Doro 8080 Smartphone User Manual

Model: 8080

1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential instructions for setting up, operating, and maintaining your Doro 8080 smartphone. The Doro 8080 is designed for ease of use, featuring a 5.7-inch display, Android 9.0 operating system, and 4G/LTE connectivity. Please read this manual thoroughly to ensure proper use and to maximize your device's functionality.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

- **Battery Safety:** Use only Doro-approved batteries and chargers. Do not puncture, open, or disassemble the battery. Avoid exposing the battery to high temperatures or direct sunlight.
- **Hearing Protection:** Avoid prolonged listening at high volume levels to prevent hearing damage.
- **Driving Safety:** Always prioritize driving safety. Do not use your phone in a way that distracts you from driving.
- **Medical Devices:** Maintain a safe distance between your phone and medical devices like pacemakers. Consult your physician and medical device manufacturer for specific guidelines.
- **Disposal:** Dispose of your device and battery responsibly according to local regulations. Do not dispose of them in household waste.

3. SETUP

3.1 Unboxing and Initial Inspection

Upon opening the package, verify that all components are present: Doro 8080 smartphone, charger, USB cable, and this user manual. Inspect the device for any physical damage.

3.2 Inserting the SIM Card

The Doro 8080 supports a single Nano-SIM card. Locate the SIM card tray on the side of the device. Use the provided SIM ejector tool to open the tray. Place your Nano-SIM card into the tray with the gold contacts facing

down and the cut corner aligned correctly. Gently push the tray back into the phone until it clicks into place.

3.3 Inserting a MicroSD Card (Optional)

To expand the internal storage, you can insert a microSD card. The microSD card slot is typically located within the same tray as the SIM card or in a separate slot. Follow the same procedure as for the SIM card, ensuring the microSD card is correctly oriented.

3.4 Charging the Battery

Before first use, fully charge the Doro 8080 battery. Connect the USB cable to the charging adapter and then to the phone's USB-C port located at the bottom. Plug the adapter into a power outlet. The phone can also be charged using the included charging dock.

3.5 Powering On/Off

To power on, press and hold the power button located on the right side of the phone until the Doro logo appears. To power off, press and hold the power button, then select 'Power off' from the options on the screen.

4. OPERATING THE DORO 8080

4.1 Basic Navigation

The Doro 8080 runs on Android 9.0. Use the touchscreen to navigate. Swipe up, down, left, or right to move through menus and screens. Tap icons to open applications. The home screen features large, clear icons for common functions like Call, View, Send, and Search, along with Google, Camera, Assistant, and Play Store.



