Table 7.1: Common Troubleshooting Scenarios

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Engine Fails to Start	No fuel, stale fuel, fouled spark plug, clogged air filter.	Check fuel level, replace old fuel, clean/replace spark plug, clean/replace air filter.
Tiller Not Tilling Effectively	Worn tines, incorrect tilling depth, engine losing power.	Inspect/replace tines, adjust depth stake, check engine maintenance (air filter, spark plug).
Excessive Vibration	Loose components, bent tines, unbalanced tines.	Tighten all fasteners, inspect tines for damage, replace bent tines.
