INTRODUCTION

Welcome to your new TERIOS Mobile Game Controller. This manual provides detailed instructions for setup, operation, and maintenance to ensure optimal performance and an enhanced gaming experience across various platforms including Android smartphones, Windows PCs, and PlayStation 3 consoles. Please read this manual thoroughly before using the device.

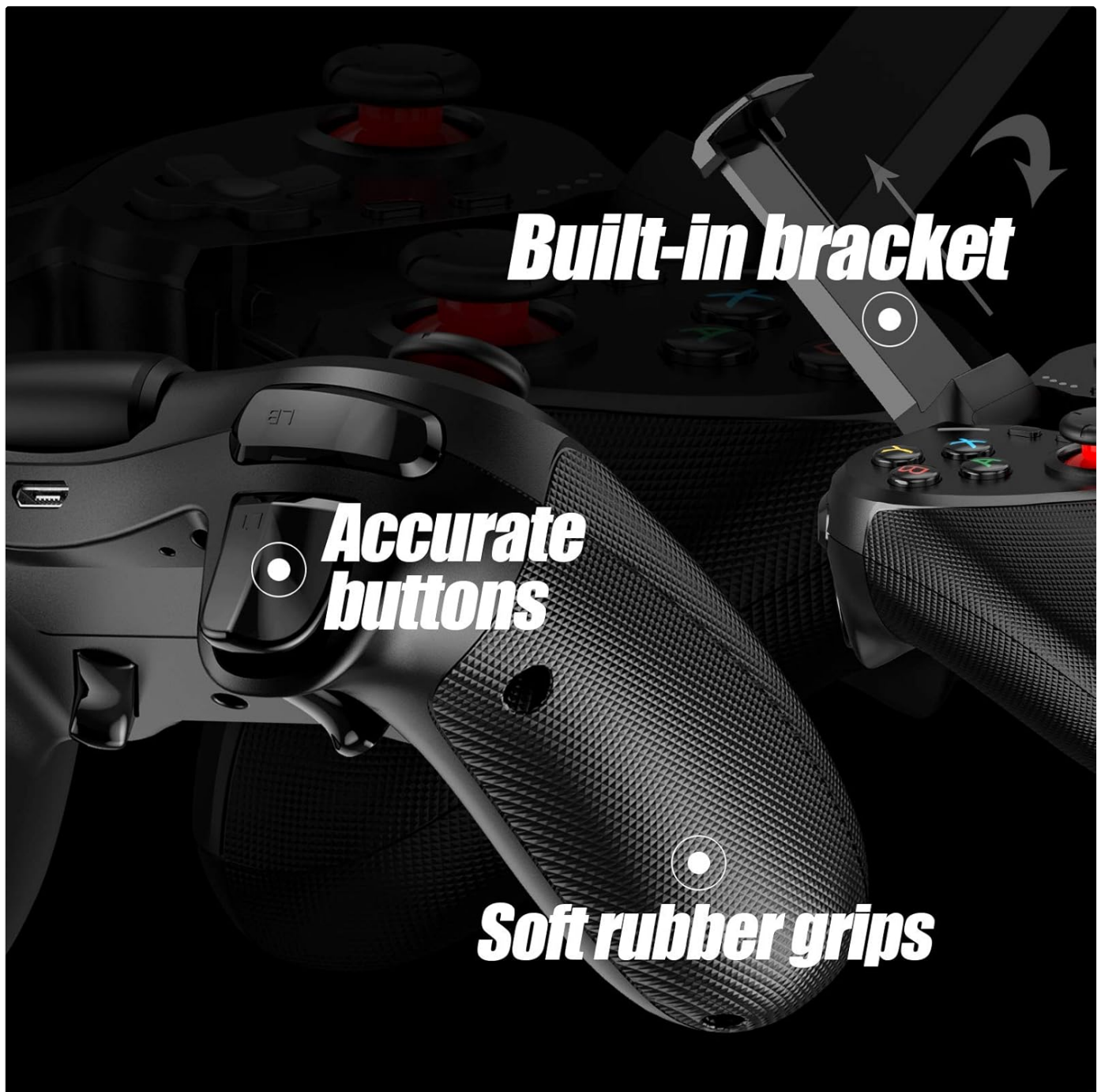


Figure 2: Detail of the controller's built-in smartphone bracket, accurate buttons, and comfortable soft rubber grips.

SETUP AND CONNECTION

1. Charging the Controller

Before first use, fully charge the controller. Connect the provided Micro USB cable to the controller's charging port and the other end to a USB power source (e.g., computer USB port, USB wall adapter). The indicator lights will show charging status and turn off when fully charged.

