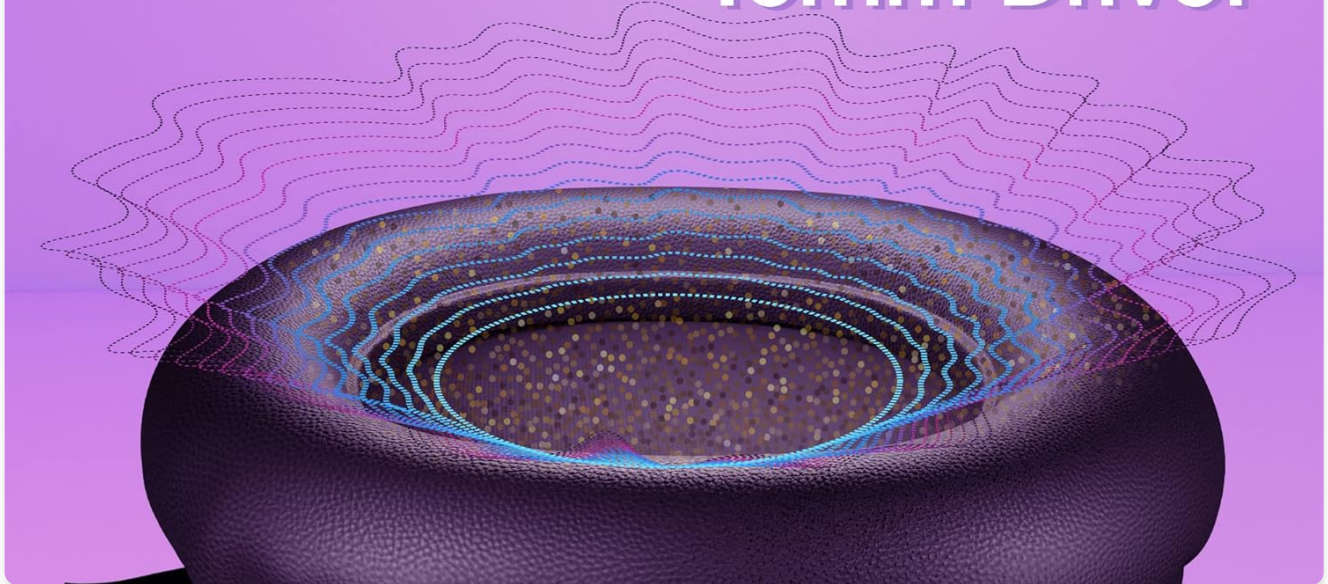

5.4. Connecting the Detachable Microphone

For enhanced call clarity or gaming, attach the flexible microphone.

- Locate the Aux/Detachable Mic Input port on the headphone earcup.
- Insert the detachable microphone's 3.5mm jack firmly into this port.
- Adjust the microphone's position for optimal voice pickup.

5.5. Wired Connection (Aux Mode)

Use the provided 3.5mm Aux cable for a wired connection, useful when the battery is low or for devices without Bluetooth.

- Connect one end of the 3.5mm Aux cable to the Aux/Detachable Mic Input port on the headphones.
- Connect the other end to the 3.5mm audio output jack of your device.
- The headphones will automatically switch to Aux mode.

6. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

6.1. Music Playback

- **Play/Pause:** Short press the Play/Pause/ON/OFF button.
- **Volume Up:** Short press the Volume + button.

- **Volume Down:** Short press the Volume - button.
- **Next Track:** Long press the Volume + button.
- **Previous Track:** Long press the Volume - button.

6.2. Call Functions

- **Answer/End Call:** Short press the Play/Pause/ON/OFF button.
- **Reject Call:** Long press the Play/Pause/ON/OFF button.
- **Redial Last Number:** Double press the Play/Pause/ON/OFF button (in standby mode).

6.3. Voice Assistant

Activate your device's voice assistant (e.g., Siri, Google Assistant).

- Double press the Play/Pause/ON/OFF button to activate the voice assistant.

6.4. LED Control (RGB Lights)

The Zeb-Envy headphones feature breathing RGB lights with multiple modes.

- Press the LED Control Switch to cycle through different lighting modes (Static, Breathing, RGB).
- Press and hold the LED Control Switch to turn the lights off.

6.5. Adjusting the Headband

Adjust the headband for a comfortable and secure fit.

- Gently slide the earcups up or down along the headband to find the optimal position.

7. MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Wipe the headphones with a soft, slightly damp cloth. Do not use liquid cleaners directly on the product.
- **Storage:** Store the headphones in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.
- **Battery Care:** To preserve battery life, charge the headphones at least once every three months if not used regularly.

8. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
---------	----------------	----------

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Headphones do not power on.	Low battery.	Charge the headphones fully.
Cannot pair via Bluetooth.	Headphones not in pairing mode; Bluetooth disabled on device; device too far.	Ensure headphones are in pairing mode (flashing red/blue). Enable Bluetooth on your device. Move device closer to headphones (within 10 meters).
No sound.	Volume too low; incorrect input mode; device not connected.	Increase volume on headphones and device. Check if connected via Bluetooth or Aux cable correctly.
Microphone not working.	Microphone not properly connected; device settings.	Ensure detachable microphone is fully inserted. Check microphone input settings on your connected device.
