# Gigaset AS690HX DECT Cordless IP Phone User Manual

#### 1. Introduction

The Gigaset AS690HX is a reliable DECT cordless IP phone designed for versatile connection to standard DECT base stations. It features a high-contrast graphic display, superior audio quality, and a hands-free function, making it an ideal communication device for both home and office environments. This manual provides essential information for setting up, operating, and maintaining your Gigaset AS690HX phone.

# 3. SETUP

# 3.1 Battery Installation

- 1. Remove the battery cover on the back of the handset.
- 2. Insert the two supplied AAA (NiMH) rechargeable batteries, ensuring correct polarity.
- 3. Replace the battery cover.

#### 3.2 Connecting the Charging Base

- 1. Connect the power supply unit to the charging base.
- 2. Plug the power supply unit into a wall outlet.
- 3. Place the handset in the charging base to charge the batteries. Allow at least 8 hours for the initial charge.

## 3.3 Registering the Handset to a DECT Base Station

The Gigaset AS690HX is designed to connect to any standard DECT base station. Follow these general steps for registration:

- 1. Activate registration mode on your DECT base station (refer to your base station's manual for specific instructions). This usually involves pressing and holding a registration/paging button on the base.
- 2. On the Gigaset AS690HX handset, navigate to the 'Settings' or 'Registration' menu.
- 3. Select 'Register Handset' and follow the on-screen prompts. You may be asked to enter a PIN (default is usually 0000).
- 4. Once successfully registered, the handset display will show the internal number (e.g., INT 1) and the signal strength.

# 4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

# 4.1 Making and Receiving Calls

- Making a Call: Enter the phone number using the keypad and press the green call button.
- Receiving a Call: Press the green call button when the phone rings.
- Ending a Call: Press the red end call button.

#### 4.2 Hands-Free Function

During a call, press the hands-free button (speaker icon) to activate or deactivate the hands-free mode. The Gigaset AS690HX offers great sound quality even in hands-free mode.

#### 4.3 Volume Control

The handset features a 5-level volume control for both the ringer and the earpiece/hands-free speaker. Adjust the volume using the navigation keys during a call or through the settings menu.

#### 4.4 Phonebook

The phonebook can store up to 100 contacts. To add a contact:

- 1. Navigate to the 'Phonebook' menu.
- 2. Select 'New Entry'.
- 3. Enter the name and phone number.
- 4. Save the entry.

#### 4.5 Call Blocking

The Gigaset AS690HX allows you to block up to 32 numbers. This feature helps to prevent unwanted calls. Access the 'Call Blocking' option in the settings menu to add or remove numbers from the block list.

#### 4.6 Jumbo Mode

For enhanced readability, activate the jumbo mode. In this mode, all numbers are displayed larger during dialing, making it easier to see the digits on the high-contrast display.

#### 6. MAINTENANCE

# 6.1 Cleaning

Wipe the handset and charging base with a soft, damp cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents, as these can damage the surfaces.

#### **6.2 Battery Care**

Use only the recommended NiMH rechargeable batteries. Non-rechargeable batteries or other battery types may cause damage or malfunction. If the phone will not be used for an extended period, remove the batteries to prevent leakage.

# 7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Gigaset AS690HX, please refer to the following common solutions:

- **No Dial Tone:** Ensure the charging base is properly connected to the power supply and the phone line (if applicable, for the DECT base station). Verify the handset is registered to the base station.
- Handset Not Charging: Check that the handset is correctly placed in the charging cradle and that the power supply is connected. Clean the charging contacts on both the handset and the base with a dry cloth.
- Poor Sound Quality: Ensure the handset is within range of the DECT base station. Check for interference from other electronic devices.
- Cannot Register Handset: Ensure the base station is in registration mode. Double-check the PIN if required. Try restarting both the base station and the handset.