2. Powering On/Off

- **To Power On:** Press and hold the **HOME** button for 2 seconds. The indicator lights will flash.
- **To Power Off:** Press and hold the **HOME** button for 5 seconds until the indicator lights turn off. The controller will automatically power off after 5 minutes of inactivity.

3. Bluetooth Pairing (Android Smartphones / PS3)

1. Ensure the controller is powered off.
2. On your Android smartphone or PS3, enable Bluetooth.
3. Press and hold the **HOME** button on the controller until the indicator lights flash rapidly, indicating pairing mode.
4. On your device, search for new Bluetooth devices. Select "TERIOS Gamepad" or similar from the list.
5. Once connected, the indicator light will become solid.

4. PC Connection

For PC connection, the controller typically uses a USB dongle (often included). Insert the USB dongle into an available USB port on your PC. The controller should automatically connect. If not, press the **HOME** button to initiate connection.

5. Initial Setup and App (V3 App)

For optimal customization and compatibility with certain mobile games, it is recommended to download the V3 app from the Google Play Store. This app allows you to map virtual keys on your screen to the physical buttons of the controller.

1. Download the "V3" app from the Google Play Store.
2. Connect the TERIOS gamepad to your smartphone via Bluetooth.
3. Open the V3 app and follow the on-screen instructions to customize key mappings for your desired games.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Button Layout and Functions

- **Left Analog Stick:** Primary movement control.
- **Right Analog Stick:** Camera control or secondary movement.
- **D-Pad (Directional Pad):** Precise directional input.
- **ABXY Buttons:** Standard action buttons (A, B, X, Y).
- **L1/L2, R1/R2 Buttons:** Shoulder and trigger buttons for various in-game actions.
- **SELECT Button:** Typically used for menu navigation or specific game functions.
- **START Button:** Typically used for pausing games or accessing menus.
- **HOME Button:** Powers on/off, enters pairing mode, and returns to home screen on some devices.
- **TURBO Button:** Activates the turbo function for other buttons.
- **CLEAR Button:** Deactivates the turbo function.

2. Turbo Function

The Turbo function allows a button to be pressed repeatedly as long as you hold it down, which is useful for rapid-fire actions in games.

- **To Activate:** Press and hold the **TURBO** button, then press the desired action button (e.g., A, B, X, Y, L1, R1). Release both buttons. Now, holding down the action button will activate turbo fire.
- **To Deactivate:** Press and hold the **CLEAR** button, then press the action button for which turbo was activated. Release both buttons.

3. Smartphone Holder Usage

The integrated smartphone holder can accommodate most smartphone sizes. Gently extend the holder and place your smartphone securely within the clamps. Ensure the phone is centered for balance.

MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, dry cloth to clean the controller. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- **Storage:** Store the controller in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.
- **Battery Care:** To prolong battery life, avoid fully discharging the controller frequently. Charge it regularly, even if not in use for extended periods.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Issue	Possible Cause	Solution
Controller not connecting via Bluetooth.	Controller not in pairing mode; device Bluetooth off; interference.	Ensure controller is in pairing mode (rapid flashing lights). Check device Bluetooth settings. Move closer to the device. Try restarting both controller and device.
Buttons are unresponsive or delayed.	Low battery; software glitch; interference.	Charge the controller fully. Restart the controller. Ensure no other strong wireless signals are nearby. For mobile games, check V3 app settings.
Controller disconnects frequently.	Low battery; too far from device; interference.	Charge the controller. Stay within the recommended Bluetooth range. Minimize wireless interference.
Turbo function not working.	Incorrect activation sequence; button not supported.	Ensure you press and hold TURBO, then press the desired action button, then release both. Some games or buttons may not fully support turbo.



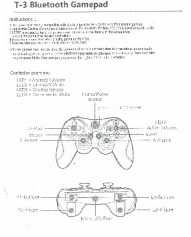

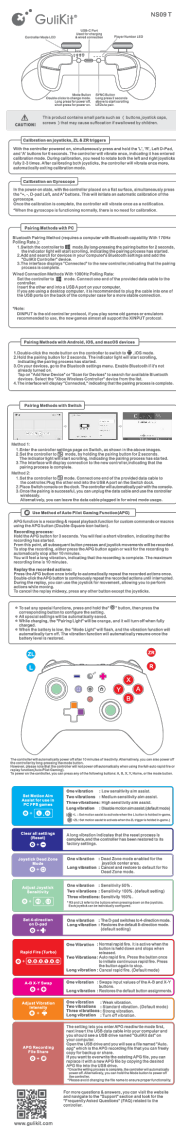
