- 3. Apply Gentle Pressure:** Apply steady, gentle pressure to the handle, guiding the nail into the material. For harder materials, a pilot hole may be beneficial.
- 4. Drive the Nail:** Once the nail is started, use a small hammer or mallet to tap the end of the nail driver's handle. Apply controlled, light taps until the nail is fully seated. Avoid excessive force, which can bend the nail or damage the workpiece.
- 5. Remove Tool:** Carefully withdraw the nail driver, ensuring the nail remains in place.

Tip: For very delicate work, practice on scrap material first to get a feel for the required pressure and tapping force.

MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** After each use, wipe the tool clean with a dry cloth to remove any dust or debris.
- **Storage:** Store the nail driver in a dry environment to prevent rust. A tool rack or drawer is ideal.
- **Inspection:** Periodically check the driving tip for wear or deformation. While made of durable alloy steel, extreme misuse can cause damage.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Nail bends easily.	Excessive force; incorrect nail size; material too hard.	Use lighter taps; ensure nail fits tip; drill a pilot hole for hard materials.
Nail driver slips off nail head.	Improper alignment; worn tip.	Ensure tool is perpendicular to the nail; inspect tip for damage.
Difficulty starting the nail.	Material too dense; nail not properly seated.	Apply firm, steady initial pressure; ensure nail is fully in the tip.
