Introduction

Sid Meier's Civilization VI is a turn-based strategy game where players guide a civilization from the Stone Age to the Information Age. The objective is to build an empire that endures through history by exploring new lands, researching technologies, engaging in diplomacy or warfare, and achieving various victory conditions. 1. Setup and Installation

1. **Insert Game Disc:** Insert the Sid Meier's Civilization VI game disc into your PlayStation 4 console.
2. **Automatic Installation:** The game will begin installing automatically. Follow any on-screen prompts. Ensure your console has sufficient storage space.
3. **Game Updates:** Connect your PlayStation 4 to the internet to download and install any available game updates. This ensures you have the latest features and bug fixes.
4. **Launch Game:** Once installation and updates are complete, select the Civilization VI icon from your PlayStation

4 home screen to launch the game.

2. Operating Instructions: Core Gameplay

Sid Meier's Civilization VI is a turn-based strategy game where you lead a civilization through various historical eras. The game involves managing resources, developing cities, advancing technology, engaging in diplomacy, and potentially warfare to achieve one of several victory conditions.

2.1. Getting Started

- **Choose a Leader:** Select a historical leader, each with unique abilities, units, and buildings that influence your playstyle.
- **Found Your First City:** Begin by founding your first city. Consider locations with access to resources, fresh water, and defensible terrain.
- **Explore:** Use your initial units (e.g., Warrior, Scout) to explore the surrounding map, uncover natural wonders, and discover other civilizations.

2.2. City Management and Development

- **Districts:** Cities expand by building districts on adjacent tiles. Each district specializes in a certain output (e.g., Campus for Science, Holy Site for Faith).
- **Buildings:** Construct buildings within districts to enhance their output and provide various bonuses.
- **Units:** Train military, civilian, and religious units to explore, defend, expand, and interact with the world.

2.3. Research and Advancement

- **Technology Tree:** Advance through the Technology Tree to unlock new units, buildings, and improvements. Gain 'Eureka' moments to speed up research.
- **Civic Tree:** Progress through the Civic Tree to unlock new governments, policies, and wonders. Gain 'Inspiration' moments to speed up civic research.

2.4. Diplomacy and Warfare

- **Interactions:** Engage with other leaders through diplomacy to form alliances, trade resources, or declare war.
- **Combat:** Utilize military units strategically on the hexagonal map. Terrain, unit types, and promotions play a crucial role in battle outcomes.

2.5. Victory Conditions

The game offers multiple paths to victory:

- **Science Victory:** Be the first to launch a Mars colony.
- **Culture Victory:** Attract more foreign tourists than any other civilization has domestic tourists.
- **Domination Victory:** Conquer the original capitals of all other civilizations.
- **Religious Victory:** Convert all other civilizations to your founded religion.
- **Diplomatic Victory:** Achieve a set number of Diplomatic Victory Points through various in-game actions.

3. Maintenance and Updates

- **Game Updates:** Periodically check for game updates via your PlayStation 4 system. These updates often include performance improvements, bug fixes, and new content.
- **Saving Progress:** Ensure you regularly save your game progress to avoid data loss. The game typically offers both auto-save and manual save options.
- **Storage Management:** Monitor your PlayStation 4's storage space. Civilization VI and its expansions can consume significant storage.

4. Troubleshooting

- **Game Freezes or Crashes:** If the game freezes or crashes, close the application and restart your PlayStation 4 console. Ensure the game and system software are up to date.
- **Performance Issues:** For slow performance, ensure no other demanding applications are running in the background. Restarting the game or console can often resolve temporary slowdowns.
- **Installation Problems:** If installation fails, verify your internet connection (for digital downloads) and ensure sufficient storage space. Try deleting and re-downloading the game if necessary.
- **Online Multiplayer Issues:** Check your internet connection and PlayStation Network status. Ensure all players have the same game version and any required DLC.
