Introduction

CAMERA OVERVIEW

Physical Design and Ergonomics

The EOS M200 features a compact and lightweight mirrorless design, making it highly portable. The camera body is constructed with a durable plastic, offering a comfortable grip for extended use. Its small form factor allows for easy handling and storage.

Controls and Interface

The camera features a 3.0-inch touch panel LCD screen that can tilt 180 degrees, ideal for self-portraits and vlogging. Essential control buttons are intuitively placed for easy access and operation.

SETUP AND INITIAL USE

Battery Installation

- 1. Open the battery compartment cover located at the bottom of the camera.
- 2. Insert the LP-E12 battery pack with the contacts facing inward, ensuring it clicks into place.
- 3. Close the battery compartment cover securely.

Lens Attachment

- 1. Align the red dot on the EF-M 15-45mm lens with the red dot on the camera body.
- 2. Rotate the lens clockwise until it clicks into place.
- 3. To detach, press the lens release button on the camera body and rotate the lens counter-clockwise.

Memory Card Insertion

- 1. Open the memory card slot cover on the side of the camera.
- 2. Insert an SD, SDHC, or SDXC (UHS-I compatible) card with the label facing the front of the camera until it clicks.
- 3. Close the memory card slot cover.

Powering On/Off

To power on the camera, rotate the power dial to the 'ON' position. To power off, rotate the dial to 'OFF'.

BASIC OPERATION

Shooting Modes

The EOS M200 offers various shooting modes, including:

- Scene Intelligent Auto: Automatically optimizes settings for various scenes.
- Program AE (P): Camera sets shutter speed and aperture, user controls other settings.
- Shutter-priority AE (Tv): User sets shutter speed, camera sets aperture.
- Aperture-priority AE (Av): User sets aperture, camera sets shutter speed.
- Manual Exposure (M): User controls both shutter speed and aperture.
- Creative Filters: Apply various effects to your photos.
- Self-Portrait Mode: Optimized for taking selfies.

Image Quality and Sensor

The camera is equipped with a 24.1 Megapixel APS-C CMOS sensor, delivering high-resolution images with excellent detail and color reproduction. It supports JPEG and RAW file formats.

ISO Sensitivity

The standard ISO range is 100-25600, expandable to 51200, allowing for versatile shooting in various lighting conditions.

Autofocus System

The EOS M200 features Canon's Dual Pixel CMOS AF with Eye Detection AF, providing fast and accurate focusing for both stills and video. It has 143 autofocus points and supports continuous autofocus.

Continuous Shooting

The camera can capture images at up to 6.1 frames per second (fps) with continuous autofocus, suitable for capturing moving subjects.

VIDEO RECORDING

4K Video

The EOS M200 supports 4K UHD (2160p) video recording at 24fps, 25fps, and 30fps. It also offers vertical video support, ideal for social media content. Note that 4K video recording may involve a slight crop.

Video Recording Limits

Individual video clips are limited to approximately 30 minutes of recording time. Factors such as memory card capacity, battery life, and camera temperature may affect actual recording duration.

CONNECTIVITY

Wi-Fi and Bluetooth

Built-in Wi-Fi and Bluetooth technology allow for seamless connection to compatible smart devices. This enables remote control of the camera, easy image transfer, and sharing to social media platforms.

Image Transfer

Utilize the Canon Camera Connect app on your smartphone or tablet to wirelessly transfer photos and videos from your EOS M200. The auto image transfer function can automatically send images to your device after shooting.

LENSES AND COMPATIBILITY

EF-M Mount

The EOS M200 uses the Canon EF-M lens mount, designed specifically for Canon's mirrorless M-series cameras. The included EF-M 15-45mm f/3.5-6.3 IS STM lens is a versatile standard zoom lens.

TROUBLESHOOTING

- Images are blurry: Check autofocus settings, ensure proper lighting, and verify lens is clean.
- Video recording stops unexpectedly: Check memory card space, battery level, and camera temperature.
- Connectivity issues: Ensure Wi-Fi/Bluetooth is enabled on both camera and smart device, and that the Canon Camera Connect app is up to date.