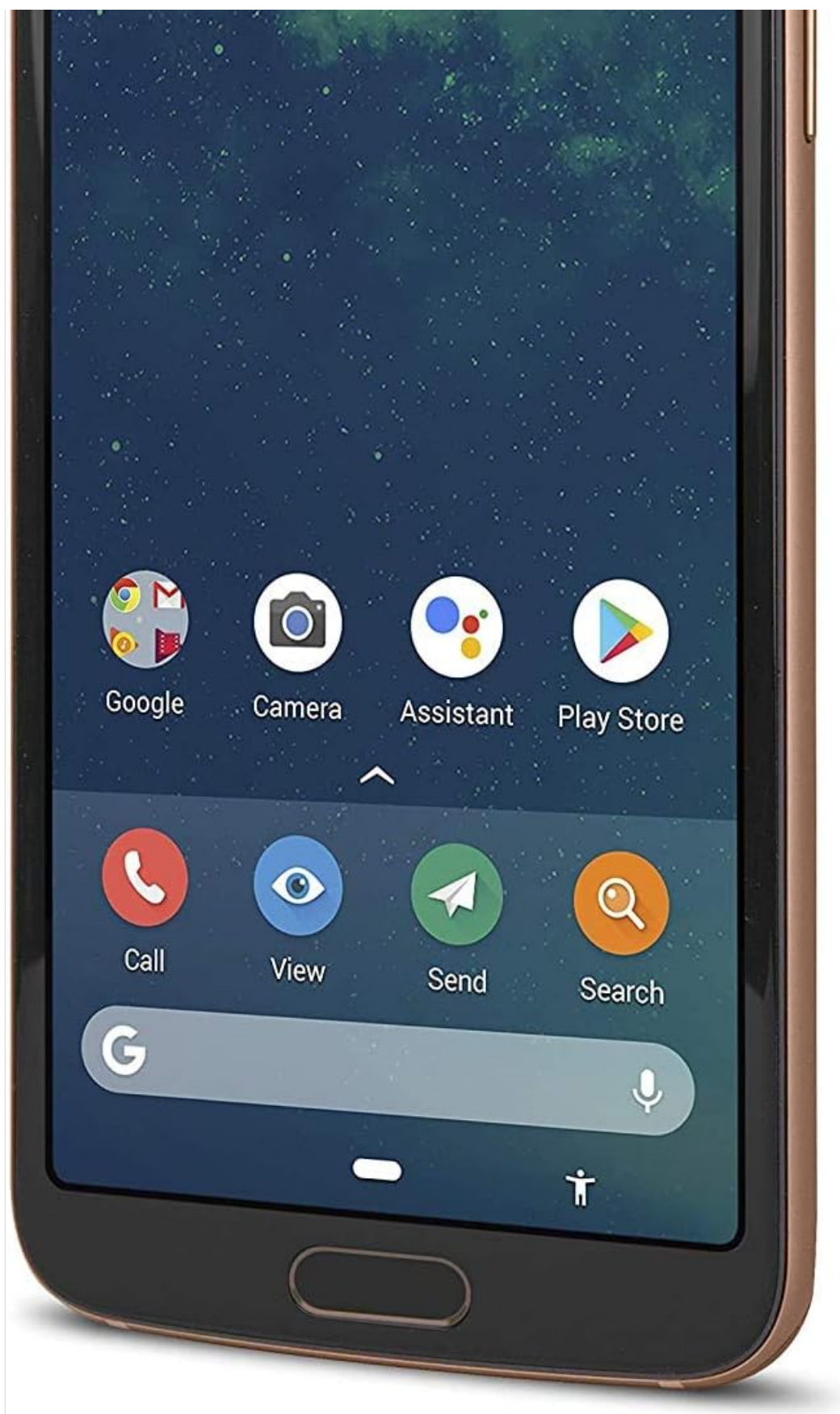


Image: Front view of the Doro 8080 displaying its user-friendly home screen with large, accessible icons.

4.2 Making and Receiving Calls

Tap the 'Call' icon to access the dialer. Enter the phone number and tap the green call button. To answer an incoming call, swipe the green phone icon upwards. To decline, swipe the red phone icon downwards.

4.3 Sending Messages

Tap the 'Send' icon to open the messaging application. Select a contact or enter a new number, then type your message in the text field. Tap the send button to transmit the message.

4.4 Using the Camera

The Doro 8080 features a 16MP rear camera and a 5MP front camera. Tap the 'Camera' icon to open the camera application. Tap the shutter button to take a photo. You can switch between front and rear cameras using the icon on the screen.

4.5 Internet and Connectivity

The Doro 8080 supports 4G/LTE mobile data and Wi-Fi. To connect to Wi-Fi, go to **Settings > Network & internet > Wi-Fi**, turn Wi-Fi on, and select your desired network. Enter the password if prompted.

4.6 Google Assistant

The Doro 8080 integrates Google Assistant. Tap the 'Assistant' icon or say "Hey Google" to activate it. You can use voice commands for various tasks, such as making calls, sending messages, setting alarms, or getting information.

4.7 The 'I' Tile

A unique feature of the Doro 8080 is the 'I' tile on the home screen. Tapping this tile provides quick access to a guide on how the phone works, offering step-by-step instructions and tips for various functions. This is particularly useful for new users or for refreshing your memory on specific features.

4.8 Emergency Beacon

The Doro 8080 includes an emergency beacon feature, often activated by a dedicated button or specific gesture. This feature is designed to send an alert to pre-selected contacts in case of an emergency. Refer to the on-device 'I' tile guide for detailed setup and usage instructions for this safety feature.

5. MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, lint-free cloth to clean the screen and body of the phone. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive materials.
- **Software Updates:** Regularly check for and install software updates to ensure optimal performance and security. Go to **Settings > System > Advanced > System update**
- **Battery Care:** To prolong battery life, avoid fully discharging the battery frequently. Charge the phone before the battery level drops too low.
- **Storage Management:** Periodically clear unnecessary files and apps to free up storage space and maintain device speed.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

6.1 Phone Not Turning On

Ensure the battery is charged. Connect the phone to its charger and wait a few minutes before attempting to power it on again. If the issue persists, contact Doro support.

6.2 Poor Battery Life

Battery life can be affected by various factors. Reduce screen brightness, close unused applications, disable Wi-Fi or Bluetooth when not in use, and limit background data usage. If battery degradation is severe, consider contacting support for a battery replacement.

6.3 Network Connectivity Issues

Check if your SIM card is properly inserted. Ensure you have network coverage in your area. Verify that mobile data is enabled in settings. If problems persist, contact your network provider to confirm service status and SIM card functionality.

6.4 Applications Crashing or Freezing

Try restarting the application. If the issue continues, clear the app's cache and data via **Settings > Apps & notifications > [App Name] > Storage & cache**. As a last resort, uninstall and reinstall the application. Ensure your phone's software is up to date.
